We notify your Sub Commission that the General Attorney of Perugia, who had received by the undersigned orders about the execution of the sentence to death against MATTEUCCI Adolfo, issued by the local Assizes for collaborationsim, has declared himself contrary to this execution.

The reason of his opposition is grounded on the fact that MATTEUCCI was a civilian Internee, formerly handed over by the Allied Authorities to the Italian Government for his trial, and therefore the Allied Hqs. should have been informed in any case of the sentence issued by the Italian Tribunal, before its execution.

Successively the Ministry of Interior notified that the Public Safety Sub Commission had requested, (by letter No. 550/05/21) a delay for the execution of this sentence, (issued on the 4th of July 1945) as MATTEUCCI had been sentenced in Perugia when the Province was still under the A.E.G. control.

Therefore two reasons hinders the execution of this sentence. As regards the former, brought forth by the Perugia Perfect, i.e. the ignorance of this Ministry about an engagement taken by the Italian Government to notify the Allied Hqs. of the sentences issued against individuals, formerly civilian internees under the Allies, we beg you to let us know whether this engagement really exists and eventually its importance.

As regards the latter objection advanced by the Public Safety Sub Commission, it results that the a/m sentence was issued on the 4th of July, i.e. about two months after the date of handover of the Perugia Province to the jurisdiction of the Italian Government. (10th of May 1945).

According to the agreements to which we came with your Sub Commission, in this case we must not respect the a/m engagement, as this Ministry only for information notifies you of the decisions taken about appeals regarding already accomplished trials, which have been judged in zones still under the A.M.G.'s control, at the date of the sentence, and successively returned to the Italian Government.

Therefore we beg you to let us know, without delay, the opinion of your Commission

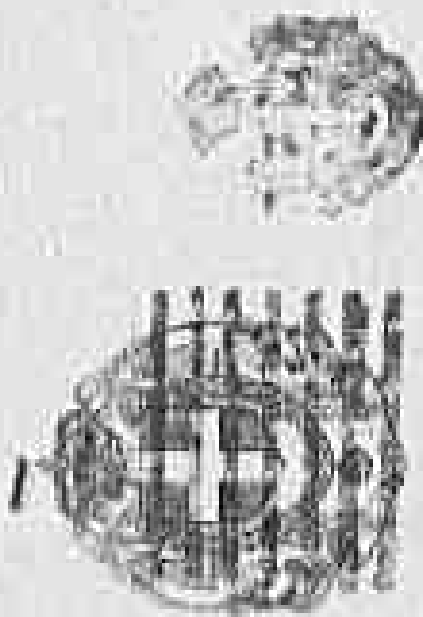

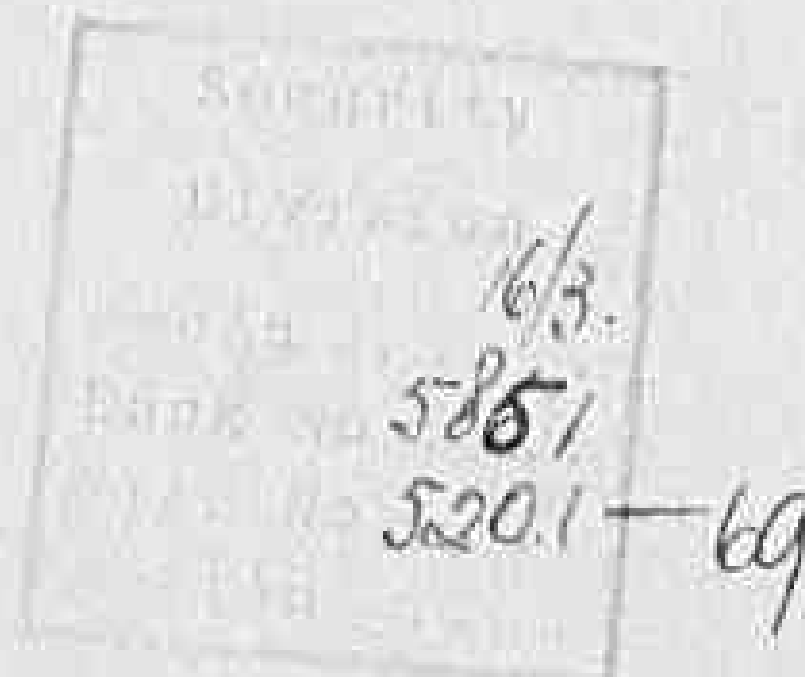

Perugia, 23rd February 1945

Subject : Matteucci Adolfo of Giuseppe, born in Passignano on the 21/5/1912, who lived at Perugia, Head of a squad of the ex republican provincial police.

