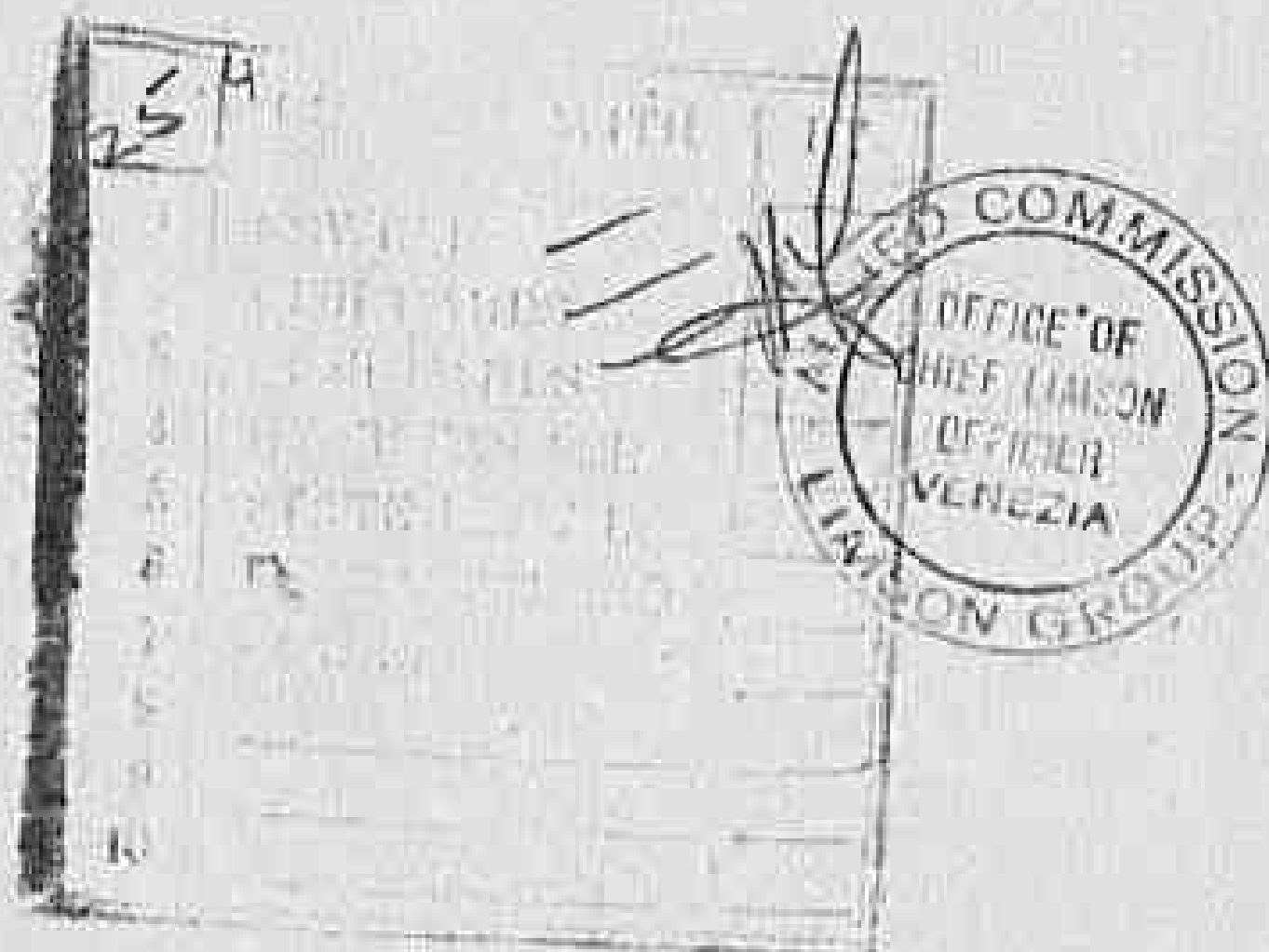
The attached application signed by the Questore, Venezia is passed to you for your attention.

