

1. On 21 July 44 Gennili Bruno appeared before a Court at Capua charged by the 75 Coy C.M. (T.C.) The charge was in connection with 2 W.D. tyres on his car Bianchi No. 3.9. 50363 Roma which he was driving when arrested at the junction of routes 6 & 7.

2. According to our information accused was remanded on bail "for Tribunal." Further investigations revealed that the case was sent to the Procura del Regno of Santa Maria C. V. and from there all papers were forwarded to the Procura del Regno Rome on the grounds that the matter was within Rome jurisdiction.

3. Will you please make enquiries as to the progress of this case and the result, if any. At the same time please ask the Procura del Regno the legal grounds for the transfer of the case to Rome.

1. Receipt is acknowledged of your letter ref. No. 23 Prot. of 5 Sep 44 on the above subject.

2. With reference to and in further amplification of my letter reference ACC/4083/1/L of 14 Aug 44 the following information is taken from a letter written by Capt. Rutter commanding 75 Coy C.M.F. (T.C.) reference No. 75/TC/C/1/2 dated 1 Aug 44.

"On 21 July 44, at the Civil Court, CAPUA, GERELLI Brune was charged by this unit with driving a civilian car, Bianchi No. S. 9. 53353 ROMA, which had on it two British W.D. tires, at the junction of routes 6 and 7. The civilian was remanded for Tribunal, and the case has not yet been heard."

3. From this it is presumed that GERELLI's case was in the first instance heard by the Pretura at CAPUA who remanded the case for trial by the Tribunale.

4. Will you please take action :

(a) To cause a full investigation to be made into the records of the Pretura and of the Tribunale at CAPUA to see if this case has been tried or not, and if tried to discover by what court.

(b) If the case has not been tried and the 75 Coy C.M.F. (T.C.) are still in the area, to obtain a full statement from them of all the facts of the case.

(c) In any event if the case has not been tried, to bring all possible pressure to bear on the

2. He was released on 10.000 lire bail and, according to my information, he was "remanded for tribunal" i.e. presumably the case was transferred to the Italian courts.

3. There is a little more than meets the eye in this case, as it appears that the owner of the car is a Lt. TAGLIOLI Luigi of RR.CO., Tivoli, working under AMG.

4. Will you please make arrangements for the early trial of the case and communicate the result to this sub-Commission.

On 21 July 42 at the Civil Court CAPUA, Geroni Bruno was charged by this unit with driving a civilian car Bianchi No S.9. 55353 ROMA, which had on it two British MD tyres, at the junction of Routes 6 and 7. The civilian was remanded for Tribunal, and the case has not yet been heard.

On 1st Aug 42 Lt TANCIONI Luigi, apparently the owner of the car in question, and head of the 31 RH TIVOLI in company with Geroni Bruno, who had been released from gaol on 10,000 lire bail, delivered to this Coy HQ the attached letter from AMG Tivoli. He was told by this office that the car would not be released, but that the matter would be referred to higher authority, and your instructions are awaited please.

On the date the case was originally heard in Capua, the Judge, after a conversation with Geroni Bruno's lawyer, asked that the car be delivered to the Carabinieri and held there until the case be heard by the Tribunal. This was opposed by the Company Commander, and the car was retained, and is held at this Coy HQ.

The whole thing, to say the least, appears extremely fishy, and nothing yet has been heard regarding the date of trial. The Company Commander is rather of the opinion that unless this case be further pressed and also that the car be retained at this HQ, nothing further will be done by the Civil Authorities.




