I am enclosing a list giving the names of thirty three Italian criminal deportees who were scheduled to sail on the T.M.V. GRIPSHOLM on October 16, 1945. This list was received from the Department of State today in a communication dated October 16, 1945.

It is expected that the following Italian nationals will also arrive on the GRIPSHOLM:

Eighty-two Italian seamen.
Fifty-four other Italians.

According to information furnished by the Immigration and Naturalization Service none of the above have engaged in any known Fascist activities.

The above information was furnished to the Italian Embassy in Washington on October 12 with the understanding that it would be telegraphed to the Italian Government.

The foregoing information was modified by a telegram from the Department of State dated October 17, a copy of which is enclosed. You will note that the telegram makes certain additions to and deletions from the list sent on October 16.

- 1 On 12 Jan 45, without any prior notification, 93 Italian undesirables arrived in Naples having been deported from the U.S. as undesirables. They were accompanied by no dossiers and were landed from the Swedish ship "Gripsholm".
- 2 I must point out that this is contrary to all international practice and, apart from that, made it extremely difficult for both Allied and Italian authorities at the port of disembarkation.
- 3 It would be appreciated if you would forward this information to the U.S. authorities to prevent similar occurrences in the future.
A detailed list of the names of the deportees can be supplied if required.

Reference your memo dated 21 July 45 reference 2/13.15/CA.

On 8th and 9th June this Section held several telephone conversations with the Italian Branch of the Displaced Persons and Refugees Sub Commission of the Allied Commission for Italy relative to the arrival of the "Gripsholm". At that time the only information here was that were approximately 525 "undesirable Italian deportees" aboard this ship. Displaced Persons and Refugees Sub Commission were informed of this and were requested to make sure that the Italian Government made plans to receive these Italian nationals.

Then, due to the anxiety of the War Shipping Administration, the American Council and Officers of G-5 this Headquarters, a signal (E-20930 of 10 June) was sent to Allied Commission asking confirmation of the notification of the Italian Government. Confirmation was later received from Allied Commission by signal (9706 of 13 June).

It is true that details of names of deportees was not furnished prior to arrival of the "Gripsholm", a review of references in the AD cable will show that the Italian Government and the Allied Commission were notified of the arrival of "undesirable deportees".

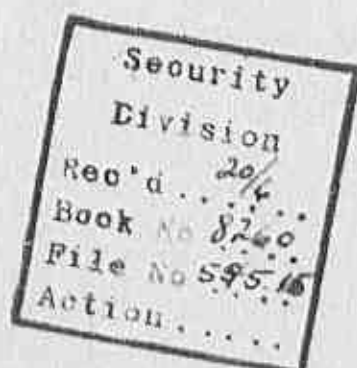
SUBJECT: Deportees from U.S.

TO : HQ Allied Commission
Public Safety Sub-Commission,
(Att. Security Office).

1. On 13th and 14th instant 93 Italian civilians deported from the U.S. were landed at Naples port from the Swedish s/s "GRIPSHOLM". No prior notice of arrival had been received at this office, or by local Italian officials.
2. Due to the fact no arrangements had been made for reception, the Provost Marshal, P.B.S., in conjunction with the Questore, Naples, temporarily housed the deportees at 326 Concentration Camp, Aversa.
3. During the morning of 16th June 1945, the deportees were dispersed to their various home towns by the Questore, after finger prints and full particulars had been taken for the information of P.S. services at the various destinations.
4. A detailed list of the deportees will be forwarded when received.
