2. Former Civilian Ration Cards and supplementary cards will be withdrawn from these classes where centralized issuing is in practice, and authorities for bulk purchase substituted.

3. In cases where centralized issues are not practicable i.e. Guardia Forestale, ration cards will be withdrawn, and special authority entitling the person to the new scale, issued in lieu. The number and names of the individuals involved will be ascertained from the appropriate Provincial Office of the organization.

- In cases where centralized messes are not practicable i.e. Guardia Forestale, ration cards will be withdrawn, and special authorities entitling the person to the new scale, issued in lieu. The number and name of the individuals involved will be ascertained from the appropriate Provincial Office of the organization.
