With reference to the request of execution, we are returning the four copies of warrant of arrest regarding said persons and inform you that they have not been found in this city.- Reg. Rota residing in Rome since 22.1.44 at via A. Giulio Barrili n. 41, where he occupied the flats N.12 and N.13 communicating with one another. He left his apartment and has never returned. It is rumoured, that he lives in La Spezia or Venice, where he is working for the Germans and for the Republican Fascist Navy.

Giampieri Giovanni, not completely identified in the warrant of arrest, is known as Giampieri Giovanni di Narciso and Coochini Maria, born in S. Giovanni Valdarno the 2.8.1908, lyric actor, residing in Milano. He has been in this city (Rome) for only one night from 16.12.43 to 17.12.43 at the Milano Hotel in Via Montecitorio. Leaving the Hotel he said that he was going to Piombino.

A certain Cauccia Giovanni, residing in Via A. Ferri 13, has been ordered by Rota to separate the two flats; the flat n. 13 has been leased to Cabrusà Giorgio fu Antonio and di Buggioni Evelina, born at Milano the 1.5.1891, businessman, who resides there at the present time, while the other flat contains the furniture of Rota.

Reference orders of that High Commission all the property existing in the flat n.12 has been confiscated. Inventory of the furniture confiscated has been listed on the confiscation-papers. All doors have been locked.

Cabrusà has been appointed as trustee of the furniture. He tells that many pieces of the furniture has been requisitioned by Capt. Robert Forgan Prigge of the Allied Force M.C. Rome, showing a receipt therefore. This has been noted in the requisition paper. He added that many objects belonging to Rota are still in his flat; said objects listed in the minute have been levied upon.

The keys of the inner doors are in this Office, while the key of the entrance door is in possession of Scarpitti Flavia fu Pasquale and di Filonella Colarossi, born at Foccaraso the 27.6.1911, residing in via Nicasoli 19. Said Scarpitti declared that her fiancé Dr. Palladino Umano, official of Court of "Conti", residing in via Napoleone II 8385, received the keys of said apartment from the owner of the apartment Marchesa Maris Marconi, as per contract dated 21.6.1944. A judgment against the Giovannattista of Pietro from Piombino, residing in Rome, Vincenzo Giulio Parravicini, and his last Giannieri Giulio has been guilty of co-operation after having, during 29th October 1943, availed themselves of the political situation caused by the fascism and by the war, sacked the house of Giovanni Costanzi at Montebello (Livorno) robbing valuable articles, jewelry and artistic articles to the value of about 6 millions of lire.

The first mentioned person is also guilty of having, before the 8th September 1943, given active help and collaboration to the Germans.

Through instruction, it results that the following articles were to be found in the residence of Rota, so, the High Commissioner orders that all goods found in the habitation of Rota, should be sequestered. The Justice of Rome has been sole cited to proceed to the sequestration.
