30 March 1946

Clamor and uproar were made and are being for an immediate danger, which would upset the same humanity.

Many ^{the} persons who, sent away from offices and head-offices for their activities during the fascist period, are working on behalf of a man in order to re-establish, if not the fascism, a similar Party.

I will, as a very humble servant of the Thought of the great East, be able to enlighten you.

I do not dare ask to be received by you, nor to waste your time, spent on behalf of a Nation so tormented , but you could, as I hope, arrange a meeting with a confident Allied Commission.

Before men, of the same universal fraternization I will be not afraid to tell the truth, swearing on God, for the society and democracy.

The a/n during the Nazi occupation, denounced her husband, for revenge, to the German Command, having he hidden an English prisoner of war escaped from Alatri Camp. Therefore, her husband was denounced to Tribunale Militare in Rome, and if the Allies did not come, against him a trial would be effected with results easily imaginable.
