The car in question has been found intact.

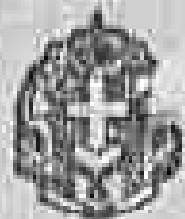

This morning I was given some information (which may be true) about stolen cars. There are apparently three collecting centers for these:

- 1) Via della Cornilucua, between Via Cassia and Via S. Onofrio, in a small siding.
- 2) Somewhere near Ponte Milvio, on the left going north, by the bridge.
- 3) Between S. Paolo and Porta S. Sebastiano, on the road immediately outside the old Roman wall.

It appears stolen cars are taken to these places and stripped of everything portable, the remains being left on the spot.

I enquired who might take an interest in this, and it was suggested I should mention the matter to you.
