TRANSLATION

Rome, 27 September 1946.

Excellency,

Mrs Maria Del Fabro, living in Rome, via Crazio 21, has been deprived of the licence for renting one of her rooms following the arrest of her daughter, Miss Giuseppina Del Fabro.

As results from the enclosed memorandum, this arrest was not due to a real crime, but because the girl had been a victim in good faith of the intermediary Cav. Piombino who confirmed in the court her statements proving that she was not guilty. Presently, she has been granted temporary freedom, but lives - and with her also her mother - in the most squalid poverty, having sold first all the superfluous, then all the necessary and even having made a big debt.

We beg you to save from complete ruin a mother and a daughter whose innocence and honesty have not been able to avoid prison and infamy. Wishing to remain honest, the two women appeal to your kind heart and understanding and supplicate you as a husband and a father to get them back the licence before the trial, so that they may at least cover part of their expenses for food.

The licence is in the hands of the Questore of Rome. Should I be asking too much, could you at least give me a letter of recommendation for the Chief of the Italian Police, Mr Ferrari?