To the Allied Governor for the Province of Perugia

Our office has been informed that subject was arrested by the Allied Military Police of Florence Region, and that as there are no specific facts such as to induce the Allies to take a severe action against him, he will only be interned in a concentration camp.

However, we inform you that Matteucci served the ill-famed Head of the Province Rocchi, and that both of them have terrorised for months the Province of Perugia.

Matteucci executed all Rocchi's orders even the most brutal with indifference and cynicism.

When the republican provincial police was constituted under Rocchi's direct orders, Matteucci, who didn't belong to the police being only a non commissioned officer of the G.N.R., was the first to enter in it committing all sorts of crimes. He not only arrested the antifascists of Perugia and province, but tortured many people in the premises of the republican provincial police.

He very often commanded the expeditions for the arrest of Allied war prisoners, of those who helped them, of the fellows refusing to serve the nazi fascists and of their people whom he kept in prison as hostages.

Besides, Matteucci is responsible for the death of Lisa Marcello, a boy of 23 years old, which took place on the 15 February 1944 in the cemetery of Perugia where Lisa had been taken by Matteucci and by two other agents. According to the statement of Dr. Bianchi Bruno of Arturo, doctor of the local hygien office, who called on the spot to verify the death, Matteucci shot Lisa at the back of his neck at the distance of 20 cm. When asked if Lisa was dead, the doctor answered that his pulse was still beating. Hearing this Matteucci said to the dying boy "YOU WANT TO MAKE ME WAST A SECOND BULLET THE WHICH COULD SERVE FOR ANOTHER ONE?" and shot him at his left temple at a distance of 5 or 10 cm.

In October 1943 he took part to the arrest of Cancellieri Pietro, Panfili Mario, Gargiulo Gaspare and Lucio Pasini all accused of helping the patriots. Luciano Pasini died because of the ill-treatments he suffered during the interrogation.

In the night of the 13th of October Gargiulo was removed from the prison to the office of the provincial police where Matteucci made him undress and submitted him to ill-treatments pricking him with a knife and whipping him with a chain and a rope until he fainted.

Matteucci took also part to the arrest of dr. Rosa Angelo deported to Germany, and terrorised his mother and his sister with a gun in their own house.

On the evening of the 17th of February he and some other fellows of the G.N.R., all dressed as patriots, arrested in S. Faustino (Umbertide) several patriots amongst whom the Bonucci Bonuccio, political Commissioner for the partisans of central Italy, who was sent to Perugia and interrogated in the office of the republican provincial police, by Major Vantaggi Head of the office, lieutenant Borghesi Marino, "capomanipolo Ceccani, and Matteucci. During this interrogation Bonucci was very much ill-treated with slaps, kicks and blows, especially by Matteucci, and was even menaced of being shot if he didn't speak.

A few days after the liberation of Perugia, and always by Rocchi's order, Matteucci killed a certain Chiavarini Silvestro suspected of having taken part in the pillage committed by some German soldiers. The murder took place in front of Chiavarini's house at via Guerriera, 4 and without any process.

On the 30th of May 1944 Matteucci executed a controlling expedition in the region of Gualdo Tadino. Such expedition has provoked the arrest and the death of a Head of the patriots called "Sandro", and of the patriot "Miro". These arrests, however, were executed by another squad.

Matteucci is not at all liked by the population for the atrocities and homicides he committed, and everybody wants him to be punished, in order to vindicate Lisa Marcello and Lucio Pasini killed pitilessly by him.

Because of the above stated facts, a warrant of arrest n. 564/44 Reg. Gen. dated 30.12.1944 has been issued against Matteucci by the local Procura del Regno for offence against the articles 51 and 58 of the C.P.M.G. and the article 5 of the legislative Decree n. 159 dated 27-7-1944, and the articles 56. 110. 610. 61.1. of the C.P.

Inquiries are made for the discovery of other eventual responsibilities.

