10. DUTIES OF CAPOS(a) In the Standing-by Stage:

Instruct Carabinieri fully in all duties they will be required to perform, in the manner in which they will be required to perform those duties, particularly without political bias or favour. Stress smartness of turnout and their potential influence on the mind of the population. Define the directed policy regarding partisans. Many persons will, no doubt, be denounced to them, but in the early stages at least it will not normally be possible for them to do other than record particulars of the denouncer and denounced for communication in due course to you. Slackness will not be tolerated. Select Carabinieri and instruct in special duties such as the posting of proclamations etc. Display to the Carabinieri, specimens of all proclamations, orders, notices, price-lists, passes, motor-car permits, and explain their significance and provisions.

The person posting must keep a record showing his name, list of proclamations, General Orders etc., time, date and place posted. You will personally see the posting of one set of Proclamations, etc, and keep a record as above for possible future use in prosecutions.

(e) Surrender of Firearms, Ammunition and Wireless Transmitting Sets

Direct the recording at stations in your district of the date, name and address of person surrendering, type and number of firearm or Wireless transmitting Set. Record also to be kept of any other class of article ordered to be surrendered.

(f) CUF

Ensure disarming and disbanding.

(g) Employment of other Police Agencies

As directed in para 8.

(h) Passes and Motor Vehicle Permits

Will only be issued by CPOs on the prescribed form and will be kept to an absolute minimum. Passes will include Curfew Passes for Doctors and Midwives. Motor Vehicle permits will only be issued in respect of those vehicles vital to the city administration. Motor Vehicle permits will be displayed on the left hand bottom corner of the windscreen.

Duplicates will be kept of all passes and motor vehicle permits.

(j) Brothels will be closed and prostitutes ordered to remain inside for 48 hours or such other period as may be ordered.(k) Wines and Spirits

Street stalls for the sale of wines and spirits are prohibited altogether. Wine shops, i.e., premises where wines and spirits are retailed for consumption on or off the premises will be closed on entry into the city and will not be re-opened until further orders. The sale in hotels and restaurants of wines and spirits to be consumed with a meal in these premises is permitted to continue, as is the sale by wholesalers of wines and spirits in bulk.

(l) Check Posts and Patrols

Check posts will be established on all main military traffic roads at the entrance to the city, and patrols will be established to prevent movement into or out of the city, to control civilian movement generally, to keep all civilian motor vehicles not displaying a permit, carts and bicycles off the main military traffic routes until further orders, and to confine such traffic to secondary routes, prevent operation of trams until permission is given, to maintain law and Order, prevent looting and sabot-

The sale in hotels and restaurants of wines and spirits to be consumed with a meal in those premises is permitted to continue, as is the sale by wholesalers of wines and spirits in bulk.

(l) Check Posts and Patrols

Check posts will be established on all main military traffic roads at the entrance to the city, and patrols will be established to prevent movement into or out of the city, to control civilian movement generally, to keep all civilian motor vehicles not displaying a permit, carts and bicycles off the main military traffic routes until further orders, and to confine such traffic to secondary routes, prevent operation of trams until permission is given, to maintain Law and Order, prevent looting and sabotage, enforcing proclamations and orders, implementing within Civil Police Jurisdiction Eighth Army Policy relating to Brothels, closing of wine shops, reporting UX bombs, mines etc., obstructions on essential traffic routes. Posts and patrols will be covered 24 hours daily until further orders.

(m) "S" Force Targets

As personally instructed by SCAPG.

(n) Guards for Banks, Post Offices and Financial Institutions

will be provided to the extent of the personnel available.
