SUBJECT: Arrest of Colonel Di Stefano, Antonio.

TO : Commanding General, Peninsular Base Section.

1. With further reference to your communication of 15 Jan., M., (A.D. 250-2 D-100) and reply thereto from A.G., HQ, M.C.C. of 31 Jan., M., (M.C./112/19), it has now been ascertained that Colonel Di Stefano was not released from custody on 21 Dec. 43 on the authority of the OIC, but on that date was transferred to No. 325 POW Camp at Aversa, and has since been moved to PW Camp 371 at Ischia, in the province of Salerno.
2. OIC report that it has been recommended that Di Stefano be tried by an Italian military court martial on charges of collaborating with the German High Command during the time he held the position of liaison officer between the Italian and German armies.

1. Colonel DI STEFANO, Antonio, was transferred by this office from Poggioreale Prison to PW 326, Aversa on 21 December 1943 and has since been moved to PW Camp 371 in Padula, Province of Salerno. It has been recommended that he be tried by an Italian Military courts-martial on charges of collaborating with the German High Command during the period he held the position of liaison officer between the Italian and German armies.

2. There is no record in the files of this office on Colonel ROSSI, Filippo.

2. Application has been made for their transfer to an Italian Military Prison and for the particulars of charges against them.
3. There is no record here of them having been arrested by either FIFTH or EIGHTH ARMIES and it is thought that arrests may have been made after the FIFTH ARMY had handed over the cities.

With reference to your communication of 15 Jan 44 (AG 250.3 BPDGS) Colonel Di STEFANO Antonio was arrested by the CIC on 17 Nov 43 and lodged in Poggioreale Prison, Naples, whence he was released on the authority of the CIC on 21 Dec 43.

Colonel ROSSI, Filippo is reported to be detained in No. 326 Prisoner of War Camp, AVERSÀ, awaiting disposal by an Italian Military Tribunal.

No information is available as to the charges against either officer but further details are obtainable from CIC Headquarters.
