1. P.M.G. AFHQ has received a check for \$160.50 representing 16,050 lire from the Provost Marshal, Seventh Army, with a covering letter which states that it is the property of a civilian named SALERNO, Questore of the Province of Enna, City of Enna, Sicily. The funds were in his possession "at the time of his arrest as a prominent Fascist on or about 24 July 1943". The money was delivered to the Provost Marshal, Seventh Army by Counter Intelligence Corps.

2. G-2 (CI) AFHQ has informed this Hq. that the name of Commandatore SALERNO, Vincenzo, arrested by C.I.C. at Enna on 26 July 1943, appears on a list received from 15th Army Group on 28 Sept. 1943. His whereabouts was not stated.

3. As HQ ACMF may have further facts on the above subject, it is requested that your Hq. investigate and pass to us any information which would enable proper disposition of the funds.
