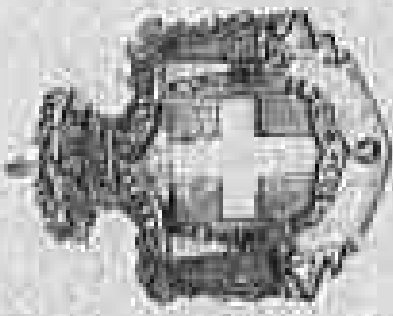

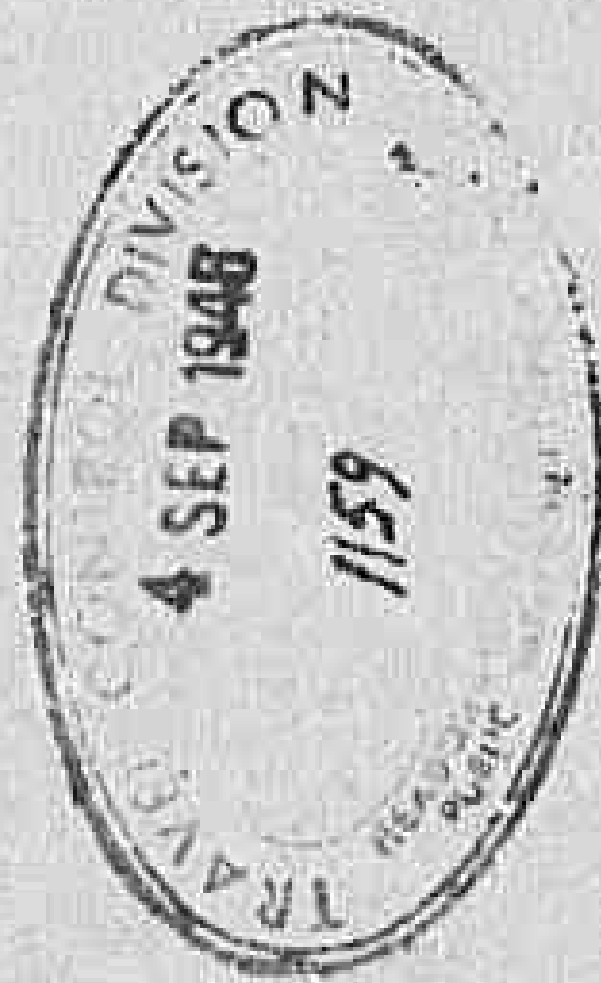

1. Reference is made to your letter H.443/54201 dated 19th July and to this Headquarters letter GHI 389-506/188 dated 3 August 1946 addressed to the President of the Council of Ministers.

2. On orders of the Supreme Allied Commander, Polish Military and para-military personnel are to be permitted entry into Italy from Allied occupied territory and the Middle East on the production of military movement orders.

3. It would, therefore, be appreciated if very urgent consideration could be given to this question and if, as the result of the letter dated 3rd August 1946 from this Headquarters referred to in para 1 above, Public Safety Agents at Airports, sea-ports and frontiers are informed at a very early date of this new exception to the requirements of Italian visas for entering into Italy.

My dear Mr. Prime Minister,

It has been brought to the notice of the Supreme Allied Commander that Polish Military and para-military personnel of 2 Polish Corps wishing to return to Italy from the Middle East and from Allied Occupied Europe are being denied entry because of the Italian Government's refusal to issue visas. I understand that representations on this subject have also been made to the Ministry for Foreign Affairs by the British Embassy.

These persons are required to enter Italy in the performance of their normal military duties. Many of them are required now to join their units in Italy in order to accompany them to the United Kingdom. Their delay in rejoining their units in Italy is likely therefore to prolong the stay of Polish personnel in this country.

The Supreme Allied Commander has therefore directed me in the absence of the Chief Commissioner to explain to you that the current move of 2 Polish Corps from Italy makes the free movement of Polish military and para-military personnel between Middle East, Allied Occupied Europe, and Italy a military necessity on the same terms as presently apply to British and American military personnel.

In view of this military necessity the Supreme Allied Commander is issuing orders forthwith for the resumption of movement of Polish military and para-military personnel in Italy and the Allied travel control section have been informed that such personnel are authorised by the Supreme Allied Commander to enter Italy on production of military movement orders.

I am to assure you that this travel will be under the control of the Allied military authorities and that such personnel will either return to their proper stations outside Italy on completion of their missions or will leave Italy with 2 Polish Corps in the normal manner. Their stay in Italy therefore will be purely transitory as November 1st 1946 is the target date by which the essential moves of 2 Polish Corps will be completed.

