1. I attach particulars of two cases of persons wishing to come to Italy from Canada passed to us from our office in Washington. The information given is obviously incomplete and not in a form in which they can be presented to any authority in Italy.

2. We recently submitted a case (LEHMAN) to Civil Affairs Section AC under the general subject "Entry of Civilians into Italy" covered by AC/14022/2/F3 of the 20th June 1945, but were informed that it had been passed to you and that the procedure given in the above-mentioned letter no longer applied. We do not know what the proper procedure now is in such cases.

3. The object of this letter is to establish procedure rather than to deal with the individual cases.

4. Apart from the practical details of travel facilities, payment for, quotas and priorities, etc. we want to know whether permission on principle to enter and remain in Italy must still be obtained from your branch of AFHQ or whether we should deal direct with the Italian Government authorities as regards the desirability or otherwise of each particular case. If the latter, will you please say what channel of approach to the Italian Government is indicated.

MR. AND MRS. GUILLAUME SAND.

Rumanians by birth, later German nationals by naturalization, expatriated, lived in Italy from January, 1934 till April, 1939, when they had to leave Italy on account of the newly adopted racial laws, found refuge in Tangiers, later in 1944, were temporarily admitted to Canada as war refugees. They had applied for naturalization in Italy in 1938; Mrs. Sand is a graduate in medicine of the University of Milano.

The Sands are anxious to return to Italy and to settle there permanently.

UNRRA officials in the Displaced Persons Division Washington stated that they cannot aid Mr. and Mrs. Sand, as this couple left Italy before the war started and cannot, hence, be considered as "victims of war".

MR. GIUSEPPE LEVI.

Italian national by birth, had found refuge in England after the racial laws had come into force, then found himself among the group of refugees interned and sent to Canada by the British Government. Later he was released and given a temporary immigration permit, to be extended every year.

Mr. Levi has heard that his family has survived in Italy and now feels it his duty to return. His father, we understand, is employed with the Allied Military Government in Italy. Mr. Levi's case would appear to be a clear case of repatriation of a war refugee.

It is not stated when Mr. Levi left Italy, but if he left before the outbreak of war, it would no doubt be the conclusion of UNRRA officials in the Displaced Persons Division Washington that he cannot be considered as a "victim of war", and that therefore they cannot aid him. Even if he left after the war began and could be considered a "victim of war", it is very doubtful whether UNRRA would undertake to repatriate him, as he is now in Canada.

Application is made for the above-mentioned person, particulars of whom are given below:

- (who is now in Portugal)*
1. Mr. Friedrich Lehmann wishes to return to Milan, Italy, where he resided up to October 1940, and was obliged to leave because of the so-called racial laws at that time.
 2. Mr. Lehmann, who is of Jewish faith, was born in Boryslaw, District Drohobycz, Austria-Hungary, on September 28, 1886. He lost his Austrian nationality due to a Nazi decree on February 11, 1942.
 3. Earlier this year, he applied for an Italian visa and was informed by the Italian Consul in Portugal that this will be granted providing he succeeds in obtaining a navicert to Italy. The British Passport Control Office, Lisbon, wrote to their headquarters in London under date of July 4, 1945, requesting a navicert for Mr. Lehmann.
 4. IGCR London heard from the Foreign Office that the Passport Control Department authorized Mr. Lehmann's departure to Italy by telegram to Lisbon on the 23rd August.
 5. Documents in possession of Lehmann are as follows: 1938.
 - (1) Carta d'identita No. 359365 di Comune di Milano, del 5 Agosto/
 - (2) Carte de Legitimation No. 89 della Camera di Commercio, Milano.
 - (3) Legitimazione del Circolo Fologico, Milano del 1 Ottobre 1911
