I forward the attached copy of the warrant of arrest issued by the President of the Court of Assise of Grosseto against FIORELLI Angiolino fu Luigi, who is at present interned in the concentration camp of Padula.

The crime of competition in homicide will have to be judged according to the penal code, even though the penal action has been recalled in life for the law against fascism.

At the present moment it would be necessary to communicate the warrant of arrest to Fiorelli and to take notice of it in order that, in case of the internee's liberation from the concentration camp, the same is not to be put in liberty; but delivered to the Italian police for his transferment to the jails of Grosseto.

In case this should not happen before the fixed date for the judgement at the court of Assise, I will inform you of the date and place of the audience in order to obtain the authorization to let the internee out of the camp.

I would like to know the orders given and I thank you very much.

M. A. G. REPORT

EVDOKIMOFF Giorgio fu Nicola e fu Elena Busing (stateless), born in Kieffil on the 21 April 1896, residing in Italy since 1926, coming from Germany, where he was a prisoner of war.

In 1926 he came here with his wife ES. IPOFF Vera fu Alessio and his daughter Vera, born at Pietrogrado on the 27th September 1911.

According to what appears in these documents it results that at the beginning of the bolscevic revolution in Russia the s/m wife worked for the Government of Moscow, by which she was sent in 1926 to Rome to work at the Russian Embassy, as a trusted informant collaborating with her husband. In 1941 she committed suicide.

Evdokimoff who has taken part of the local colony of White Russians practices the profession of Doctor.

In 1941 he was to be interned in the concentration camp of Corropoli, but such steps were suspended with disposition given by the Ministry of Interior n. 448/305386 dated 1-8-41, because the Ministry of Foreign Affairs wrote to the Ministry of Interior with note n. 6865 - A.G. IV dated 8-7-41.

Although from the vigilance practiced on his account no concrete elements have arisen against him, he is considered to be an untrustworthy person.

ROMANOVSKY Sergio (Stateless but of Russian origin) duke of Leuchten, di Giorgio e di Anastasia Petrovich - Princess of Montenegro - born in Peterkoff on the 17/7/1895, resided in Italy since 1926, coming from Paris. Prince Sergio Romanovsky, as it is known, is the son of Queen Elena's sister, the Princess Anastasia of Montenegro, married, for the first time to Duke Bohanal De Leuchten berg Giorgio. The same Prince Sergio was successively given the name of Romanovski by the Tsar, being that his mother, remaining widow, married again the Grand-Duke Nicola Nicolaievic, nephew of Zar Alessandro III.

In 1939, Romanovski was appointed President of the Russian National Colony in Rome, with full powers, for the duration of five years.

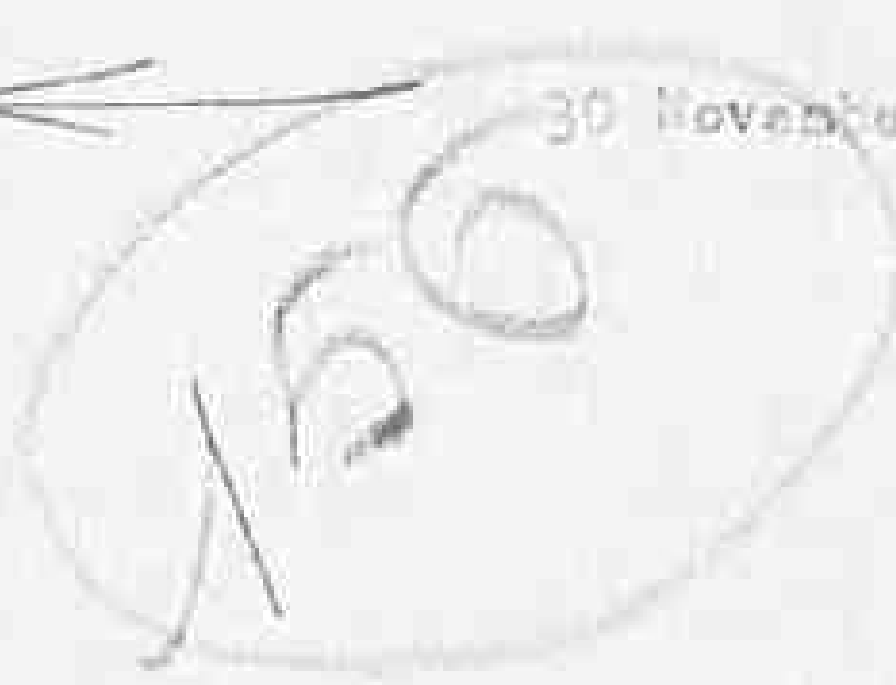
Such committee had an exclusively non-political character, and had only philanthropical assistance purposes in the Russian society here in Rome the s/m Prince does not have or enjoy excessive sympathy. And the most part of the stateless russians do not want to recognise his qualification of President of the club.

