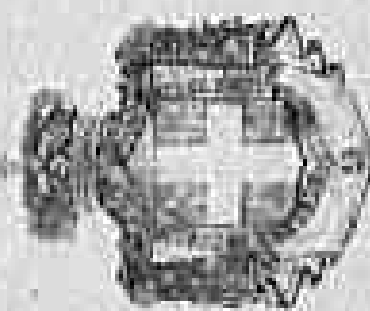

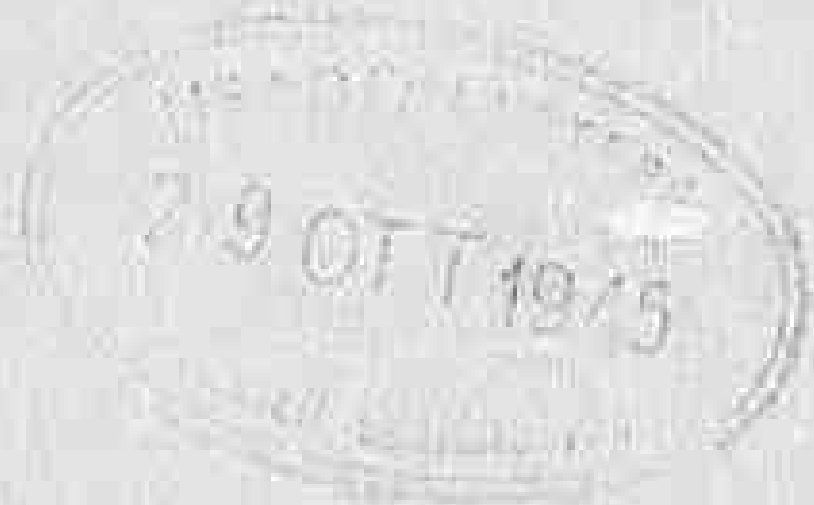

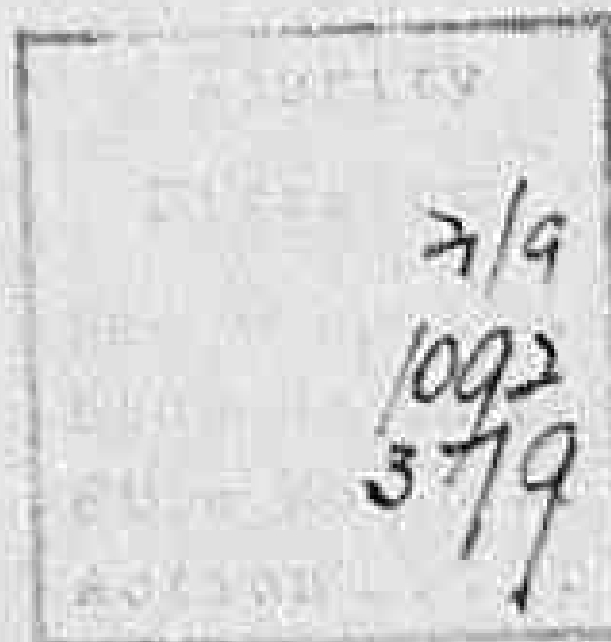

ROCCASECCA Osvalda di Pietro and di SOPRANO Lucia, born in Velletri on the 4th of May 1927, single, living at 6 Via Giuseppe Cel, int. 9, has resided in Rome with her own family since June 1943, refugee.

It results that she leads an honest life, and is generally esteemed in the neighborhood. Nothing result against her in the file of the local Questura.

At present time she is unemployed. Formerly she worked out of staff with the "Istituto Centrale di Statistica" for about three months. She was dismissed for reduction of personnel.

It is rumoured that in Velletri she studied at the "Scuole Magistrali" and had acquired a good literary learning. However she was obliged to suspend her studies, owing to the war.

It is also rumoured that some time ago she got engaged with a British soldier, who goes often to her house.

