2. Although Subject denies that she signed the document, an official analysis of her handwriting proved without a doubt that the signature is hers. The report of the analysis is also attached.

3. In view of the above, this office is recommending that Subject be interned for the duration of the war.

SUBJ: Interrogation of Lucia FOX

a. Circumstances Leading to Arrest:

Lucia FOX was arrested by this Unit on the result of the finding of a document addressed to the Under-Secretary of Foreign Affairs of the Republican Fausti Government, signed by her, informing that official of the whereabouts of three of Hitler agents. This document is attached hereto (b) RAT.

b. Personal History:

Name: JULY, Lucia

Born: June 20, 1900 at Valencia, Spain, Spanish

Father: POLA, Arturo, Agent 70000 living at Valencia San Bartolome
Vila Prospere Alfonso No. 24.

Mother: MARGO, Flaminia, deceased.

Brothers: Major Giuseppe Poli Luigi, Republic

Sisters: Anna Rosina and Sister Flaminia Maria, deceased.

Marital Status: Was married 1930 to the G. Juniper to a Thompson
from USA. Had two children married in 1931. She believed him to be dead now.Housing: College at Inca, where worked during until 1927. Then
spent France, Switzerland, Germany, Holland, and some
other countries.

c. Interrogation:

In 1925 Lucia went to SAN PAOLO, Brazil, and in 1927
Lima, Peru, and then, Belo Horizonte, and then PR. 1929 for South
America and remained at SAO PAOLO. This family made these two houses
for a year and a half at NOTICIA.

Here Lucia set up a school for young children, in which
she taught them art, drawing, painting, carpentry, and service. The name
of the school was Santa Gertrudis, Via Florida Polonio No. 110.

In 1929 the FOX family changed residence and went to
live in SAN PAOLO in Via São José, where she married in June 1930.
In the same year, Lucia's family departed for Italy and lived at
TURINELLA (OLIO), Prov. V. CAGLIARI.

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A few days after her family's departure for Italy, Lucia left for RIO de JANEIRO because of a revolution which was taking place in SAO PAULO.

In 1937 Lucia had her marriage annulled. She went to the Italian Consulate in an effort to obtain employment and, through the Consul, Mr. GALLINA, she was able to get a job teaching in the Leonardo da Vinci Gimnasio. In 1939 the school was closed because it was operating at a loss to the Italian Government. In the same building, there was an elementary school, the Principe di Piemonte, and here she applied and was accepted as a teacher. In 1941 this school was closed also and subject remained without employment. During this period she compiled a 15 page guide book for travelers, and sold it to various hotels.

In 1942, when all diplomatic relations had been severed between Italy and Brazil, FOLI was asked to leave that country with a group of teachers who were being repatriated. At first, she had some difficulty in this connection because, while she was teaching at the Gimnasio, she was paid by the Brazilian Government; therefore, she was not considered an Italian teacher teaching abroad. However, through the assistance of Consul GALLINA, Lucia was able to embark on 2 May, 1942 from RIO de JANEIRO with other teachers bound for Italy.

The ship docked at LISBON, Portugal, on 25 May, where she got a special train which went directly to ROME. While in ROME, she lived at the Grand Hotel, then with a private family called MARTINI BOAGNI, Antonio at Via Eritrea No. 26. However, she tried to get an apartment and, a short time later, was able to locate one at Via Eritrea No. 32 Int'l.

Capt. Bini BEJEDOMO lived in the same apartment for three or four months. He worked at the Consorship Office in Rome. She claims that he was a good Fascist and that he left for BOLOGNA several months ago.

In 1943, Subject worked at the Ministero Cultura Popolare at the Stampa Estera, for Prof. BROLOCH, and, with him translated "I POVERI RIDONI" and "I FANATICI" from Hungarian into Italian.

D. Comments and Conclusions:

It is the opinion of this interrogator that FOLI has told the truth as stated above, but that she is withholding information in connection with the document she is purported to have written denouncing anti-Fascist elements and Allied agents.

An analysis of her handwriting and of the handwriting on the above-mentioned document, indicates that she did sign the document beyond all doubt. However, she persists in her denial of this.

