4. It will be noticed from the attached report that VASIN is a white Russian who worked in uniform for the Germans and has been issued by Displaced Persons Section, A.M.G., with the certificate to the effect that he is to be considered as "Allied".
5. It would be interesting to know whether A.F.H.Q. has any records of this man.
6. Subject is employed by U.N.R.R.A. as a driver.

Interrogation report on: VASIN Vieter, in Andre.

Subject was born on 21 June 1921 at Leningrad (St. Petersburg) as the son of Russian parents. He is stateless. He worked as a driver and mechanic and is at present employed by UNRRA, Inc Buildings, Rome, as a driver. He lives at Via Panama 79, Rome.

Languages : Russian, French, Italian, German.
Father : ENNOK Andre (deceased)
Mother : VORONZOFF Senaida, living at Chantilly (France).
Step-Father: VASIN Efim, living at Chantilly.
Documents : Italian driver's licence No. 27789, issued at Rome, 27 Oct '44; foglio di soggiorno degli stranieri No. 6068, issued at Rome on 31 Aug. '44; certificate issued by Bishop KOURAKIN John, of the Greek Orthodox Church at Florence, dated 17 Aug. '44, stating that he knew Subject since his childhood.

Life history:

21 June 1921 Subject born at Leningrad. Parents left Russia and lived in PERNOFF (Estonia), where mother married Efim VASIN, Subject's step-father. Family lived in PERNOFF from when they settled in Chantilly, near Paris (France). Subject attended elementary and medium school in Chantilly.
Subject worked in the metal container factory of Safat at Paris as a stock-keeper and dispatch clerk. Subject worked as a driver for the S.G.T.A truck-company. When the Germans requisitioned all trucks, he became unemployed. French Police instructed Subject to report to the Quai d'Orsay. There he was forced to go to Berlin and was recruited for the Teut Organisation. Transport was provided and Subject arrived in Sept. '42 in the Recruiting Depot of the Teut Organisation at Berlin, Tirpitz Ufer. In Oct. '42 he was sent to the driver's school of the s/n organisation at Muggel-Helm, near Berlin as a pupil. On account of his abilities as a linguist, the Germans kept him there until as interpreter. Then he was sent to a school for mechanics and driving instructors at Britz, for two months. From

On account of his abilities as a linguist, the Germans kept him there until as interpreter. Then he was sent to a school for mechanics and driving instructors at Britz, for two months. From

Jan. 1943

April to Oct. '43 he was a driver instructor in Muggelheim and Britz alternately, until he was sent to Italy in Oct. '43.

October 1943

Subject taught Italians employed by the Test Organisation as driving instructor at Reschiera del Garda, near Verona. Although he could not speak Italian, he claims to have picked up that language within a month. He worked there until when he and three white-Russian friends:

Basil VINOGRADSKI (now officer in French Army)
Leone BOHRINSKI (now in Rome)
Basil TOHEREMETEFF (now in Rome)

decided to cross the fighting lines and escape from the Germans. They stepped German military vehicles, as they were clad in German uniforms and spoke German, and travelled via Mantua, Modena, Bologna, until they arrived in Florence, where they contacted Bishop KOURAKIN, whose address was known to VINOGRADSKI as being via Principessa Margherita, Florence. At the Bishop's house they disposed of their uniforms and dressed as civilians. On

25 July 1944

a Russian woman, MICHAELIS, who is Swiss by marriage, led Subject and his three friends across the Arno river. She hid them for five days on her property across the Arno. They left their papers at their house near the Ponte Vecchio at Florence. Subject believes that the papers were destroyed when the house of MICHAELIS was blown up by the Germans before retreating. Subject and his friends had to return to Florence later, hiding in different places. Subject hid with a Russian woman by the name of ODINZOFF for approximately three weeks. He does not remember the address, but states that the house was repeatedly raided by the Germans. Subject escaped through back-door and returned at night. Subject succeeded to get through the lines and reported to the British. There he found BORRINSKI, who speaks English, and is an interpreter by profession, explaining their escape to the British Intelligence Officer on duty. Eventually all four friends were re-united and Mrs MICHAELIS, who knew an A.M.C. officer, arranged for transport for them, via Castiglione Fiorentino to Rome, where THEREMETOFF's mother lived at Via Panama 79. On Subject reported to the Police (see a/m Seggierno), and was introduced by Prince Serge ROMANOVSKI to Capt. Frank DI GIACOMO (Displaced Persons Section, A.M.C.), who issued a certificate to the effect that Subject is to be considered as Allied.