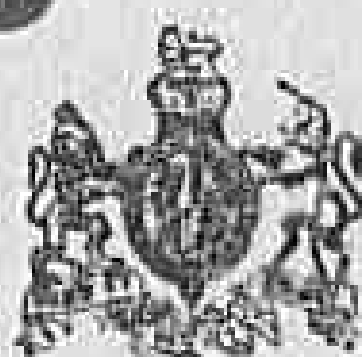

1. Your GBI 389 - 506/18 - E - 5 of 28 February.
2. We much regret any inconvenience caused by the arrival of the SCHALLYs in ITALY without Italian transit visas.
3. We did not however receive your circular AG 322/19 GBI - 0 of 27 November 1945 until 7 February and on 6 February, when we issued the SCHALLYs with AFHQ permits, we had not yet received the new instructions. The SCHALLYs were in fact the last passengers to leave with AFHQ permits and we have always ensured that passengers for ITALY have a visa or permit for that country before embarkation here.

1. Cases are occurring of civilians arriving in Italy by air without entry or transit visas.

2. Two examples are the arrival at Bari airport on 19 February 1946 of Mr and Mrs SCHALLY, Polish nationals. Movement Order # 38268 issued 7 February 1946.

3. It is pointed out that all persons other than British or American service personnel should be in possession of an Italian passport or visa when arriving in the country; and persons arriving without the necessary visa are liable to cause considerable inconvenience not only to the authorities in Italy but also to themselves.

4. It would be therefore appreciated if a strict check could be made to ensure that all passengers leaving for Italy are properly documented.

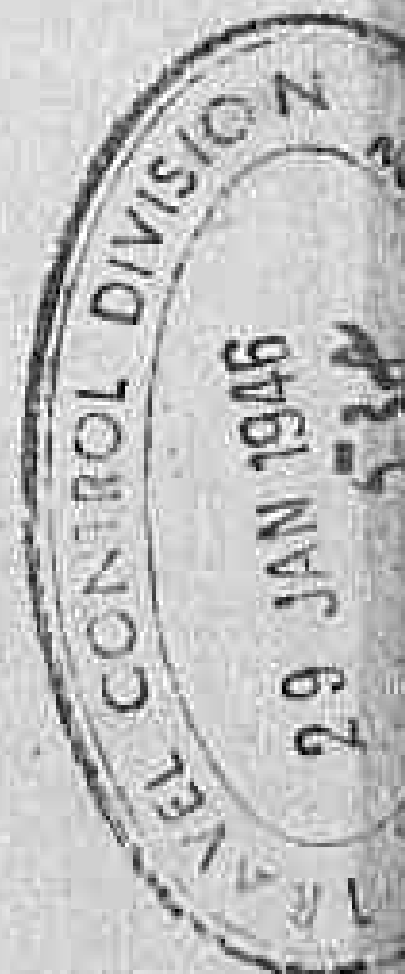

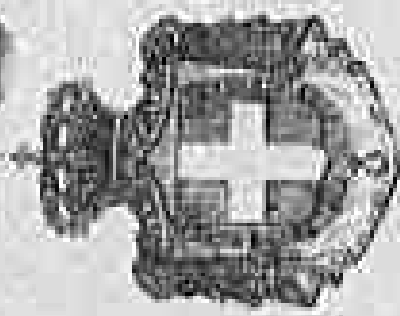

Information has been received from M. Romer, former Polish Minister of Foreign Affairs in London /up to Nov. 1944/. that he has heard that Countess Zoltowska, wife of Lt. Zoltowska A.D.C. to Comd. 14 Armoured Brigade, and her two children are in Bucharest, and in very difficult financial circumstances.

This information has been supplied to M. Romer by M. Le Rougelet, who he says, is British representative in Roumania. Further confirmation has been received by a letter from Lt. Col. E.C. Masreson, British Mission, Bucharest.

M. Romer quotes as follows from M. Le Rougelet's letter:
"En ce qui concerne la Comtesse Zoltowska, il paraît que son mari est en Italie et du moment que nous recevrons l'autorisation du Quartier Général polonais qui - a ce qu'il paraît - contrôle très strictement le mouvement des familles, nous demanderons un permis de sortie pour la faire parvenir à Bari dans un de nos avions militaires. Maintenant que le mari est retrouvé, je ne crois pas que le problème présentera beaucoup de difficultés. Dans tous les cas nous sommes en contact avec Madame Zoltowska entre temps."

Of the categories of military personnel which you mention, only such personnel as are assigned or attached to this Headquarters are present in RUMANIA. In my opinion, dependents of this personnel should be freely authorized to travel into this area provided only that in each case, ACC clearance to enter RUMANIA is first secured from this Headquarters.

In this connection, it may be of interest to know that families of many Soviet Officers on duty with ACC are present in RUMANIA, as are also families of US State Department Representatives, British Political Representatives and certain Senior British Army Officers on duty with ACC.
