SUBJECT: "Comitato Onoranze Martiri Cefalonia" (Committee for Honoring the Martyrs of Cefalonia).

In this City the "Comitato Onoranze Martiri di Cefalonia" has been formed with temporary office in Via Vetriera a Chiaia n. 15, with the aim to erect a monument in memory of the Italian massacred by the Germans in Cefalonia, collect information concerning the dead and the dispersed and help the most needy ex POWs with a fund collected from voluntary gifts of the adherents.

The leaders are :-

- 1) MISCETTOLA Giuseppe di Angelo and di Sammartino Teresa, born in Naples on 30.5.1915, resident in Via Vetriera n. 15, married, a doctor surgeon attached to the local Town Hall; formerly he belonged to the Fascist Party; no penal records in this R. Questura files.
- 2) FORLANI Ugo di Cuglielmo and di Formentieri Concetta, born in Naples on 3.1.1917 resident in Via S. Attanasio n. 68, married and has children, he is going to graduate in economical and commercial science; formerly he belonged to the G.U.F., no penal records in this R. Questura files.
- 3) DI MARO Mario di Pietro and fu Torres Ida, born in Naples on 27.3.1918 resident in Via Berbini n. 64, bachelor, a graduate in economical and commercial science, formerly belonging to the G.U.F.
- 4) MATTEA Vincenzo fu Vincenzo and di Maria Di Sabato born in Naples on 20.1.1915, resident in Via Ferdinando Palasciano n. 31, a bachelor, an employee; formerly he belonged to the Fascist Party, it appears from our records that on 4.7.1936 he was sentenced by the local Tribunale to 6 months and 15 days imprisonment for affront and violence to the Police Forces.
- 5) CHIRLANDINI Luigi fu Santo, born in Gazzaniga on 22.5.1911 resident in Via Generale Orsini 51 in the General Navy Guest House, with Tenente Cappellano, who has no penal records in this R. Questura files.