Her father, ROCCASECCA Pietro fu Filippo, born in Velletri on the 22nd of June 1900, has always been anti-fascist and of republican feelings. In October 1944, as he had led a demonstration against the Government, he was cautioned by the Provincial Commission. In 1942, on occasion of the twentieth anniversary of the Fascist Regime, he was acquitted by the a/m caution.

He is whitewasher, but in 1941-42 he was representative for medical articles, kitchens and heaters of Argas Concern, situated in Rome, Via della Stelletta. ~~Formerly~~ It seems that for about four months he was the manager of a coffee-house at Porta Furba.

From his file he results to have been sentenced by on a year imprisonment by the Military Tribunal of Rome, with sentence dated 2 January 1919, for desertion.

Investigations have been made yesterday by two policemen or Carabinieri in civilian clothes about ROCCASECCA.

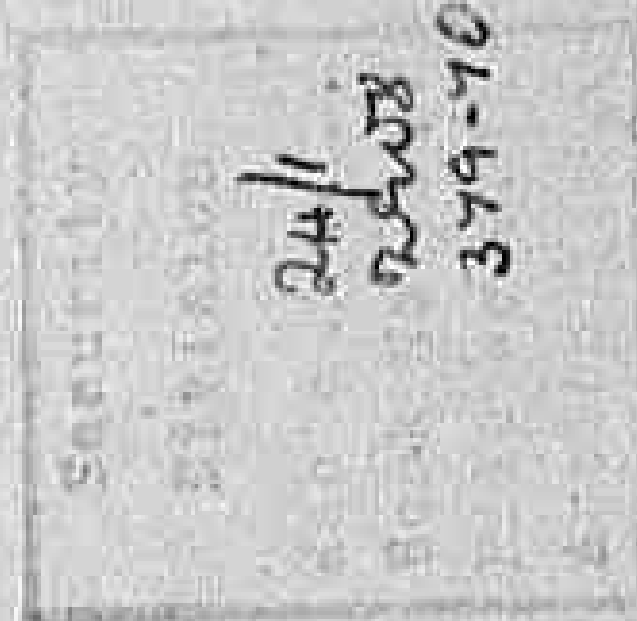

