By giving valuable data through me to the American authorities, his anti-Fascism has been established, which I can testify under oath. This was especially so during period 1939 to late summer 1941. WILLIAM PHILLIPS, then American Ambassador in Rome can attest to the great importance of military and political data given by MALAPARTE through me to the Embassy."
