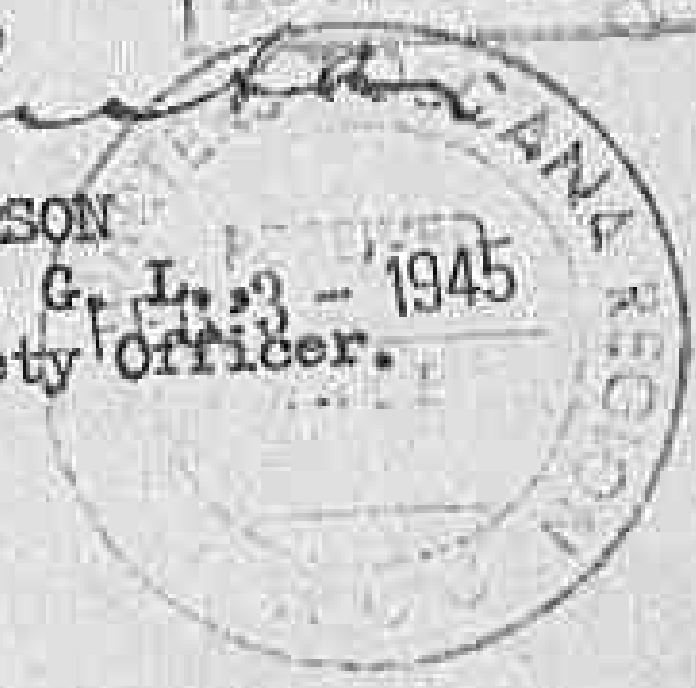

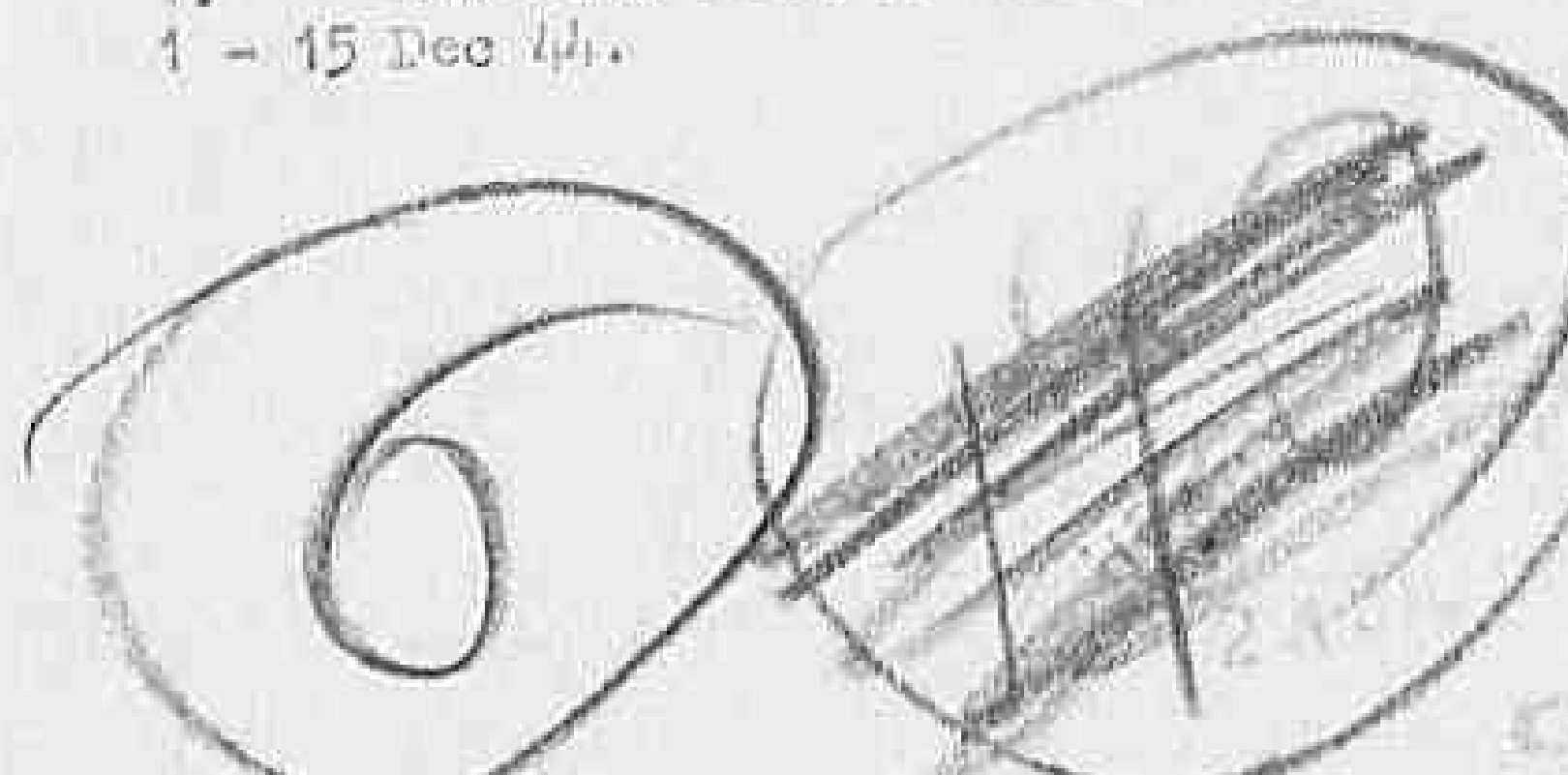

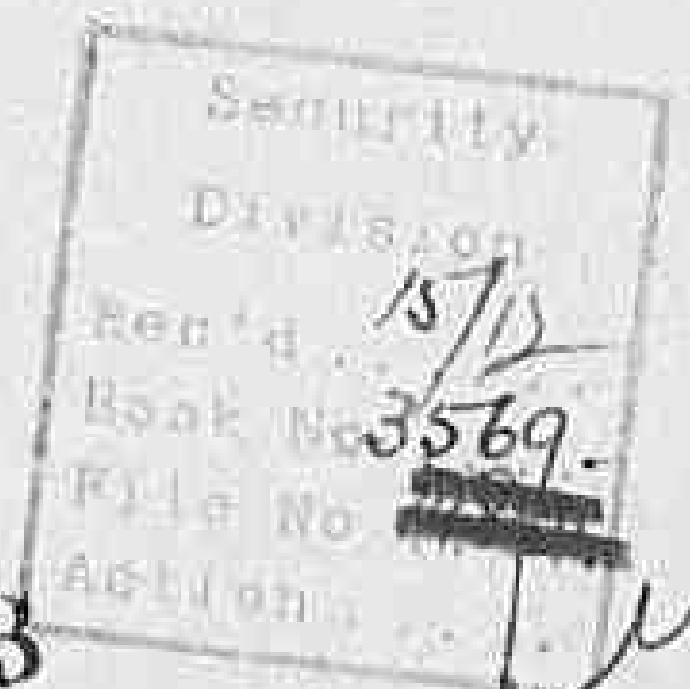

This individual, although elderly, should be arrested and extremely severe sentence of imprisonment."

Germans were frequent visitors to his house at CINGOLI (prev. ROMA) (M.S. 340420) and he was concerned with them in the burning of a house belonging to a patriot whom he had denounced. DE RICCIO is not considered to be dangerous in a big way, but he is an extremely unpleasant type."
