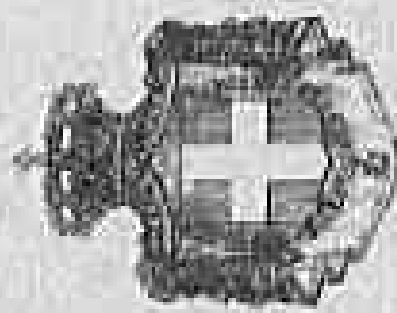

MEMORANDUM FOR THE ALLIED COMMISSION

SUBJECT: Alleged Italian representative to Hungary Sig. ROSSI Giovanni.

1. Reference is made to your note GBI.389-506/18-E-7 dated 27 May 1946.

2. The Ministry for Foreign Affairs has never confided to Sig. ROSSI (not ORSSI) Giovanni an appointment, and therefore he has never had the authority to issue Italian visas.

3. Sig. ROSSI, according to information received by the Ministry for Foreign Affairs, formed in Budapest, on his own initiative, when the town was liberated, a "Free Italy Committee", which carried out aid activities in favour of Italians, civilians and military, residing there. This information has been passed to you with Memorandum 6/4293/1986 dated 2 November 1945.

4. Later on Sig. ROSSI received from the Italian Post War Aid Ministry the appointment of taking care of repatriation of Italian military personnel. Such appointment did in no way confer to Signor ROSSI an official qualification, and has been recently revoked by the foregoing Ministry.

5. The Hungarian Government has been duly informed of this decision through the Italian Mission in Vienna and the Hungarian Consulate in that town.

4. Later on Sig. ROSSI received from the Italian Post War Aid Ministry the appointment of taking care of repatriation of Italian military personnel. Such appointment did in no way confer to Signor ROSSI an official qualification, and has been recently revoked by the foregoing Ministry.

5. The Hungarian Government has been duly informed of this decision through the Italian Mission in Vienna and the Hungarian Consulate in that town.

6. Recently an agreement has been reached between the Italian and the Hungarian Governments for the exchange of Missions entrusted with the repatriation of nationals. The Hungarian Mission has just arrived in Rome and the Italian one is about to leave. This Mission to Hungary is the first having an official character.

Ref your letter HCM/LW dated 4 June 1946 regarding the application on the part of Mrs; Elizabeth PITTERMAN to travel to ITALY to join Mrs. Mary Marshall in ROME.

We regret to have to inform you that Mrs. MARSHALL is incorrect in stating that the British Military Mission here can arrange an Italian Entry Permit by cabling to the A.C.C. in ROME. The correct procedure for anyone travelling from here to ITALY is for them to obtain an Italian visa from the local Italian Representative, Signor ROSSI, who is authorised to grant it on behalf of the Italian Government.

The only way in which this Mission comes into the matter is that, in order to go to ITALY, Mrs. PITTERMAN must travel through the British Zone of Austria, for which she requires an Allied Military Permit for transit, which we are only authorised to grant on production of both Hungarian Passport and Italian Entry Visa on the part of the person concerned.

It is regretted that we cannot assist further. We are re-emphasizing to Mrs. PITTERMAN to-day, that her first step must be to approach the Italian Representative here.
