SUBJECT : Ayroldi Michele.

To.- Chief, Public Safety Sub-Commission,  
A.C.C. Rear Headquarters.

The papers in connection with the above named were forwarded to BRINDISI for necessary action.

Provincial Police Officer reports contact with CC.RR. with the following result.

- (a) There is nothing on the correspondence to say if the man can be arrested for leaving his employment without permission. Such an arrest could be justified under Italian law under certain conditions.
- (b) There is insufficient evidence to justify an arrest for the suspected failure to account for monies and books.
- (c) If the man were approached before it was clear that he could be dealt with under (a) or (b) he would only abscond again before the reply containing the necessary information was received here from Licola.

In the circumstances I think it desirable for such evidence as is available to be addressed to the CC.RR. at Brindisi from the CC.RR. at Licola, which would be the normal course of action. I would like to point out that there is no suggestion of the missing money having been the property of the Allied Government.