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E. Recommendations:

It is believed by this Unit, that POLI did, in fact, give information to the Undersecretary of Foreign Affairs concerning the Allied agents in Rumania. Her position in the Ministry of Popular Culture, her acquaintance with the persons concerned, and the opinion of the handwriting expert confirming the identity of her signature with that appended to the document addressed to the Undersecretary of Foreign Affairs and denouncing the Allied agents, renders this belief tenable. It is accordingly recommended that POLI, as a security danger to the Allied cause, be interned for the duration.

In September 1962, TELLE informed CIA of their intent to assassinate President Hugo Banzer. TELLE informed CIA that he had been given the order to do so by the military junta which had overthrown the government of President Fernando Belaúnde Terry in 1962.

In 1965, TELLE, along with other members, had discussions about and planned with the military, the Central Bank, and the Bank of Chile, regarding their intent to assassinate President Salvador Allende and convert Chile into a socialist state. However, TELLE did not return until the month of May 1969, and it was during those months, he agreed to help the military, and it was during those months, he agreed to help the military. That summer TELLE, along with a number of others, traveled to Argentina. There they were invited to participate in a meeting of the United Left, which was organized in 1967. Meeting from April to September 1969, TELLE, along with many other Chileans, met with members of the United Left.

In 1969, the United Left, as well as TELLE, left for Mexico City, and remained at the Hotel Mexico, the last place used for their meetings, and remained at the Hotel Mexico until May 1970. On 2 June 1970, TELLE returned from Argentina, where he had been, to Mexico City, Mexico, along with members of the United Left, along with many other Chileans, and stayed at the Hotel Mexico until 22 June 1970.

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From the first days of her return to Rio from South America, Lucia maintained a hostile attitude towards Maria Rita. The reasons were many; the most important of them being the difference in viewpoint regarding politics: Lucia being a strong Fascist and pro-German, while Maria Rita was an anti-Fascist. On many occasions during conversations, Maria Rita criticized the Fascist regime. She was told by Lucia and by her brother, Mgr. Giuseppe Pio, who is also a pro-Fascist (and an Army chaplain), that she, being the youngest one in the family, was not in a position to speak of politics and she was to refrain from criticizing the Fascist regime.

As time went by, the tension grew. Sister Lucia and Mgr. Pio, knowing Maria Rita's ideas, exhorted her on many occasions to leave the apartment. This Maria Rita claims, was done because the other two wanted more freedom in their home. Maria Rita claims that the reason for which Pio and Lucia got along was because the latter played up to his sexual desires by receiving and entertaining women that Pio was interested in. Maria Rita states that for Easter 1943, a certain Elsa CORTELLI was invited by Pio to come from Milano and stay with them at the apartment for a day. It appears that there were intimate relations between Pio and Elsa. The daughter of a certain Colonel FIORE who came to the apartment on the pretext of receiving special lessons from Pio, was, according to Maria Rita, having intimate relations with her brother.

In March or April of 1944, every night, for three nights, Lucia left the apartment at around 11 pm. and returned at 2 or 3 in the morning. She explained that she spoke Portuguese over the radio for the Ministry of Popular Culture.

Maria Rita believes that she was drugged by Lucia by use of sleeping powders which were mixed into her sugar bowl. The tensed relationship between the two sisters had reached a point where they were eating out of their own particular plates, glasses, etc. Due to this drugging, Maria Rita claims she had to remain in bed for three days, during which time she was groggy and constantly sick to her stomach. She was in a semi-conscious condition--could hear the phone ring, but was unable to get out of bed to answer it.

After three days, Maria Rita was feeling better, and at that time, her sister approached her and in a laughing manner told her she should be ashamed of herself to have stayed in bed for three days. Maria Rita answered that she had found sleeping powders in Lucia's medicine kit, which powders Maria Rita believed Lucia had placed in her sugar bowl. She told Lucia that she had taken the powder to her attorney MATTEINI, to be used in a case against Lucia. When Lucia heard this accusation, she left the room and a short time later Maria Rita heard her flush the toilet a few times; this action convinced Maria Rita that Lucia had destroyed the rest of the powder. (As it turned out, however, on examination of the powder she had turned over to the lawyer, there was no trace of its being a drug.)

