Information is required by this HQ about the whereabouts of the under-mentioned:

- (a) Giulio FLORIS Age: 44, ex employee Banco di Roma in Lattakia 1937-38 and in Beirut 1938-39. He transferred in 1939 to the Adriatica Shipping Co., and remained with them until 1941 except for a short period of internment by the French in 1940. On the occupation of Syria by the Allies he fled to Turkey and then to Italy. He returned to Athens as the representative of his old firm the Adriatica Company. His brother believes that he may now be at the family home at ~~Calamiano~~, Calabria, Italy. Giulio is described as a known fascist, and while he was at Athens corresponded clandestinely with his relations in Beirut.
- (b) Carlo BRUGHERA - Age. 40. He was formerly employed as works surveyor by the Beirut Tramway and Electricity Co. In 1941 he left Syria for Turkey and went on immediately to Italy.
