Germaine LAMBERT - PORTER.

TO : British Consulate General (Visa Section) Algiers.

1. We refer to your letters T/281 of 16 Jan and T/136
of 30 Jan and our letters GBI-389.506/PF/ BLACKIE dated 22
Jan and 5 Feb.

2. Families Scheme "B", details of which were published
on 28 Jan now offers certain privileges to wives and families
of British service personnel, whether British or foreign
born. Such privileges include free passages within the
theatre to enable them to join entitled British service
personnel, subject to the fulfillment of certain conditions
and availability of accommodation.

3. Applications will normally be made by service
personnel to their formations or districts, and on receiving
lists of families of approved applicants, resident in areas
to which the Allied Force Permit system applies, we will
arrange clearance with the Italian Government, and notify
permit issuing agencies accordingly.
