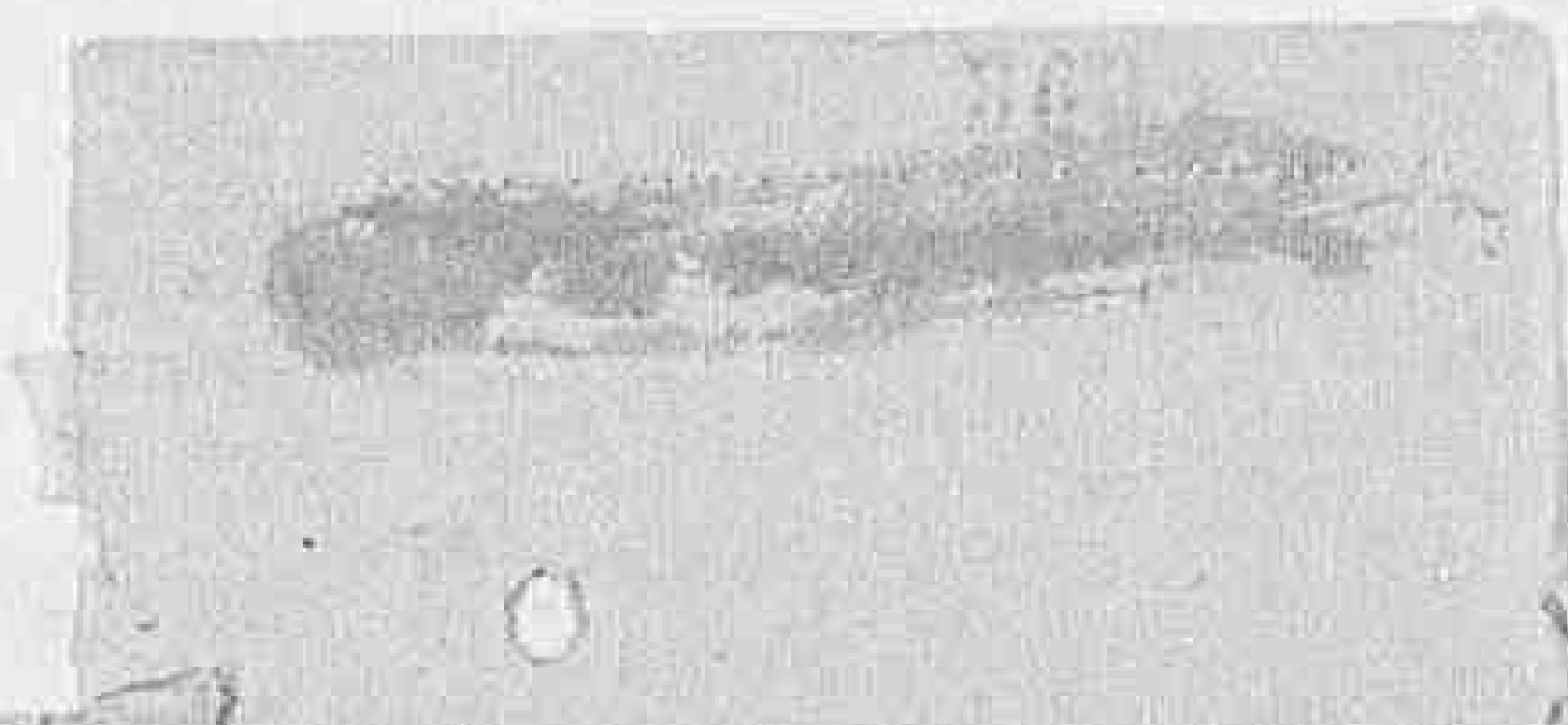



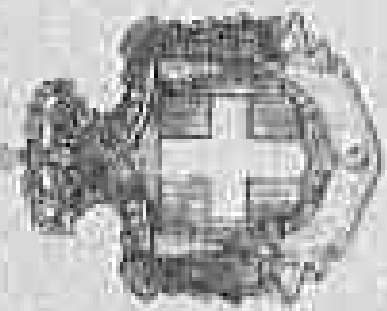

I forward the present appeal begging you to please transmit it to the competent office:

"My husband Carlo Borghesi fu Achille was arrested on the 6th of July 1944 and interned in the concentration camp of Padula (Salerno) on account of false accusations made by some persons of bad faith. He was a 1st class communal employee in Panicale since January 1926, and secretary of the local "Opere Pie".

