It is reported that British and American units are preventing the entry of Italian Malaria Control Organisations on to land occupied by troops.

In the Myro Campaign most of the malarial control work is done by Civilian Constructors who are thoroughly conversant with their duties. In future, all civilian personnel who are employed in Malaria Control are being issued with passes by the Public Health Dept, Rome Region.

All units and organisations will ensure that these men are NOT denied access to areas occupied by troops except when military security makes it necessary.

Units and organisations will also ensure that there is no interference with dams and similar water control measures operated by the Civilian Malaria Control Organisations.