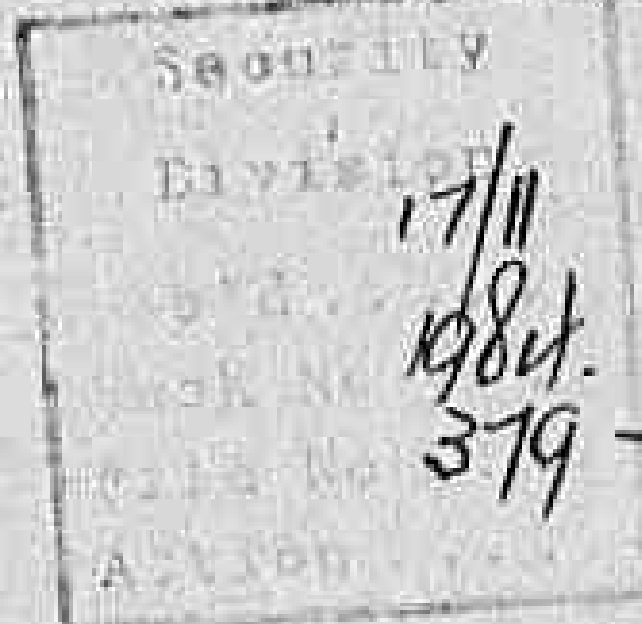

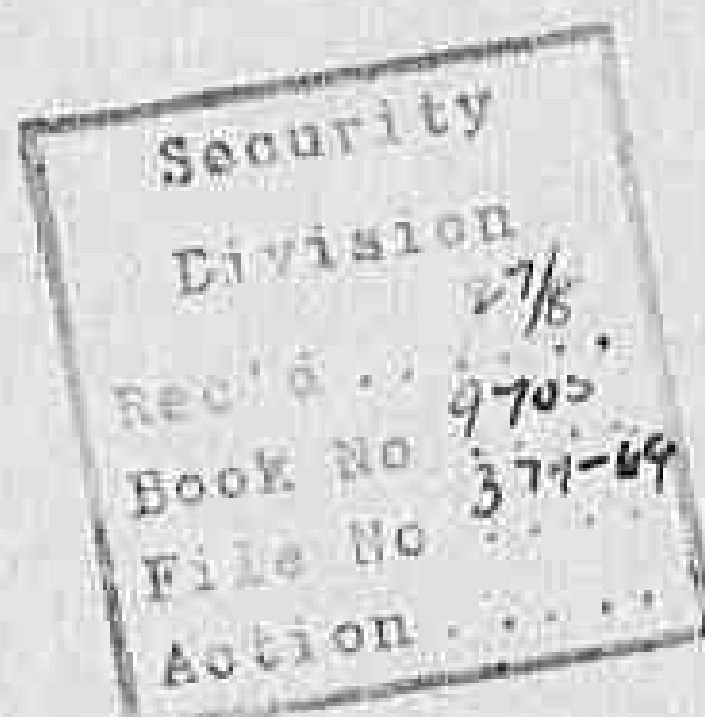

2. On investigating it is found that the man had expressed a desire to marry before proceeding to UK, and that his application was held up from 27 Oct 44 to 27 Feb 45 while A.C.C. ABRUZZI-MARCHE Region enquired into the moral and political status of his proposed wife, an Italian girl.
3. It is appreciated that these enquiries may be difficult and protracted. Nevertheless ex POW are subjects who, as a matter of policy, have to be evacuated as speedily as possible. Failure on our part to affect this normally results as at present in enquiries on a high level.
4. It would be appreciated therefore if you would instruct your subordinate formations that enquiries of this nature on behalf of ex POW should always be treated as matters of urgency.

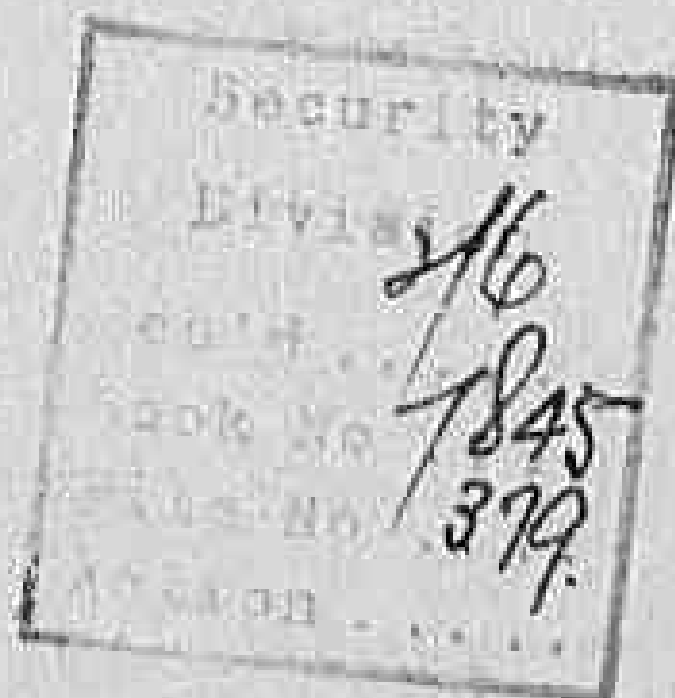

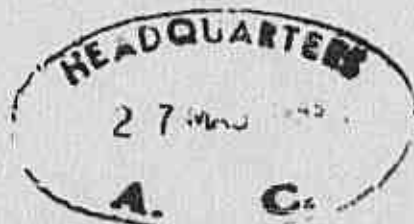