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Maria Rita further states that Lucia used to write anonymous letters to her (Maria Rita) which she would give to the portiera to deliver. These letters were left open, and contained information that would have led anyone who read them to believe that Maria Rita was insane. In fact, Lucia told Maria Rita that plans were being formulated to have Maria Rita committed to an institution for the insane. Lucia used the excuse that the automobile accident they were in had affected Maria Rita mentally. Maria Rita does have a scar over her right eye.

On 4 November 1943, in accordance with the request of Lucia, a certain Prof. SCIORTINO came to the apartment to compel Maria Rita to leave, and succeeded. Maria Rita stayed around the portiera's place for the remainder of that day, and while there, she met Cesare BARBIERI to whom she told her story. BARBIERI introduced her to Vassalli. VASSALI who told her that he and BARBIERI were both SIS men and were leaving for northern Italy. He made arrangements to have Maria Rita live with his wife. Maria Rita did this and remained with Mr. VASSALI until the portiera of her former home informed her that her sister had been arrested by the Allies.

On receiving this news, Maria Rita entered the apartment with the help of Capt. BEIJONO who used to live with the POLIS and who told Maria Rita that he had been fighting with the partisans and had just returned to Rome, for a short vacation.

He collaborated with the German authorities especially with the legal experts on law. CLANCETTI caused the Military magistrates to take an oath to the Fascist Government. He worked with the Republican Government until May last when he was discharged at his own request. It is reported that on occasions he made feeble efforts to resist but did not take the strong action as others did. He was always friendly with prominent Fascist personalities.

Lt. Gen. BITTINI Leopoldo, Councillor Relator of the High Tribunal. This man worked with the Republican Government and under Fascism made a rapid rise in his profession. He now claims he helped the underground movement by delaying action against anti-Fascists.

Lt. Gen. CLAUDIO Giuseppe, Councillor Relator of the High Tribunal. A veteran Fascist, Scudrista and a Lt. Gen. of the N.V.M. who benefitted by his activities in the Party, all of his position may be attributed to his Fascist influence. His brother and brother-in-law were both Fascist of high standing. CLAUDIO continued to serve the Republican Government after 8th September 1943.

Lt. Gen. LIPPI Umberto, substitute Military Attorney General. He commenced life as a dramatic actor. as very friendly with many prominent Fascist. Claims he was ordered to go north but delayed starting.

On the retirement of CHIARANTINI he was appointed to his post but the occupation of Rome by the Allies prevented this. A man who was regarded most favourably by the Fascists, and later by the Republican Fascist Party.

Maj. Gen. ANTONIO Leon, Military Attorney. After Oct. September 1943 he worked at Padua and Bologna. It is reported that he disagreed with the Fascist officials. Little information is available regarding him.

CHANCELLOR

Maj. POPOLLA UGO, Vice Chancellor (read). A volunteer in the Spanish war. He depended a great deal on Gen. GAVINA, who was looked upon as his protector. He took the oath to the Republican Government and is an ardent fascist.

TESTIMONIAL WITNESS OF ROME (PIASCA CAVALLI)

Col. TORNATO Agostino, Judge Relator. He consented to be removed to Perugia as Head Military Attorney because his family were living there. No other information available.

Col. CIPOLLINA Gaetano, Judge Relator. It is suspected he was a member of the P.M.R. He acted as Prosecutor at an Extraordinary Tribunal at Viterbo at which he asked for capital punishment. He was ordered to the north but managed to remain in Viterbo and made known to Varese all CIPOLLINA's anti-fascistic prosecution of the prisoners.

CHANCELLOR

Maj. LUIGI Tommaso, Chancellor. A veteran Fascist and a Son of Italy. He held office under both the Fascists and Republican Fascists.

Maj. Gen. MILAZZO Giacchino, Judge Relator. In recent years he engaged at the Special Tribunal. After the dissolution of the Tribunal he assumed assignment at the General Legal Office.

Maj. Gen. PUGLISI Giorani, was engaged at the Special Tribunal. He did not take the oath and there is little information forthcoming about his past activities, he does not seem to have been an active Fascist.