He worked for this man until Nov. 1944. In piazza Giuseppe he worked for the Super-Garage of A.C., Piazza Giuseppe Verdi, under Lieut. AMBROSO until 25 Jan. 1945. Subject started employment with UNRRA as a driver.

Interregator's opinion:

It is very likely, that Subject willingly collaborated with the Germans. As a White Russian, he dislikes everything connected with the USSR and it is quite possible that by assisting Germany, he visualised the collapse of the present regime in Russia, which would have made it possible for him to return to that country. It must also be taken into consideration that Subject could have been left behind by the Germans and that he lost his papers very conveniently at Florence.

In his present employment however, Subject does not re-

It must also be taken into consideration that Subject could have been left behind by the Germans and that he lost his papers very conveniently at Florence.

In his present employment however, Subject does not receive any information of value to the enemy.

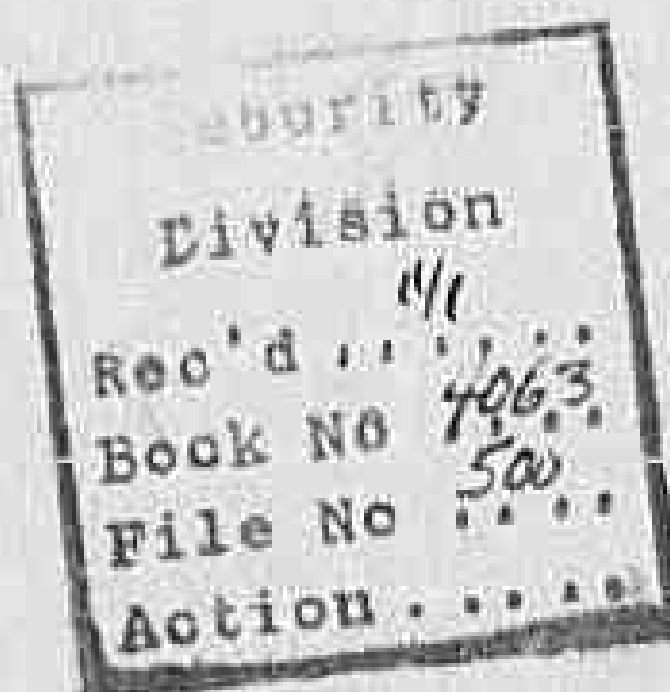

TO : All Concerned.

1. Welfare or Special Service Officers of all installations under the jurisdiction of this headquarters who engage Italian personnel for entertainment purposes will henceforth submit the names of such personnel for vetting to the appropriate Intelligence authorities of the local district, sub-area or base section headquarters in which the installation is located.

2. Requests for vetting of Italian entertainment personnel will be submitted in duplicate, together with other required information, on attached Form CI-2V-10 (see Appendix "A"). Copy of completed form will be retained in files of office requesting security screening.

3. Italian entertainment personnel will be vetted in accordance with established security procedures by the appropriate Field Security Section or Counter Intelligence Corps Detachment and all investigations of this nature will be given expeditious handling by the security authorities concerned. If necessary, security investigations of such entertainment personnel will be given preference so as not to delay or conflict with ENSA or Special Service schedules, commitments or arrangements.

4. Upon the security clearance of Italian entertainment personnel by the FSS or CIC, such personnel will be issued a Work Permit in accordance with the attached form (Work Permit - Appendix "B").

5. It will be the responsibility of the appropriate ENSA and Special Service Sections to ensure that Italian personnel will carry both the usual Identity Card and the Work Permit referred to in the previous paragraph at all times.

6. Issuance of Work Permits will not obviate the necessity for obtaining the usual individual AMG/AC travel permits which may be required for travel of civilians in Italy.

7. These instructions are applicable to:

- a. All entertainment projects which will require aid or assistance by Italian Personnel.
- b. All civilian personnel whose duties will require them to:
 - (1) Travel into restricted areas or zones.
 - (2) Come into contact with special personnel or installations.
 - (3) Go on extended or protracted tours of military installations or units.

