1. A petition has been received by CG, MTOUSA from Eugenio Civita, the brother of Engineer Antonio Civita, for the release of his brother from Padula camp.

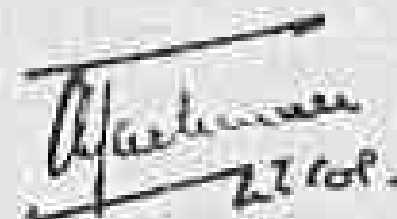
2. G-2 this HQ advise that the case of Antonio Civita has recently been reviewed. His home address is given as Via Della Robbia, 112, Florence, and his occupation was that of Director General of the Societa Minervaria at Valdarno.

3. G-2 further advise that the main accusation against him is that he continued to operate the mine in collaboration with the Germans while Civita claims he was only doing his duty in operating the mine and is willing to return and operate it again in order to assist the economic recovery of Italy.

4. G-2 state they do not consider he represents a security danger but that it is contrary to policy to release internees in the Army Areas save in exceptional circumstances. It appears that the case has been referred to HQ. 15 Army Group who consider that CIVITA should not be released unless and until he is asked for by AMG.

5. In the circumstances it is requested that you ascertain and report whether in fact the release of CIVITA as an exceptional case is desired.

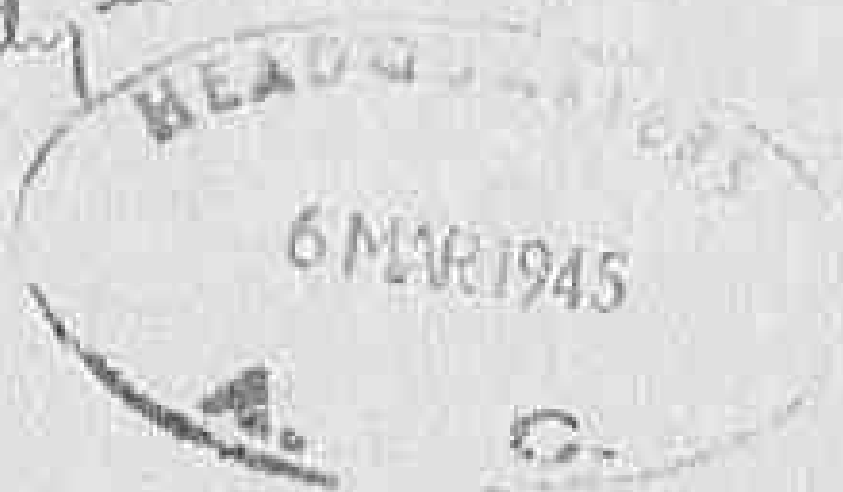

Civil Engineer Antonio CIVITA, General Director of the "Miniera del Valdarno" was arrested on July 3rd and handed over to the Allies under the unfounded and undetermined accusations of being a sympathiser with fascism and of having collaborated with the Germans. The truth is that Civil Engineer Antonio Civita stayed up to the last moment in the Establishments of the Company and it was owing to his personal courage and his intelligent activity that it was possible to save part of the industrial machinery and tools of the concern, which the German troops when retiring tried to either take away or completely destroy. After his internment in the C.M.F. camp of Padula, he was subjected to two interrogatories, which, (from the information we have received) were both absolutely favourable to the accused person, who was able to demonstrate how unjust the accusations that had been made against him were. He was afterwards told by the Commander of the Camp that he would be freed as soon as the approval of the Political Centre of Caserta was obtained.

The great experience that has been acquired by this highly valued Director during many years of work, is now considered particularly necessary, for the reconstruction of many of the destroyed plants, in the group to which he belonged.

It is therefore earnestly requested that, having examined the position of complete innocence of Eng. Civita - orders should be given as soon as is considered possible so as to liberate him from the concentration camp in which he still is.

The following regulations concerning visits to Civilian Internee Camps will be applicable to "A" Civilian Internee Camp (PADULA) and No. 2 Internee Camp (TERNI). Internees temporarily held in British Prisoner of War Camps for transfer to an Internee Camp will not be permitted to receive visitors :-

1. As from 15 Jan 45 all internees other than those in Para 2 below will be permitted to receive one visit per month from their relatives. Each visit will be limited to two persons to each internee.
2. Those temporarily detained and those in respect of whom specific instructions are issued by higher authority will not be permitted to receive visitors, and on visiting days will be confined to their quarters.
3. Such visits will only be permitted on Sundays except in special circumstances when the Commandant of the Internee Camp may at his discretion authorise a visit on other days. Such a visit will not, however, be in addition to the monthly visit to which the internee is entitled.
4. Internees requiring legal advice will be permitted to receive visits from their advocates by special appointment and with the approval of the Commandant of the Camp.
5. These instructions will not apply to visitors such as representatives of the Italian or International Red Cross, or Clergy, who may visit a Camp for the purpose of making an inspection or of making provision for the welfare of the internees as a whole. Such visitors will require to obtain a pass from this Headquarters and may only visit a Camp by appointment.
6. The full name, address, identity card number of each visitor to a Camp will be entered in a visitors book together with the name of and relationship to the internee that he or she may wish to visit.