3. Though the reopening of this Court does not present any material difficulty, two points must be borne in mind :

- a) that the archives under seal have not been examined yet;
- b) that many military and legal officials members of the Court are far from reliable (a list of them, showing those who took the fascist oath and those who refused is enclosed).

4. Could you let us have your views at the earliest opportunity as this matter is considered to be urgent.

TO : Distribution Below.

INFORMATION.

1. The Commander-in-Chief has directed the neutrality of the Republic of SAN MARINO, Map Ref: 785545, to be respected and that Allied troops will not violate territory of this republic except where it is definitely established:

- (a) The enemy have first violated the neutrality of this State either by withdrawing through it or by fighting from within its boundaries, or attitudes.
- (b) The Government and people of SAN MARINO have adopted a hostile

If it is necessary to enter the territory of SAN MARINO under the provisions of this paragraph, the greatest possible respect will be paid to the inhabitants and property within the State. The decision for armed forces to enter the territory will not be taken by an officer junior to a Divisional Commander.

2. In view of the decision to respect the neutrality of SAN MARINO under the Republic will only be set up if it is necessary for troops to enter the in any event for the supply of food and other requirements (see para. 11, 12 and 13 below).

3. An officer from HQ, AMG Eighth Army will enter the Republic of SAN MARINO as soon as the military situation enables him to do so. A. M. C. I. O. with the Corps operating in the area is to notify HQ, AMG Eighth Army three days before it is anticipated that Allied troops touch the boundaries.

4. The AMG Officer will enter the Republic not as a representative of he will be known as P.I.O. He will be accompanied by a representative from the Political Section, H.Q. ACC. For the purpose of this instruction ACC.

7. If it has been possible to observe the neutrality of the State but if on arrival the Political Liaison Officer finds the Government to be hostile to Allied interests or under Republican Fascist influence, he will arrange for a neutral Government friendly to Allied interests to be established as quickly as possible.
8. In the event of it being necessary for Allied troops to enter the Republic, a modified Military Government will be established by the Political Liaison Officer for such time as the troops are within the boundaries of the

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~~REPUBLIC~~, sufficient to ensure that military operations are not hampered in any way. A friendly neutral Government will be established as soon as the troops have passed through the Republic, and the P.L.O. will report from his status of representative of Military Government to that of Liaison Officer.

9. As soon as a friendly neutral Government is functioning in SAN MARTINO, the P.L.O. will arrange for an accredited representative of the Republic to be sent to the Provincial Commissioner of TOLI Province, and to be located at the latter's discretion at the most convenient place, probably with the Civil Affairs Officer at RUE T. The function of the SAN MARTINO representative will be to make all local arrangements necessary for supplies, refugees, and similar matters of a non-political nature.

10. As soon as the representative of the Republic of SAN MARTINO has reported to the Provincial Commissioner, O.P.I., the P.L.O. will leave the Republic and all future Local Liaison with the P.L.O. will be conducted through the representative of the Republic and the Provincial Commissioner.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR SUPPLIES, ETC.

11. For so long as the Province of TOLI remains within Eighth Army area it will be the responsibility of AGC Eighth Army to ensure that supplies, medical stores, etc., are furnished to the Republic. This responsibility will pass to Region IX when the Province of TOLI reverts to under administration Region IX.

FINANCE.

12. Detailed instructions regarding the accounting and payment for supplies, medical stores, etc., furnished to the Republic of San Marino will later be issued by the Chief Accountant, Finance Sub-Commissioner. It is anticipated that such supplies will be charged to the Italian Government and acknowledged as received by SAN MARTINO from AGC. This is in line with arrangements made for supplying the Vatican. A later financial settlement will be made in both cases.

13. As the currency circulation of SAN MARTINO consists of Italian State notes (small denominations) and Banca d'Italia notes (large denominations), the

Mrs Fleitmann Lida daughter of William and of Henry Lida born in Brooklyn on the 3rd April 1894, and her daughter Lida born in New York on the 1st January 1923, ex pupil of the German Academy of Arts, live in Rome since 1932.

From the year 1939 she lives in via Monte Giordano, 36 - Palazzo Taverna - and pays for her apartment about I. 500 lire monthly.