Nothing is known about his way of living. And it appears that in the past he was a pro-Fascist and pro-German.

It is not true that he was denounced to the Investigating Magistrate and that he has been judged; it's true that EVDOKIMOFF denounced him to the High Commissioner for Fascist Crimes but up to now nothing has been found against him.

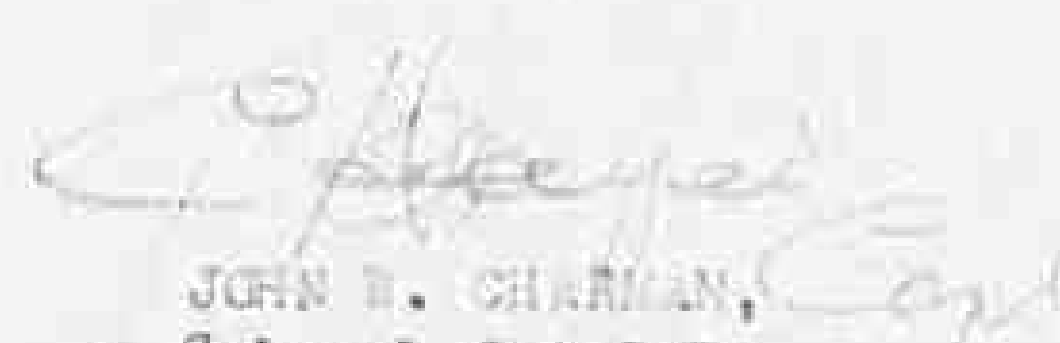

The latter was arrested for suspicion of political crime.

TRIFOGLI is also imputed of complicity in the crime as to the Art. 582 Penal Code aggravated as to the Art. 61, para 4 and 9 Penal Code, because he abused with his authority of officer of P.S. and with cruelty he has wounded SANTUCCI who was recovered only 10 days after.

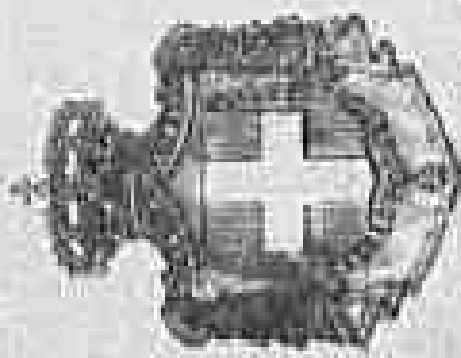
Besides, he is also imputed with the crime as to the Art. 380 Penal Code for having beaten, tortured and terrorized the same a/n Subject and push him to commit suicide. Indeed, on the 29/9/41, SANTUCCI, in Perugia has tried to kill himself and throw himself from the window. He was seriously wounded.

The Royal Prefettura ^{of Perugia} has therefore, on the 20/8/45, communicated to the Royal Questura of Terni copy of the warrant of arrest which could not be executed, because the Direction of the Internee camp of Terni has released him on the 15/9/45 without to have notified this to the Questura concerned.

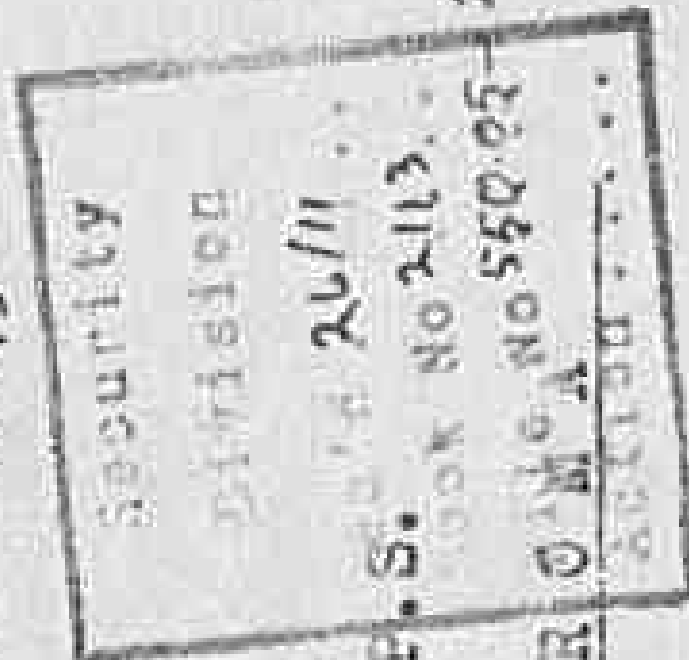
