MEMO

We inform you that on the 24th Feb Italian CC.RR. of the  
PISANO Div arrested at MARTINA FRANCA a YUGOSLAVIAN civilian: VALCOVICI  
Joseph who was trying to induce the soldiers of the Div to join  
YUGOSLAVIAN partisan units.

Interrogation resulted in the following particulars:

- s/a VALCOVICI formerly belonged to a YUGOSLAV partisan unit.
- was taken prisoner by the Italians and had escaped from a POW camp at the time of the Armistice.

It has been ascertained that he is a member of a really clandestine organisation, and that he has a friend at BARI who is in possession of trucks to facilitate the escape of soldiers.

He is considered responsible for the desertion of several soldiers of SLAV origin.