1. Subject has been investigated by SIM, with the following results:

- a. During interrogation, Subject gave four references. A check-up on these references showed that three of these persons denied any acquaintance with Subject, while the fourth stated that he knew Subject's father only casually. It is to be noted that one of these references (who denied knowledge of Subject) is Gen. Infante, aide to Prince Umberto.

- b. Subject's family was on intimate terms with Gen. Maeltzer, German commander of Rome, and with Ettore Muti, secretary of the Fascist party.

- c. Subject's father rendered his services to the Partito Fascista Repubblicano, holding a very important post.

2. Subject was employed by the Lazio-Umbria Region, AMG, from July to 25 November 1944, at which time she was discharged for security reasons. It is to be noted that it is a bad policy to re-hire a person who has been dismissed on security grounds, unless it is obvious that an injustice was inadvertently made in his case.

3. In view of results of investigation made by SIM, and also of notation made in preceding paragraph, it is not felt that Subject should be employed by this Headquarters.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE OFFICER IN CHARGE:

SUBJECT: THAON DI REVEL, Ignazio.

RE: Interview with Confidential Informant.

This investigation is predicated on basic communication from the A.C. of S., G-2, RAAC, dated 23 November 1944, ref. G/P1936/BR, subject: "THAON DI REVEL, Ignazio", to investigate Subject's activities to determine whether or not he should be interned. The basic communication had attached to it, a Summary of Information, which alleged that Subject was a Squadrista; a member of the Fascist Parliament; his activity in America; his deportation from America; his membership in the Italian Air Force; his acquaintance with Major FIDLER, Chief of Abar; and as a lover of Mrs. GARDNER, the secretary of Colonel KAPPLER, of the German S.S. This investigation was requested by Lt. Colonel Floyd C. Snowden, Chief, CID, RAAC.

The aforementioned Summary of Information indicated that Subject has been denounced to the Commission appointed to investigate Fascist crimes. On 30 November 1944, these Agents interviewed a confidential informant, considered reliable, to determine whether Subject is under investigation by the High Commission for Sanctions Against Fascists. (Purification Committee).

Informant stated that THAON DI REVEL, Ignazio's activities had been presented to the Commission; that his case has been completely investigated and the facts disclosed, as the result of the investigation, have been fully presented to the Commission for decision. He indicated that the charges against the Subject are of a serious nature, but believes that he may be exonerated because of his friendly association with Count SPORZA, the head of the Commission.

He stated that Count SPORZA and the Subject, while in America, were associated in business, and he believes this fact may influence SPORZA's decision and he may use his influence on other members of the Commission, in order that a decision favorable to THAON DI REVEL may be rendered.

The confidential informant also indicated that although THAON DI REVEL's case has been presented, he was not placed under arrest, during the investigation or when the case was presented to the Commission for decision, due to SPORZA's influence. He further stated that the decision on the case would be handed down within 15 or 20 days; and he would advise these agents as to the results of the case.

8. On the arrival of the Allies in Rome subject entertained Allied Officers.

9. It is believed he has been denounced to the Commission appointed to investigate Fascist crimes.

Count TURGI PROSPERO Giovanni, born at Ferrara in 1906. Towards 1936 he came from Ferrara to Rome together with his mother. He never had a real profession and dedicated himself to sport, and especially to boxing. He belonged to the Fascist Party for many years, and the Fascist Fede Sport Federation appointed him President of the Sport Society "Gristoforo Colombo". He travelled very much abroad as official representative of the athletes who took part to the competitions (at least this was the reason of his travels). In 1939 he obtained a pass for the U.S.A. where he went as a tourist. In 1942 he went abroad for the last time. He had to go to Hungaria in order to meet the Field-Marshal Kalandy, President of the Hungarian Sport Federation and take him to Rome. He used to live in the Stadium of the National Fascist Party or in Hotel Ambasciatori at via Venete, leading a rather comfortable life if we consider his present economical condition.

Since Turgi came to Rome he worked always with the Sport Organizations of the Fascist Regime and was very much esteemed by the Fascist Hierarchs. He does not seem to have collaborated with the nazi-fascists during the occupation of Rome. (at least according to the information available).. At present he lives at Viale Rossini, 20.
