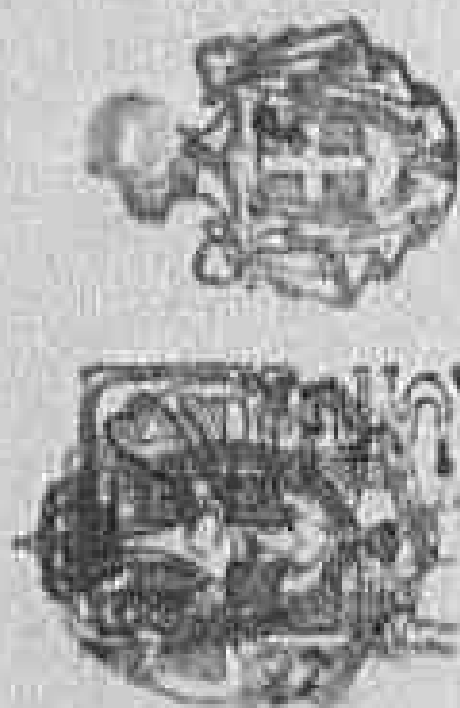

SUBJECT : Progress of the works of the Commission.

The Art. 25 D.L.L. 27 July 1944 No 159 disposes that the proceeding before the 1st Grade Commission must be completed within three months from the date of its beginning. It is moreover to be considered that such proceeding does not begin with the denunciation of the accused to the Commission, but with the notification to the former of the counts of indictment.

On the other hand this is not at all - as generally has been considered - a peremptory limit according to the law (as is that allowed to the accused for pleading against the decisions of the Commission), but a mere term according to the regulations as usually the epuration proceedings should end within three months from the notification of the counts of indictment.

Nevertheless such term practically appeared absolutely inadequate for what concerns the epuration proceedings against CC.RR. officers being of a delicate and complex nature because the officers are charged of collaboration with the enemy.

Besides, as we have already many times stated, there is great difficulty in gathering the elements indispensable for a just and deep judgment.

The witnesses, in majority military, are not always easily found. And when their present residence, often very far from Rome is finally found, it is necessary to apply to offices and commands to collect their statements. Many months may elapse without a reply.

This office since its starting has made every possible

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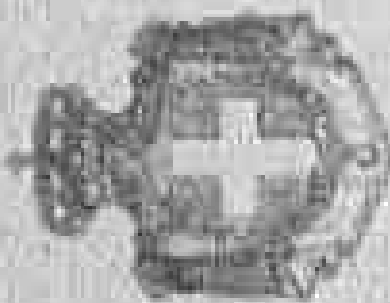

effort to hasten the end of the proceedings in question some of which are still pending (awaiting for a decision) also owing to other causes and precisely because the officers concerned have also to undergo a penal proceeding; thus, in accordance with Art. 3 of the Code of Penal Procedure, the proceedings of epuration should have been suspended.

SUBJECT : Epuration Returns.

TO : Ministry of Interior (A.P.S. & Fire)  
Ministry of War (CC.RM.)

1. DL 702 has decreased the classes of grades officials liable to Epuration and provides as regards non graded officials that the Head of the Service shall declare which appointments are of rank equal to the first seven and consequently liable to Epuration under Art.1.

2. It would seem that Senior foremen should certainly be deleted from the form and quite probably Senior Technicians also. Should Assistant or Deputy Managers be similarly dealt with?

3. It would be appreciated if this matter could be treated as urgent.

TO : Ministry of Interior (A.F.S. & Fire)  
Ministry of War (C.C.Ra.)

1. The attention of the Evacuation Commissions concerned should be drawn to the comparison between the present col (e) as compared with col (d) as at 31 Jul. The time limit for proceedings is three months; it follows therefore that every case in col (d) three months ago should be completed now, and as all cases do not take so long as three months, the total of col (e) should be still larger by the number of cases which have taken less than three months. It would be appreciated if an explanation could be given on why col (e) is so far short of its proper figure.

2. You will please instruct all concerned that in view of DL 702 having come into operation, returns from 30 Nov inclusive will contain only figures relating to grades I to VII and the comparable grades of civilians evacuable under that Decree and that the column "lesser punishments" will be no longer used.

Below the form and not included in the total will be a line "other grades" as to which only cols d,e,f,g,h,i, will be completed.

3. You will realize that the explanations asked for may lie in the facts that grades 3 & 9 are no longer liable normally to Evacuation and that in anticipation of this becoming law these grades have deliberately been allowed to drop behind. Therefore it would be appreciated if the return for the 30 Nov. could be drawn up on the new line as shown above.

Your enquiries cannot be phrased forcefully. The return for 30 Nov on the new line will show this.
