The same can be said of the undermentioned members of her family:

- Father: Dessy Attilio, son of the late Giov. Battista and Garzia Elisia, born at Cagliari 8 July 1874, doctor of law, high school teacher.
- mother: Melis Fanny, daughter of the late Michele and La Rosa, born in Cagliari 2 Feb 1885.
- brother: Aldo Giovanni, born in Cagliari on 5 Feb 1905, bookkeeper, employed in the Banca Commerciale, ex Infantry captain.
- sister: Ofelia, born in Cagliari on 10 Feb 1912, doctor of law, high school teacher.
- brother: Elia, born in Cagliari on 13 July 1914, doctor of Economics and political science, Air Corps Lieutenant, missing since 15 Aug 43 - was attached to Perugia Air Field.
- sister: Maria Paola, born in Cagliari on 25 March 1916, doctor of law, high school teacher, married Dr. Carlo Barzoni.

This family has a good reputation. There are no signs of hereditary disease in the family. During the Fascist Regime they held no fascist office nor did they spread fascist propaganda.

The bride-to-be does not present any physical imperfections.

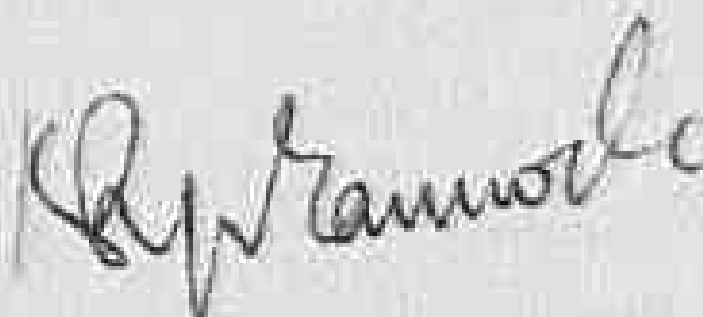

LORENZON Maria Enrica of Giacinto and of MAZZERO Maria born in MARIAGO the 26th of November 1919

The 25th of August 1942 she asks the Questura to have a free railway ticket to go back home, saying that she came in Rome for health reasons and that she has no money to pay it. Later she was repatriate by the Police.

The 9th of September 1942 she was arrested for stealing by the Commissary of Testaccio. Later she was denounced for aggravated stealing to MONACO Emilia prejudice. For the first stealing the Commissary of Testaccio made a report on her dated the 10th December 1942, n: 11842, and the King's prosecutor denounced her with the report n. 333344 dated the 18th December 1942. She obtained the provisional liberty the 26th December 1942 and she was sent to TREVISO with the order to present herself to the Questura, but because she was ill she obtained 14 days to stay in Rome.

The 19th of May 1943 she has asked to be assumed as worker in the STACCHINI's powder mill. On the 1st of May 1943 she was assumed as servant-maid by the family of SPAGNOLO Mario living in Via S. Vito 2, where she remained till the 22nd of April 1943. She was inscribed in the Anagrafe of Rome the 17th of June 1943, and she was inscribed also as nurse, and till to day she results living in Rome.

The original of the condemnation for stealing may be found in TREVISO tribunal.

Her moral conduct leaves much to be desired.

In 1937 her fascist card was withdrawn, because she did not attend the meetings.

In 1939, in order to get the appointment of accountant by the Cava dei Tirreni Commune, which had been left vacant after her brother was recalled to the colours, and also to be able to practise her profession of teacher, she asked again for the fascist card, which she kept till 1942.

She does not appear to have taken any part in political activity, in favour of the fascist regime.

Her family is composed as follows:

Sister Campagnuolo Ada, born in Cava dei Tirreni on 24.9.1918,

residing there, workwoman by the local Tobacco factory;

Brother Campagnuolo Mario, born in Cava dei Tirreni on 11.5.1912,

Infantry Officer, at present prisoner of war;

Sister Campagnuolo Emma, born in Cava dei Tirreni on 20.5.1913,

married, residing in Aquila, high-school teacher.

In Cava dei Tirreni said people own a building of 18 rooms, worth about 700,000 Lire, which has been inherited from their parents and has to be divided among them.
