3. The persons featuring in this list fall broadly into two main classes: firstly, those who, by virtue of the official appointments which they hold or have recently held, must be regarded as almost certainly pro-fascist and allied to a dangerous degree; and secondly, other persons of some prominence or influence, about whom specific information is available as to their activities or sentiments which indicates the likelihood of their endangering our security, irrespective of their official appointment, if any.

7. The addresses of each person listed is shown, if known, but it is probable that the majority will flee before the arrival of the Allies and that they will be encountered in towns other than those shown.

8. In cases where the exact address of these persons is known and shown, they have been or will be included also in the J(II)/CI target lists issued by this HQ for specific towns or areas.

9. Supplements to this Black List will be issued from time to time, as further information becomes available.

10. Sufficient copies of this Black List are issued to allow for distribution on the same scale as CI bulletins, viz. one to each CIO Section and I.S. Detachment.
