SUBJECT: Italian-Polish Cultural Centre - "Alessandro Poerio".

The Italian-Polish Cultural Centre "Alessandro Poerio" has been formed in Naples with a temporary office at the Albergo Nazionale in Via Alessandro Poerio. Up to now there are about 100 members. It has no political tendencies and its purpose is to spread the knowledge of the Italian and Polish history, culture, customs and art, in order to maintain a fraternization in the freedom of thought and religion, to protect the bodies of the Polish veterans killed in Italy.

Members of the temporary Directive Committee are:-

- 1) President - CORTESE Guido fu Paolo and fu Manetta Silvia, born in Naples on 3.8.1908, resident in Via Concezione a Monte Calvario N. 61, a lawyer; he is married and has children, formerly member of the fascist party, journalist and member of the executive committee of the Liberal Party for Campania. No penal records in the R. Questura files.
- 2) Vice President - Mons. MULLER Giuseppe di Salvatore and di Coppola Anna, born in Naples on 2.6.1911, resident at the Naples Cathedral of which he is the Parish priest. He graduated in theological philosophy. No penal records against him.
- 3) Vice President - BORSELLI Edgardo di Agostino and di Vairo Francesca, born in Naples on 12.2.1889, resident in Via Pessina N. 90, lawyer, Italian consul in Poland until 1943. He was a member of the fascist party.
- 4) Vice President - LUDWIG Vladimiro, colonel in the Polish army, resident in Naples in Via Alessandro Manzoni 140, it seems that he belonged to the Staff of General ANDERS.
- 5) Councillor - URGA Renato fu Mario and fu Cozzolino Concetta, born in Naples on 13.4.1913, resident in Vico S. Domenico Maggiore N. 9, 48 a bachelor. He graduated in economical science, and he is employed in the local tobacco factory. He was a member of the G.U.F.. No penal records against him in the R. Questura files.
- 6) Councillor - DELLA MORTE Michele di Bartolomeo and di Salzano Carmela, born in Naples on 24.7.1908, resident in Via Gesù e Maria N. 23, he is married and has children, he is a lawyer. He joined the fascist party in 1928.
- 7) Councillor - VIGLIETTI Vitale fu Luigi and di Canciano Carmela, born in Naples on 7.6.1895, resident in Via Verdi N. 5, a lawyer. He is married and has children. No penal records against him in the R. Questura files.
- 8) ABBATE Vincenzo fu Gerardo and fu Crefice Teresa, born in Casoria on 27.11.1907 resident in Via Merliani N.33, he is married and has children. He was a member of the local Pretura. He was a member of

Via Alessandro Poerio. Up to now there are about 400 members. It has no political tendencies and its purpose is to spread the knowledge of the Italian and Polish history, culture, customs and art, in order to maintain a fraternization in the freedom of thought and religion, to protect the bodies of the Polish veterans killed in Italy.

- 5) Councillor - URGA Renato fu Mario and fu Conzolino Concetta, born in Naples on 13.4.1912, resident in Vico S. Domenico Maggiore N. 9, 48 a bachelor. He graduated in economical science, and he is employed in the local tobacco factory. He was a member of the G.U.F.. No penal records against him in the R. Questura files.
- 6) Councillor - DELLA MORTE Michele di Bartolomeo and di Salzano Carmela, born in Naples on 24.7.1908, resident in Via Gesù e Maria N. 23. He is married and has children, he is a lawyer. He joined the fascist party in 1928.
- 7) Councillor - VIGLITTI Vitale fu Luigi and di Canciano Carmela, born in Naples on 7.6.1895, resident in Via Verdi N. 5, a lawyer. He is married and has children. No penal records against him in the R. Questura files.
- 8) ABBATE Vincenzo fu Gerardo and fu Crefice Teresa, born in Casoria on 27.11.1907 resident in Via Marliani N. 33, he is married and has children, he is chancellor at the local Pretura. He was a member of the fascist party.
- 9) Councillor - PAFARA Gabriella, a Polish subject in service at the local "POLISCH FORCES" N. 61 C.M.F.
- 10) For ZELENSKA Elena, Polish officer, resident in Via Manzoni N. 14C.
- 11) For SZAWELSKI Costantino, Polish Officer, resident in Via Tino da Camiano N. 4.
- 12) DE RUGGIERO Mario fu Umberto and di Liquori Enrica, born in Naples on 14.5.1914, resident in Via Tino da Camiano N. 4, a lawyer, he is married and has children, he was a member of the fascist party.
- 13) Secretary - DOSCHI Flora di Guglielmo and di MORRA Adelaide, born in Naples on 29.11.1922, resident in Vico Cimmini a S. Potito N. 15, a spinster, she is employed at the local SEPRA. No penal records against her.