1. It has been brought to the notice of the Supreme Allied Commander that Polish military and para-military personnel of 2 Polish Corps wishing to return to ITALY from the Middle East and from Allied occupied Europe are being denied entry because of the Italian Government's refusal to issue visas.
2. These persons are required to enter ITALY in the performance of their normal military duties. Many of them are required now to rejoin their units in ITALY, in order to accompany them to the United Kingdom. Their delay in rejoining their units in ITALY is likely therefore to prolong the stay of Polish personnel in that country.
3. The Supreme Allied Commander directs therefore that you approach the Italian Government and explain that the current move of 2 Polish Corps from ITALY makes the free movement of Polish military and para-military personnel between Middle East, Allied occupied Europe, and ITALY a military necessity, on the same terms as presently apply to British and American military personnel.
4. You are requested to inform the Italian Government that in view of this military necessity, the Supreme Allied Commander is issuing orders forthwith for the resumption of movement of Polish military and para-military personnel to ITALY.
5. You may assure the Italian Government that this travel will be under the control of Allied military authorities and that such personnel will either return to their proper stations outside ITALY on completion of their missions or will leave ITALY with the Corps in the normal manner. November 1st 1946 is the target date by which essential moves will be completed.
6. The travel control section of your Headquarters is to be informed that military and para-military personnel of 2 Polish Corps are authorised by the Supreme Allied Commander to enter ITALY on production of military movement orders.
7. I am to request that the matter be treated urgently.

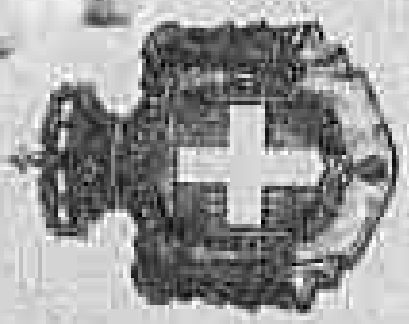

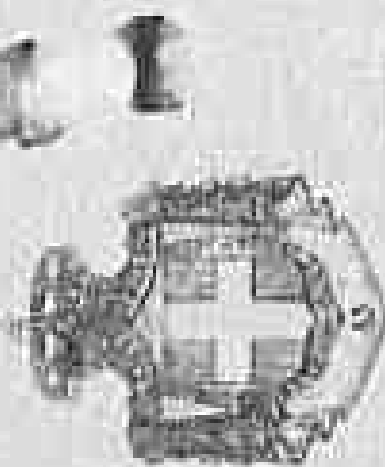

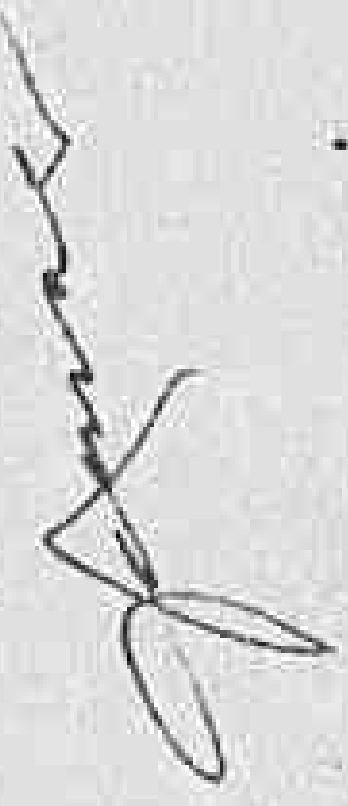

4. Furthermore it is desired to point out to the Liaison Section of your Headquarters that there are no restrictions imposed by this Commission on Polish or any other personnel entering Italy. The right of approving or disapproving entry into Italy of all personnel other than American or British Service personnel in possession of travel orders was given the Italian Government by the Supreme Allied Commander in March of this year.
5. The Italian Government's comments or concurrence will be forwarded your office as soon as they are received by this office.

1. In view of the imminent move of the II Polish Corps out of Italy a certain amount of travel will be necessary between the Middle East and Italy on matters pertaining to duty and the coordination of plans in connection with the proposed move.

2. It is felt that the smooth and efficient running of any plans for the future disposal of the Polish Corps will be hampered by the length of time it takes to obtain the Italian Government's authority for entry into Italy.

3. The Allied Force Headquarters have therefore requested this office approach the Italian Government with a view to allowing for the next six months Polish Military Personnel on duty to enter Italy from the Middle East on the production of travel orders, the normal requirement for American and British Service personnel.

4. It would be appreciated if your views on this suggestion could be forwarded this office at your earliest convenience.

1. It must be realized that in view of the imminent move of 2 Polish Corps out of this theatre a certain amount of travel will be necessary between ME and CMF on matters pertaining to duty and the coordination of plans in connection with the proposed move.
2. At present restrictions are imposed by ALCOM and the Italian Government obliging all Polish personnel to be in possession of visas to enter Italy.
3. It is felt that this restriction will tend to hamper the smooth and efficient running of any plans for the future disposal of 2 Polish Corps.
4. It is therefore recommended that for the period of the next six months all Poles travelling on duty or leave to Italy from ME should be afforded facilities of travel commensurate with those already in existence for British and American personnel.
