1. Since the Guardia Nazionale Republican, by reason of its activity, has become part of the Fascist Republicanism, its members, (less those from the CC.RP), who are considered in the course of the division, will be treated as military prisoners of war. They will therefore be dispatched to a normal PW camp, and sent to the internment camp.
2. Our letters of even number dated 4 Jul 46 and 10 Aug 46 (not to all) are cancelled in so far as they concern members of the CC.RP from the 1937 and 1941.
3. Members of CC.RP from the CC.RP will continue to be dealt with in accordance with our letter of even number dated 10 Aug 46, since many of these, if found suitable, will be required by the War Office, with the Allies.
4. For convenience of reference, the relevant paragraph concerning the disposal of these CC.RP members in the text below, enclosed in respect of the location of reception centers.

"CC.RP"

- (1) CC.RP members of the CC.RP will be interned if positive information is obtained indicating the probability of their endangering our country if left at liberty.
- (2) Other such members should be instructed to report to the nearest APO Public Safety Officer, who will arrange for them to proceed to the appropriate CC.RP reception center where they will be received. These centers are at present located as follows (for reference) in FLORENCE (for CC/RP), the other two centers are in GENOVA and TRIESTE are shortly to be closed down.
- (3) Any information that CC.RP members are in or coming such centers, and which would assist the working officers of the reception centers in deciding how to deal with them, should be passed to the nearest Public Safety Officer.

If the Public Safety Officer is unable to verify, it would be of assistance to him if CC.RP, CC/RP, if at all possible, arrange for such members to be dispatched to the reception centers concerned.

2. Our letters of even number dated 4 JUL 68 and 14 AUG 68 (not to all) are cancelled in so far as they concern members of the CR group and the ARVN and PAV.
3. Members of CR group from the CC-FR will continue to be dealt with in accordance with our letter of even number dated 14 JUL 68, since any of them, if found suitable, will be recruited by ARVN for service with the ARVN.
4. For convenience of reference, the relevant paragraphs concerning the disposal of those CC-FR members are quoted below, enclosed in reprint of the location of reception centers.

"CC-FR"

- (i) CC-FR members of the CR will be informed if positive information is obtained indicating the probability of their being given any priority if left at liberty.
- (ii) Other such members should be instructed to report to the nearest ARVN Public Safety Officer, who will arrange for them to proceed to the appropriate CC-FR reception center where they will be detained. These centers are at present located at NEM (arm of the ARVN) and FLORENCE (for ARVN/AR). The ARVN will control all ARVN and ARVN are shortly to be closed down.
- Any information which ARVN/AR may obtain concerning such members, and which would assist the growing efforts at the reception centers in dealing with them, should be passed to the nearest Public Safety Officer.
- If no Public Safety Officer is readily available, it should be of assistance to ARVN in ARVN/AR, if at all possible, arrange for such members to be transferred to the Reception Center concerned.