Therefore, as Matteucci has committed many crimes in this province, and according to the above mentioned warrant of arrest, we beg you to move him to the local jail of Perugia at the disposition of the local Procura.

Penally I proceed against ARISTA Mario, of Luigi, suspected of having denounced to the nazifascists the Jewish lawyer Mr. Pano Giorgio, his landlord, who, was arrested in his house where he was hiding and was after massacred in the Cave Ardentine.

As the proofs on Arista's crime is founded partly on the declaration made by the porter of the building in which Arista lived and of which the proprietor was Pano, it is the ght opportune that a meeting should take place between the s/m and the porter. This has been requested by the widow of dott. Pano, who justly wishes to make clear the tragic case which brought about the death of her husband.

As Arista is at the moment detained in the concentration camp of Padula (Salerno) we ask your Commission to please authorize the transferment of the s/m to the judicial jail of Rome and have him placed at the disposition of my office. As soon as this interview takes place, he will be placed once more at your disposition so that he can be transferred once more to Padula.

If our request is granted, please communicate the transferment to the Sezione 1 bis Istruttoria Penale Reati Politici Tribunale Roma (Instruction Magistrate Siniscalchi).

In case of favourable consideration of the request, we beg you to communicate the effected transfer to the I^o Section his Penal Investigations of Political Crimes Rome Tribunal (Magistrate Siniscalchi).

1. Internees cannot be released from internment for interrogation only, but they can be handed over to the Italian authorities for trial if a warrant of arrest has been issued.

2. With the permission of the Allied Command, internees can be interviewed at internment camps by an accredited representative of the Italian Government.

3. It is incumbent upon the Italian Government to inform the Commandant of "A" Internee Camp, at least 7 days in advance, of the name and credentials of the Italian Government Representative and of the date on which the latter will arrive at the Camp to carry out the interrogation.

4. If witnesses are also required to attend, application will be made to the proper authority, but as witnesses cannot be accredited representatives of the Italian Government, it is considered unlikely that such application will be successful.

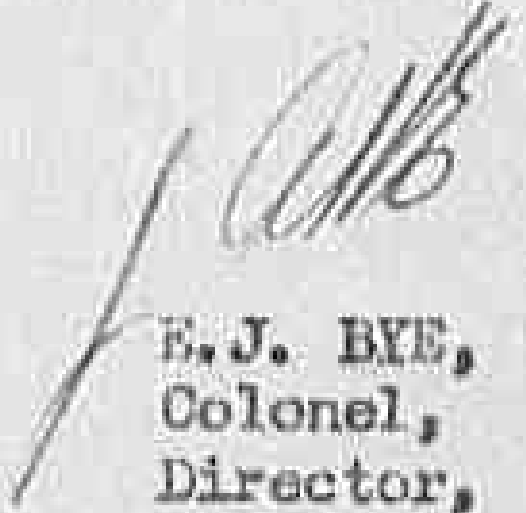

3. D'AMORE is now held in the civil prison at SUIMONA and his trial on charges of collaboration has been fixed for 20 January 1947.
4. In the event of his acquittal he will remain in custody at Allied disposition and it is requested that this HQ be advised if he is to be transferred to CI Compound, 1 SEP Centre or may be released as being of no further CI interest.

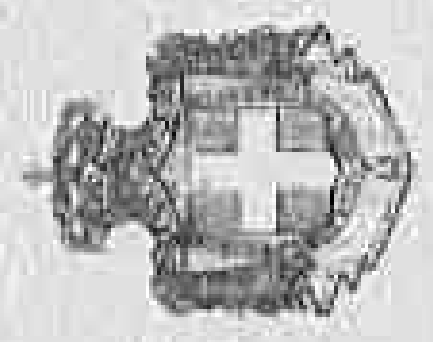

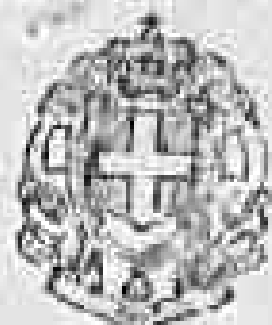

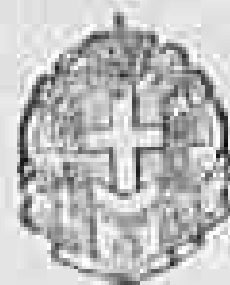
