TO : Public Safety S/C, A.C.

The M.M.I.A. Detachment of Sardegna has fixed, as of 1 July 45, the following ration for the CC.RR. horses of the island.

corn .....	3 Kilos
Straw .....	4,240 Kilos
salt .....	0,020 kilos.

with the relative substitution according to the availabilities in the Military distribution stores.

It is to be pointed out that for the horses of other Military organisations of that Territorial Command the same M.M.I.A. Detachment has fixed the following ration:

corn (barley, oats, bran, (carob-beans,millet) .....	4.540 Kilos
straw .....	6,360 "
salt (at alternate fortnights).....	0,020 "

When hay is available the following may be distributed/ 4,300 Kilos of straw or 2 Kilos of hay instead of 6,360 kilos of straw. The same ration is given to the mules of said organisations.

The work which the CC.RR. horses do is much heavier and more uneasy than that of the horses of the Territorial Commands and as such the ration is really insufficient.

The horses of the Sardegna CC.RR. have greatly suffered owing to the war, therefore great losses have been verified and still numerous cases are perishing.

The insufficient ration and the heavy work will be a further cause of loss.

CC.RR. horses do heavy and tiresome work every day, at all hours, under sun and rain, over plain and mountains: they consume a great amount of energy owing to their work.

To avoid further inconveniences please consider the possibility of having the ration modified as that of the R. Esercito (Army).

I cavalli dei CC.RR. della Sardegna hanno sofferto molto in seguito agli eventi bellici, per cui si sono verificate perdite alte e si lamenta tuttora un accentuato stato di deperimento in numerosi soggetti.

La razione insufficiente e il lavoro pesante saranno causa di un ulteriore decadimento della salute dei quadrupedi da far prevedere perdite non indifferenti.

I cavalli dei CC.RR. sono impegnati in servizi piuttosto duri e faticosi tutti i giorni, in tutte le ore, sotto il sole e la pioggia, in pianura ed in montagna: hanno un forte consumo energetico sotto forma di lavoro che non trova compenso nel potere nutritivo della razione stabilita.

Per evitare danni irreparabili prego di esaminare la possibilità di riportare la razione almeno a quella stabilita per i cavalli del R.Esercito, così modificata:

2. Would you please give instructions for these horses to be collected, as soon as possible. They are at the No. 1 Field Remount Depot, RAVO at Passo Corese, and their telephone number is duplex 683011. The Commanding Officer is Major Gilmot with, and he would like one day's notice before the animals are collected.

3. The price of all surplus horses for sale to the Italian Government is at present under discussion at AFNQ and I regret therefore that it is not possible to quote a firm price at the moment.

4. The financial arrangements will be the same as for horses sold by remount stations to the Ministry of Agriculture.



"We regret to inform you that we cannot allocate the forage which you have requested for the horses used by the Public Security Mounted Police Squadron of Rome. This unit is not in the ceiling of the Italian Army or the CC.RR., therefore, the Ministry of War cannot be responsible for the maintenance of the horses which they use."

3. The matter was then referred to the Allied Food Sub-Commission who made the following comments :-

"Oats is allocated to the Police by the High Commissioner for Food. If anything is wrong with the supplies, let the Police get into touch with Prof. De Marzi, Director General of the High Commissariat for Food, Borgo Pio 104, who has been informed on the matter by this Office." *4-71*

Hay and straw are free items, and there is no control whatsoever. It is suggested for the Police either to purchase them on the free market or to make arrangements with the Italian Commissariato Militare who is responsible for supplying the Army with these items through purchases on the free market."

4. It is hoped that this answer will solve the difficulties.

In accordance with the instructions for other forces of the Armed Forces of the State the U.S. Mounted Guards Squadron, prior to September, 1943, was supplied with forage by the appropriate authorities of the Ministry Commissariat of Bone.

After that date, instructions were made, for issue from the Bone Garrison Commissariat and border provinces, according to a resolution made by the Ministry of Agriculture and Forests, to deposit the animals, for hay and straw, not subject to deposit in the commissariats, directly on the open market according to the availability.

At this Ministry was ordered to re-establish the practice of giving on the military transports, in order to conform to the regulations of the U.S. War Department, it recently interested the Ministry of War in the possibility of an annual supply of forage. The Ministry of War, however, has made known the impossibility of supplying to the units of the present state of supplies, so a request of which the Minister of War himself made for Hay and straw through direct purchases on the market, meeting with serious difficulties, for oats, barley and maize of the kind, through periodical requests to the Allied Land Forces Sub-Commission; with weekly sessions the quantities which one associates indispensable for the horses belonging to the Italian administration.

