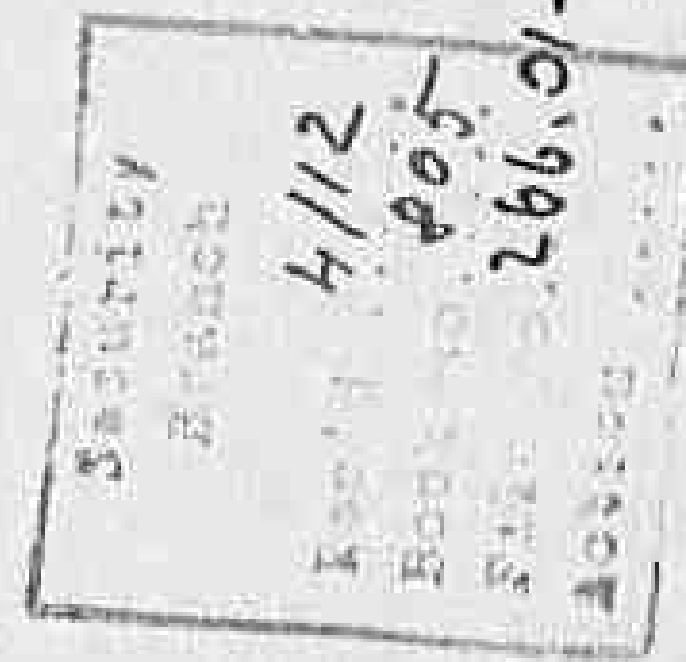

The Ministry of Interior has asked if arrangements could be made for Italian and alien nationals acquitted on war crime charges by British Military Courts or released on completion of sentence to be instructed to report to the nearest Questura or the Questura informed that such individual is in a certain jail at its disposition. The Ministry of Interior should also be advised.

3. The local Questuras will enquire into the position of Italian nationals and the Ministry will take steps for the repatriation of alien nationals.

The prisoner has to report to the nearest Questura, or the Questura has to be informed that the prisoner is kept in prison at its disposition.

This information has to be sent also to this Ministry.

The Questura will inquire on prisoners' position and, if foreigners, act for their repatriation.

Will you please inform this Ministry if the said procedure is approved by your commission in order that the necessary instructions may be given —

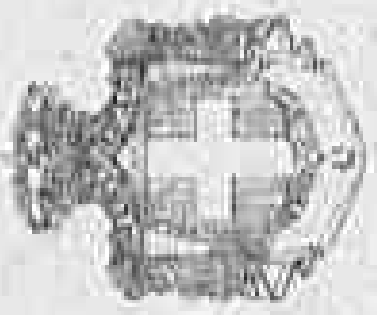

It is learned from the Questura of Bologna that after September 1943 subject did not take any part in political activities. Therefore, in case of acquittal by the British Military Court, subject can be released.

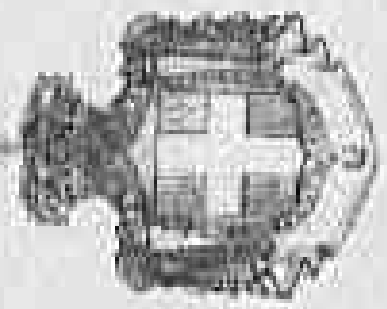

1. Reference your Div. S.I.S. Sez. II Prot. No. 224/85616 dated 15 October 1946.

2. It is regretted that it is not possible, generally speaking, to furnish your Ministry with sufficiently full details to establish the identity of potential War Criminals to be brought to trial before British Military Courts.

3. However, it is suggested that if an Italian national who is to be brought to trial has a name similar to that of some person wanted by the Italian authorities, this HQ should be requested, in the event of his acquittal, to arrange with the military authorities concerned to have him handed over in custody to the local Italian police for screening and disposal. In the case of Germans or Austrians it will be possible to inform you of as full details as may be required.

4. It will be appreciated if your Ministry will forward their observations on this suggestion to these HQ.

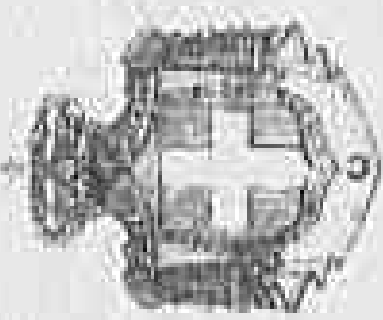

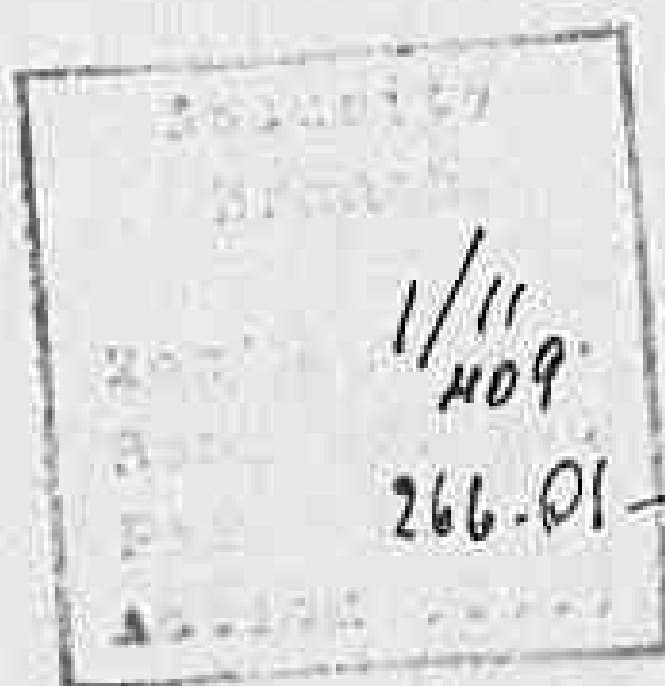

2. It is suggested that if an Italian to be brought to trial has a name similar to that of a man wanted by the Italian authorities this HQ should be requested, in the event of his acquittal, to hand him over in custody to the local Italian authorities for screening and disposal. This HQ would of course keep you fully informed of action taken. In the case of Germans or Austrians this HQ will inform you of as full details as may be required by the Italian authorities.
3. It is not thought that you can be in any doubt as to the identity of MACKENSEN and MAELTZER.

2. It is the policy of G.H. as soon as possible after trial to release acquitted war criminals, to hand them over to other authorities who may want them or to revert them to P.V. status.

3. Your Ministry is therefore requested to inform this Hq as soon as possible if you have an interest in any of the persons listed.

4. It will be appreciated if you will give this matter your immediate attention.
