1. Reference your S.959 of 28 July.

2. While we have no adverse information concerning the subject, I do not feel that officials of Allied Military Government are called upon to support an Italian subject asking for an Italian passport.

3. Any approach to us should be by the Italian authorities or if he wishes to travel to England, by the British Embassy in due course, but I don't think we should allow ourselves to be led into supporting by the applicant himself before the initial steps are taken.

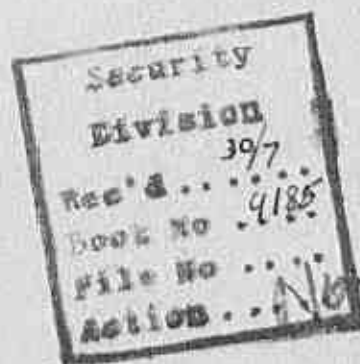