She is a great admirer of Mussolini. On the 24th May 1941 she sent him some conferences for radio Rome, and he thanked her for her present through the Minister Pavolini. Therefore she was well known in the "Ministero della Cultura Popolare".

From March till December 1941 she collaborated with the Radio Office of the above mentioned Ministry, and held at the radio 60 conferences directed to England and North America.

From the 15th to the 24th July 1941 and from the 12th to the 18th September 1941 she was the guest of marquis Antonio Spinola at Torgiano.

Mrs Fleitmann is of German origin and is very proud of it. She has still relations in Germany at Monaco, Brema, Colonia, Godesberg, and Mannheim with whom she was in correspondence while the Germans were in Rome.

Presently she is in touch with American Officers, a few days ago she invited them for a dance. It seems that her daughter is employed in an Allied office.

Dal 1939 abita in via Monte Giordano n° 35 -Palazzo Taverna- in un appartamento per il quale paga L.I. 300 mensili circa. Admiratrice fanatica di Mussolini, il 24/5/1941 gli inviava un opuscolo contenente scritti per radio Roma, per cui lo stesso Mussolini, tramite il Ministro Pavolini, la ringraziava del dono che aveva apprezzato e gradito moltissimo. Pertanto era favorevolmente conosciuta negli ambienti del Ministero della Cultura Popolare.

Quale collaboratrice esterna all'ispettorato radio del Ministero della Cultura Popolare, dal mese di marzo 1941 al dicembre detto, contribuiva con circa 60 radio-conversazioni dirette all'Inghilterra ed al Nord America. Nello stesso mese veniva invitata a lasciare Roma, nonché, il Ministero dell'Interno, con dispaccio datato 3 gennaio 1942, per suggerimento del Comando Supremo (S.I.M.) ed in base a motivi rappresentati dal Ministero della Cultura Popolare, ordinava che alla stessa non venissero applicati i provvedimenti concordati per i cittadini del Nord America.

La Fleitman, che dal 15 al 24 luglio e dal 12 al 13 settembre 1941, fu in Torgiano, ospite del marchese Spinola Antonio, di origine tedesca, ostendendolo in ogni sua manifestazione.

The North-American, Lida Fleitman fu William, living in Rome, "Via Monte Giordano" 36 and her daughter Lida, for your information, are without doubt, active members of the "Fifth Column", notwithstanding that their present attitude is indifferent and wishes to show an apparent cordiality towards the Allies.

The attachment to and the collaboration with the Fascist Regime of Lida Fleitman is irrefutable and particularly with Mussolini,

In close evil union with the "ovra" and the "S.I.M.", she earned much money and assure her self absolute immunity, in such a manner as to avoid the emigration order for the American citizens.

Lida Fleitman was also employed at "Ministero della Cultura Popolare" since to 1942. In fact when the order to send her away, came, the Internal and War Office made did every thing to prevent it.

With her removal the Government would have lost an excellent element for propaganda and espionage..

Further informations and precise investigations about Lida Fleitman are to be carried out.

It is therefore to watch her carefully and if is possible to avoid her contact with the Allied Forces.

E' inconfondibile l'attaccamento e la collaborazione che la signora Fleitman Lida ha sempre concesso al regime fascista ed in modo assai particolare al signor Mussolini. In stretto diabolico contatto con gli organismi dell'Ovra e del S.I.M. la predetta ha potuto realizzare dei notevoli guadagni ed assicurarsi una immunità assoluta, tanto da sfuggire al provvedimento di esodo dei cittadini americani.

La Fleitman non fu semplicemente collaboratrice, bensì impiegata presso il Ministero della Cultura Popolare fino al 1942.

Infatti, allorquando il provvedimento di allontanamento doveva colpirla insorsero subito il Ministero dell'Interno e quello della Guerra per scongiurarla.

Il suo allontanamento avrebbe fatto perdere al regime un elemento ottimo per la propaganda e per lo spionaggio.

Per la Fleitman sono in corso ulteriori e più minuziosi accertamenti. E' bene pertanto vigilarla assiduamente ed evitarle se possibile contatti con le forze alleate.
