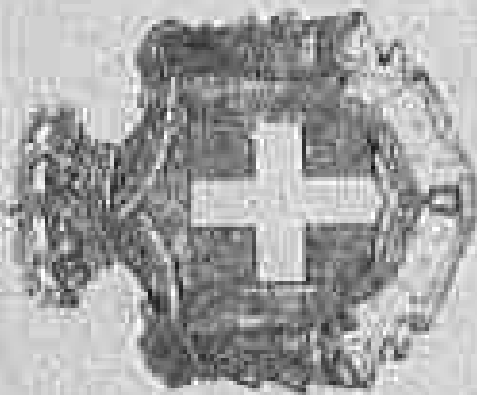
1. Information has been received that the British and the United States Governments are at present arranging for the repatriation of all Japanese diplomats from Europe, and it is hoped that it will be possible to send them back to the Far East on the Spanish ship SS. "Plus Ultra", which is expected to sail from Naples on the 28 January.
2. A party of 75 set out from Stockholm on the evening of January 20th in order to arrive by road in Naples on January 27th. This party is travelling via Germany and France and their route from NICE will be via PISA-ROMA to NAPLES.
3. The party will be travelling on a collective passport and will take with them single passports for identification purposes. A Swedish official of the Nordiska Regeringen and a member of the staff of the United States Legation in Stockholm representing the Inter-Allied Committee which deals with Japanese affairs there. Petrol is being provided for the whole route and the Swedish authorities will also arrange for feeding.
4. It is requested that you give this party every facility for entering Italy and to proceed as quickly as possible to Naples. It is further noted that the number of Japanese may exceed 75 by the time they arrive in Italy as diplomats from Germany and France may join them en route. This Office has already been notified that the Japanese Ambassador in Austria KENSO INOUE and his wife and daughter will be coming to Italy through the Brenner Pass during the next four days for this purpose.
5. Conversations J/C WILLMOTT-Lt. FAZIOLO for the Ministry of the Interior, and Conte FARRICOTTI for the Ministry of Foreign Affairs on 22 January refer.
