May I suggest that the investigating officer reserves a scheda upon the man and witnesses his signature thereto, and if it subsequently transpires that he is in fact a Squadristi he can be proceeded against in ASD court, which will have the effect of assisting in the immediate removal of the official.

SUBJECT: Disposition of Interned Officials.

TO: Major F. E. Gahland, NSAFD, Region II.

1. The instructions set forth in your letter received by me this morning regarding the above, state in substance those transmitted by me to you on January 11th. These instructions were based upon the conclusion reached in conference held by me with Col. Martin, Public Safety officer of the 15 Army Group, (as AUSA was then known), and were in accordance with a draft set of instructions prepared for the approval of Gen. Alexander, covering the subject of civilian internment in general.

2. Yesterday I learned from Col. Martin that the instructions had not in fact been, but shortly would be issued. The current reorganization may account for the delay. Action by A.S.A. along the lines indicated would be merely in anticipation of formal instructions. As soon as I learn of the publication of the formal instructions, I shall advise you.

3. One comment regarding your paragraph 1 (b). A definite period of internment should not be imposed. Simple internment is enough. Review of cases may be held from time to time which may or may not result in release or conditional release. To fix a definite period of internment at the onset would be to treat such cases as criminal or penal proceedings from which they are to be sharply distinguished in principle.

1. Herewith correspondence referring to the above-named. An investigation of the allegations made is desired as soon as possible.

2. In view of the lapse of time, should your investigation prove that allegations are well-founded, you are authorized to take the matter up with ACP authorities acting locally for remedial action.

3. A report of the investigation and final action taken should be submitted.

REMOVAL OF FASCIST OFFICIALS

One of the most difficult tasks of the Allied Military Government of Naples and the Campania has had to face is the decisions as to which officials should be removed from office on account of Fascist leanings. We have tried to keep in mind two principles: first, we are a military unit and must do all in our power to aid in defeating the enemy. As a part of the Fifth Army, it is our function to assist our Commander, in attaining his mission. To a nation at war, all else is secondary. Second: At the same time our country and our Allies are fighting the pernicious Fascist and Nazi system, and we must put it down and remove its proponents whenever practicable.

It is obviously difficult to decide just who is a Fascist. At one extreme there are individuals who were always active leaders in the Fascist Party administration, holders of high office in the Fascist fabric, many of whom have been continuously connected with the Party since the "March on Rome", and other events of its earlier days. At the other extreme, there are people who had nominal membership in the Fascist Party merely because any failure to do so would have prevented their holding positions of any kind or even drawing pensions which their prior service had earned. Between these two extremes there are all gradations. It is a simple matter to remove men who have always been Fascist leaders, but to remove everyone possessed of a Fascist membership card would be equivalent to removing every office bearer and functionary from civil or military office. Any such extreme step must, in the end, have been embarrassing to our military Commander because administration of civil public office would thereby have been practically paralyzed.

...on his present performance. In some cases an efficient officer, who was Fascist in little more than name, has been retained rather than replaced by a less efficient person who was always an anti-Fascist.

In performing the difficult task of selecting those officials to be removed, AMG has made use of a board of officers drawn from its staff on the basis of experience, judgment and position. Valuable information has been received from various official Italian sources, civilian and military, including the records of the police. The Counter-Intelligence Corps of the U.S. Army and the Field Security Service of the British Army have both given information in many instances.

Since it is a policy of AMG to supervise administration by the Italian officials rather than to do the work outright, we have, wherever practicable, conferred with Italian Prefects and other senior officials in the removal of Fascist officers. Whenever the removal could be effected by the Italians themselves, this has been facilitated. This is, obviously, a rational procedure on the part of any government maintained by an army of occupation. In the list which follows, there are included the names of a certain number of persons who escaped. Some of the office bearers that we had tentatively marked for removal, even prior to our entrance into Naples and other cities, to avoid capture have fled with their German colleagues or otherwise. While this obviated the necessity of our removing them, the same end was attained. The office being vacated, we could appoint appropriate substitutes.

Some of the officials removed were merely put out of office and no further action taken on our part. In other instances, actual arrests have been carried out. Our house-cleaning has only begun, but the task will be less difficult in the future because during the period of our occupation of Naples and the Campania, we have developed many sources of information which render it easier to make decisions as to removals in the future. Moreover, we now have the records of a month's performance of all office holders since the time of our occupation.

In order to make a systematic study of the present and past records of office bearers, functionaries, and other public servants, a questionnaire has been prepared. We require that each individual complete this questionnaire and sign it under oath. Thus, any statements found to be made the bases for trial. On the returns given by the officers themselves, we are able to initiate further studies of present and past activities which might be held objectionable from our standpoint. A copy of this questionnaire is attached.

Trials for persons arrested will take place in the proper Italian courts. Among the charges which will be considered are those of graft, peculation, and malfeasance in office.

I. PREFETTURA

Province of Naples.

1. Domenico Soprano, Prefect when the Allied Forces entered Naples, was removed on 3 October. The office was administered by an Acting Prefect, Nicola Spirito until 1 November when Ernesto Cavaliere was appointed. Spirito was known to have cooperated with the Germans, particularly in the matter of forcing Italians between 19 and 35 to serve in German military labor units.

2. A signed statement dated 5 November 1943 was received from the new Prefect, Cavaliere, stating that all other personnel of the Prefettura are at their respective posts and anxious to cooperate with Allied authorities. AMG will judge on performance.

II. PODESTA (MAYORS)

Province of Naples.

A. The following well known fascist Podesta were removed from office by the Badoglio government between 25 July 1943 and 1 October 1943. Thus AMG did not have to do so. The dates of removal are given.

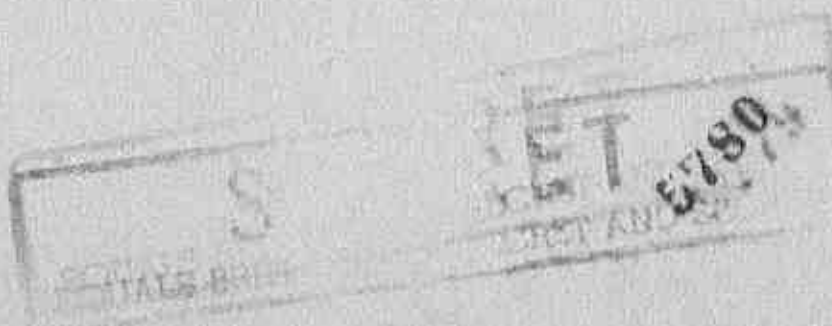
