1. Cases are occurring of civilians arriving in Italy by air without entry of transit visas.
2. Two examples are the arrival at Bari airport on 19 Feb. 1946 of Mr. Isaac M. Frances, Bulgarian national, Movement Order No. 38436 - 16 Feb. 46 - and Mr. Isaac D. JEROMAN, Bulgarian national, Movement Order No. 28436 - 16 Feb. 46.
3. It is pointed out that all persons other than British or American service personnel should be in possession of an Italian passport or visa when arriving in the country; and persons arriving without the necessary visa are liable to cause considerable inconvenience not only to the authorities in Italy but also to themselves.
4. It would therefore be appreciated if a strict check could be made to ensure that all passengers leaving for Italy are properly documented.