3. Such visits shall be made under special circumstances when the Commandant of the Internment Camp may at his discretion authorize a visit on other days. Such a visit will not, however, be in addition to the monthly visit to which the internee is entitled.
4. Internees requiring legal advice will be permitted to receive visits from their advocates by special appointment and with the approval of the Commandant of the Camp.
5. These instructions will not apply to visitors such as representatives of the Italian or International Red Cross, or Clergy, who may visit a Camp for the purpose of making an inspection or of making provision for the welfare of the internees as a whole. Such visitors will require to obtain a pass from this Headquarters and may only visit a Camp by appointment.
6. The full name, address, identity card number of each visitor to a Camp will be entered in a visitors book together with the name of and relationship to the internee that he or she may wish to visit.
7. Visitors will be given a warning to read, written in the appropriate language as to the censorship regulation in force before they are conducted into the Camp.

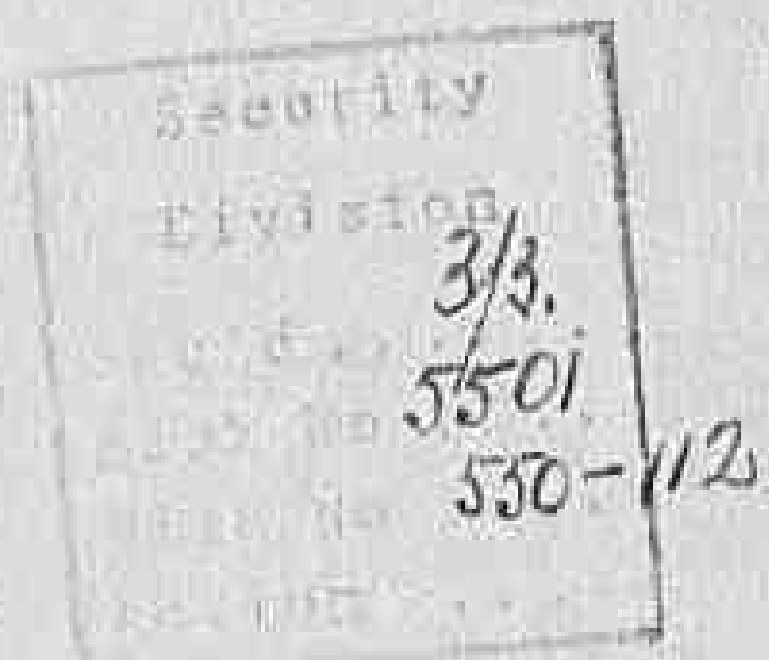

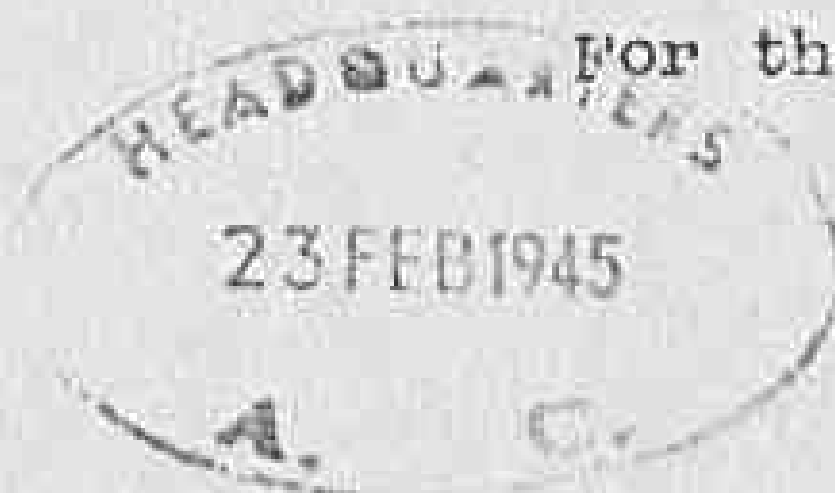