He has always been esteemed by his superiors of the Prefecture in Perugia as a good functionary and a good citizen.

No gathering of men or any other painful facts of the kind happened in Panicale as it did in many other provinces of Perugia, and I think that the absolute absence of the intangible facts, is the most eloquent argument to demonstrate how false the accusations made against my husband are, and how he gave proof of equilibrium and good sense during the difficult period of the National life in general and particularly in Panicale.

On the other hand it is necessary to consider the fact that during the critical period of the "Republic" he could not refuse himself to the political life without being in danger of being prosecuted, instead, by acting the way he did without factiousity he avoided much danger and damage to the population.

I therefore trust in the just valuation of my husbands activities and hope to obtain his liberation.

The issuing of the daily subsidies to the ex-confinees and to the ex political internees, according to the circular of the 14 Aug.44 n.451/1731, has the purpose to help those against whom relative police measures have been taken and released and who afterwards and in consequence of the events of July-Sept 43 were in the impossibility of going back to their homes and were therefore in bad financial conditions.

With the circular of the 29 Jan.1935, it has been suggested to proceed to periodical controls and the effective impossibility of the people in question, in sending them to their homes, and on their economical conditions, with the purpose of avoiding further undue payments.

It does not seem though, that the a/m payments proceed regularly and with the necessary frequency, the consequence of all this being that the amount of the subsidies present a continuous increase, which is not justified.

Therefore your attention is drawn on the importance and necessity of frequent control, so we therefore beg you to transmit two distinct numerical lists, one for the ex-italian confinees and the ex political internees and the other for the foreigners, with the below mentioned details.

- 1) Those subsidized on the arrival of the present circular.
- 2) Those subsidized during the period of the a/m date <sup>2045</sup> the 30 June 1945.
- 3) Those excluded from the subsidy from the a/m date to the 30 June 1945 (for re-patriation, transference, deaths and revisions etc.,)
- 4) Those subsidized from 1 July 1945.
- 5) The compressive sum distributed from the date of arrival of the present circular and the 30 June 45.

These lists must be sent for the first time within the 15 July and successively every three months (therefore within the 15 Oct.45 - 15 Jan.1946 etc.,) with the details relative to the three months.

Particular attention must be drawn to the Prefettura in order to avoid that the subsidized of one province will not be paid in an other province.

As to the foreigners, whose movements can be more easily controlled it is disposed that on their sojourn order a notice be written on the space reserved, for the authorization annotations for work in the following way.

"R.Prefettura of .....Admitted for the benefit of the subsidy as an internee".

This notice has to be repeated in all the Prefetturas in whose jurisdiction the subsidized person transfer their residence.

In the case that the concession of the subsidy ceases, it must always be written in the same space, as follows:

"R.Prefettura of .... The revocation of the subsidy.

In order to avoid duplicates of subsidy, when the statement of sojourn is made by the foreign ex-internee, that, the Prefettura of the Province from which the person comes must ask at once for the necessary information regarding the assistance given.

The sending of the a/m bi-monthly lists do not exempt the Prefettura from taking care of the following periodical lists.

A) A monthly list of the names of the subsidized political ex-confinees and ex-political internees.

Within the 10th of every month, two distinct lists of the political ex-confinees and internees in duplicate have to be sent to the Ministry, one regarding the Italians and the other the foreigners who have been subsidized during the previous month with the following details:

- 1) Surname, name and paternity.
- 2) nationality (only for the foreigners which have to be grouped according to their nationality).
- 3) Present residence
- 4) Residence when in confinement or interned
- 5) Amount of daily subsidy.
- 6) Monthly amount issued to each one of them.

