1. The policy of this office for certifying German protected personnel is based upon the strict adherence to the Red Cross "Convention of Geneva of July 27, 1929, for the Amelioration of the Condition of the Wounded and Sick of Armies of the Field", Chapter III, Articles 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and Chapter VI, Article 21.

2. There are three groups of personnel which may be classified as protected personnel: Military personnel of sanitary formations and establishments; recognized volunteer aid societies; and Chaplains attached to the armies. In all cases where certification of protected personnel is being considered, documentary proof is necessary. This documentary identification should be uniform and of the same type.

a. MILITARY PERSONNEL

- (1) The German Wehrmacht issues to military personnel of sanitary formations and establishments in addition to their service record ("Soldbuch") a special document of identification ("Personalausweis"). Acceptable for certification is either the service record ("Soldbuch") or the special document of identification ("Personalausweis"). There are two types of special documents of identification ("Personalausweis"). The first type (Photostat I) certifies that the individual is exclusively employed in sanitary service. The second type (Photostat II) certifies that the individual has received special training as an auxiliary letter bearer or auxiliary aid man and is to be used when necessary in the removal, transportation, and treatment of the wounded and sick. Military personnel possessing such identification (Photostat II) will be certified as protected personnel provided it can be established by American authority that they were performing above mentioned duties when captured.

- (2) In evaluation the special document ("Personalausweis") for documentary proof, it must be of linen (or of at least partial linen content), duly signed and authenticated by the stamped seal of the German High Command, and emblazoned with a red cross, the accepted distinctive sign of the sanitary services of the Wehrmacht.
- (3) In evaluating the service record, ("Soldbuch") for documentary proof, there must be entered on page 1 the notation that the individual is in the "Sanitätsdienst" (serves in the sanitary corps) and on page 4 or 17 that he has a sanitary corps assignment.

b. RECOGNIZED VOLUNTEER AID SOCIETIES

- (1) Members of recognized volunteer aid societies are furnished by competent military authority with a certificate ("Personalausweis") and an employment booklet ("Verwendungsbuch") which contains their photograph and attests to their sanitary status.
- (2) In the case of personnel of volunteer aid societies the employment booklet ("Verwendungsbuch") is always necessary for certification as this document contains the necessary photograph. This employment booklet ("Verwendungsbuch") is only acceptable if signed and stamped by authorities mentioned in paragraph 3, page 1 of booklet and equipped with a photograph on the inner page of the front cover and the same stamp and signature found on page 5 is duplicated on page 20.
- (3) The certificate ("Personalausweis") of the recognized volunteer aid society members need not necessarily be of linen content but must be emblazoned with a red cross and authenticated with the stamped seal of the German High Command. The certificate ("Personalausweis") however is only acceptable in conjunction with the employment booklet ("Verwendungsbuch").

c. CHAPLAINS ATTACHED TO THE ARMED FORCES

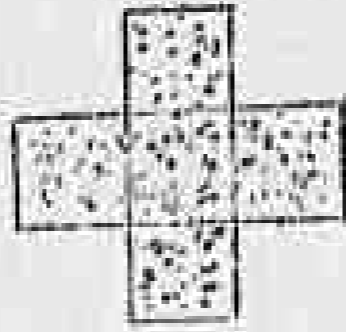

- (1) Chaplains should have in their possession a special certificate and/or service record to establish satisfactorily their protected status.
- (2) In evaluating the service record ("Soldbuch"), there must be entered on page 1 the notation that the individual is a chaplain attached to the armed forces and on page 4 or 17 that he has an assignment as chaplain.

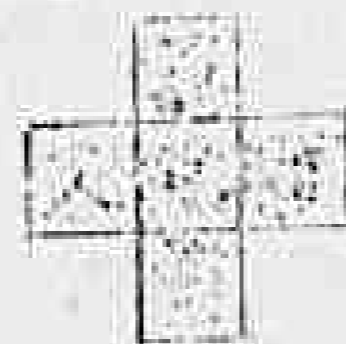