Some instructions made by the Ministry of Education and Welfare, for their own sake, do not subject to deposit in the ministry. At present, the cash cannot be submitted to the ministry.

As this situation was considered undesirable, the practice of "training" on the military personnel, in order to conform to the requirements of the Ground Forces, it recently interested the Ministry of War in the possibility of an annual camp in Zorge. The Ministry of War, however, has made known the impossibility of securing supplies, as a result of the present state of supplies, of War itself and supplies for the market, meetings with the commandant, direct purchases on the market, meetings with various districts, for oats, barley and maize of the grain, through periodical visits to the Armed Land Forces Commission; which requires the quantities which are absolutely indispensable for the horses belonging to the Ministry Administration.

This being the case, the M.C. is asked **4169** for the higher authorities of the situation exposed at the moment the possibility may be examined of concluding oats, barley and such like horses, to be assigned through the same forces Sub-commission in accordance to the treatment given to the other armed forces of the state.

Subject : Horses for the CC.RR. Strength. Force

To : A.C. Public Safety Sub-Commission - Rome.

After the liberation of Rome, in re-organising the CC.RR. ~~Strength~~, this General HQ. has taken particular care of the reconstruction of the cavalry units and precisely of the Squadron Group of the Rome Legion, of one Squadron of the Rome Cadet Legion and of the cavalry stations of the Rome and Lazio Legions.

The Squadrons Group of the Rome CC.RR. Legion has a particular importance because assigned to the service of public order in the Capital: the Cadet Legion Squadron will function for the cavalry training of the CC.RR. Cadets. The Cavalry stations of the two legions, distributed in the rural centres, carry out a street-activity, which has the purpose to assure the protection of the population and the vigilance on the installations, implements and cattle of the farms, where, especially at present, frequently occur thefts and robberies.

For the Squadrons Group of the Rome Legion, the number of horses has been fixed at at least 180 ( 90 horses for each Squadron); for the Cadet Legion Squadron at 50 horses, for the cavalry stations of the Rome Legion at 108 and for that of the Lazio Legion at 120 horses: totally n. 458 horses.

At the present time the Squadrons Group has n. 142 horses, the Cadet Legion Squadron has none; the cavalry stations of the Rome Legion have 27 and that of the Lazio Legion n. 12. Totally n. 181 horses.

In order to complete the number and to bring a/m units to a real efficiency, n. 277 horses are necessary. In consideration of the present serious difficulties for the supply of horses, we beg the Sub-Commission to kindly examine the possibility of assigning to the CC.RR. strength at least 150 horses to be selected from the group of those which will arrive within a short time from Calabria and already belonged to the Combat Group "Mantova", destined to be distributed among the farmers in consequence of interest

1. At appendix "A" is a strength return of horses in SARDINIA, obtained from Ministry of War on 18 Dec 1944.
2. From appendix "A" it can be seen that if 300 horses were transferred from the CGRR to Allied use, as suggested in your a/m letter, it would be impossible to replace them from horses available in Sardinia.
3. Even if it were desirable, the Ministry of War state that there are no horses on the mainland available for shipping to Sardinia.
4. Public Safety Sub Commission, A.C. state that all existing CGRR horses in Sardinia are needed for police work and that owing to the nature of the country they could not be replaced by motor transport.

1. With reference to report called for by Col. Young, Deputy Director, Public Safety Sub-Commission, Allied Commission, H.Q., I have to inform you that enquiry has been made of the CC.RR. Command in this City and it is stated that no CC.RR. horses are used by any Allied Personnel.

2. The Chief of Staff, Allied Commission, has been granted the use of horses, which are at the present time, on the strength of the Agenti di P.S. Rome.

The original request was for four horses, but I am informed that the numbers are sometimes increased.

Sir Noel Charles and Lady Charles have also been granted the use of horses from this force.

Not more than ten horses have been used on any one day, the period of use is approximately 30 minutes, the animals are exercised in the Vills Borghese, and the Villa Glori.

3. Owing to the numbers of horses on strength, the insufficiency of trained mounted police officers, the fact that these horses are so used by Allied Personnel, is appreciated by the Italian Authorities, as the horses used obviously assist in the exercise program.