B) Monthly list of the names of British subjects subsidized ex-political internees.

The names of the subsidized British ex-political internees, besides being included in the foreigners list mentioned in para. A., must be comprised in a special list which has to be transmitted every month in duplicate within the 10th of each month. In this list the following details must be reported.

- On this list it is sufficient to repeat the following:
- 1) Name, surname and paternity of the subsidized.
  - 2) residence
  - 3) monthly sum assigned to each one.

Dear Sir,

I am sorry to write you at this time, being you are a very busy man, but knowing you are the only one that can help me I am writing this letter hoping that you could do something for my brother, ALFRED DE GENNARO, who has been interned for seven months just for having a good heart and helping some Italian civilians that were destitutely poor, while he was in the American Army in the 2677th Regiment, APO 534, U.S. Army. My brother has never been in America and he joined in the American Army soon after the liberation of Naples where my whole family reside. He did wonderful work while he was with his Regiment meriting the trust and esteem of his American superiors, there is proof for everything, I am saying. He is sorry for helping those civilians not knowing the consequences; he thought that he was doing good. Because he is only a good hearted kid. He speaks, writes and reads English well and has never been in America, that is because since we were kids from knee high we were taught from our father to love America and fight for her and maybe some day live in this great land of Liberty all of us. I for one, I am a Veteran from the Southern Pacific Theatre of War but three months ago I was Honorably Discharged from the Army for a disease I caught out there, and if it wasn't for that I would still fight for this land that has adopted us. Every member of my family is like us (true Americans). My family has endured a lot of suffering from the Nazi rats with my father in a concentration camp for three years. Now my mother and father are both very sick and with my brother interned they cry day and night and it is worse because with the little that my brother earned the family could eat. He used to support the family while I was fighting in the Pacific and unable to help them.

Please, Sir, I beg of you to look into the matter and see if you could obtain my brother's release or pardon him for you will not regret it. He is a Naval expert and will do a lot of his share for the war effort. As for my mother, you will give her happiness that she has never know, receive her blessings and mine and I will be ever grateful to you for the rest of my life. The Camp where my brother is interned is Alfred De Gennaro, "A" Civilian Internes Camp, C.I.F., Italy.

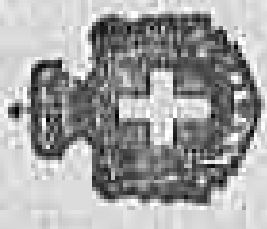

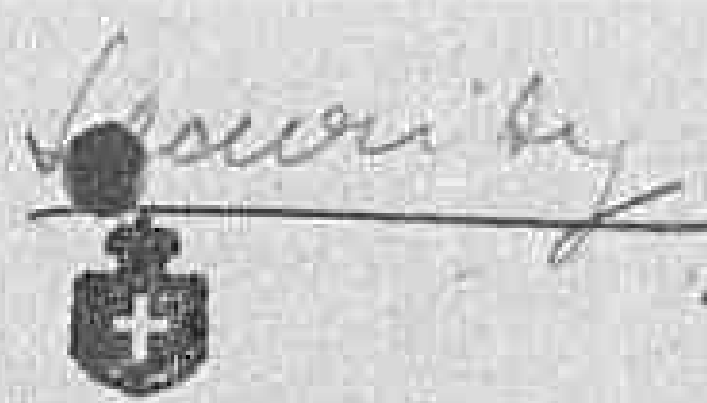

2. ADMS 94 Sub Area has reported that he requires treatment not available at NOCERA and the diagnosis by the Italian M.O. has been confirmed by a British Medical Officer.
3. Please therefore make arrangements to transfer him to an Italian Civil Hospital or clinic where necessary treatment can be given, advising this Headquarters in advance date of transfer and address of hospital to which transferred.
4. On receipt of information requested in para 3, G2(OI) this Headquarters, will arrange for him to be kept under surveillance.
