Rome

We inform you that in the Penal House of VOLterra, province of Pisa, is detained the antifascist DI VIRGILIO Domenico of the late Vito, from Cerignola (Foggia). He was arrested at Marsiglia by the occupying Italian Authorities on 4th April 1943 and was convicted by the Military Tribunal of the IV Army to 8 years of prison " for purchasing arms and ammunitions from an Italian soldier.

The political appearance of DI VIRGILIO Domenico, the date of the arrest, the court which sentenced him, show distinctly the political character of the sentence itself. It would be a serious injustice to detain the patriot DI VIRGILIO any longer.

Therefore we ask the Allied Control Commission to intervene and take action in order that the patriot DI VIRGILIO can be immediately released.
