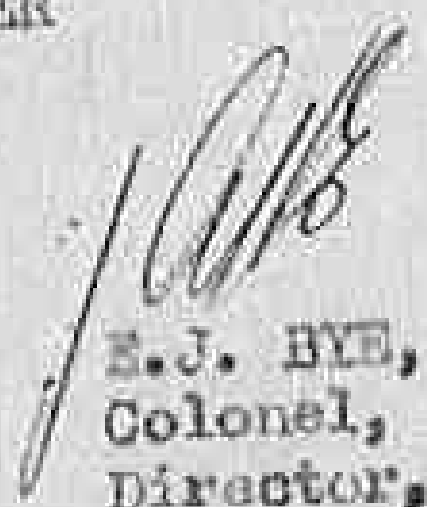

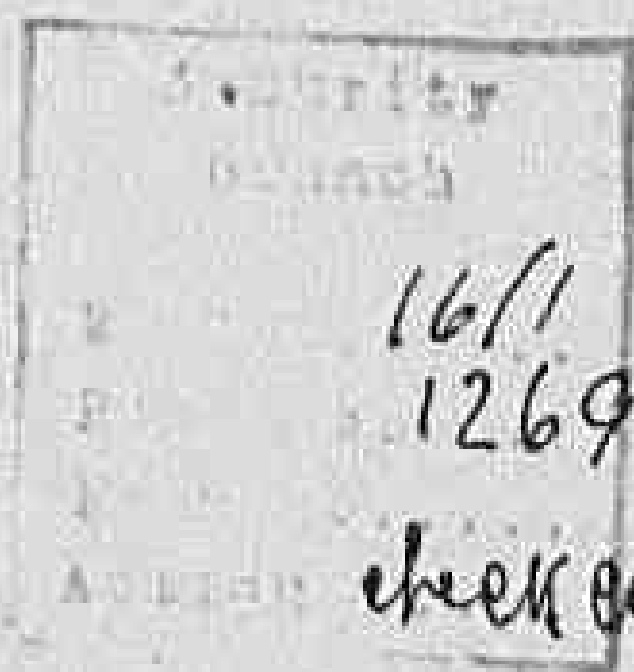

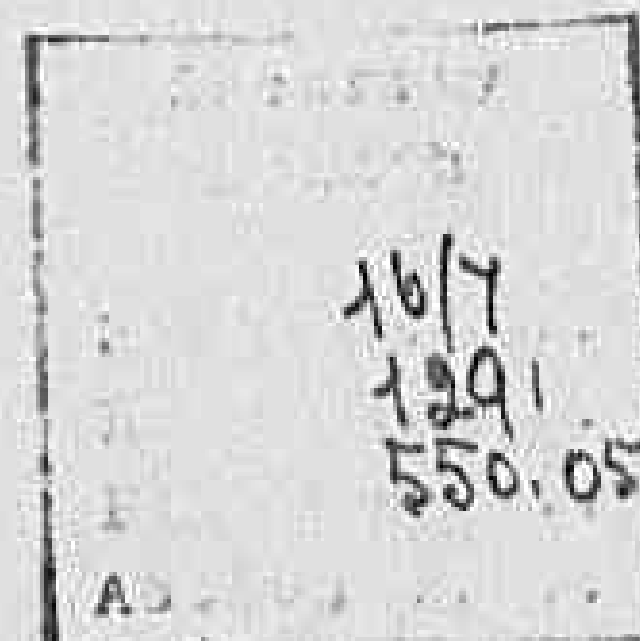

2. He was acquitted on charges of collaboration but for speaking against certain partisans who has been captured he was sentenced to two years imprisonment, pay costs of the trial, pay his maintenance whilst in prison and confiscation of one-tenth of his property.

Referring to the a/m wire, we inform you that ISACCO MARSILI of Adolfo, on 9 Feb 46, was sentenced to two years prison, with the following sentence:

" The Sezione Speciale della Corte di Assise di Arezzo, -art. 5 and 9 of D.L.L. 27 July 1944 n. 159 and Decreto 21 May 1945 N. 364 art. 87 C.P.M. of War 484 and 488 C.P.M.- as previous declarations that the facts discussed about the "charge of collaboration" (art. 51 C.P.M. of War) are instead to be considered "denigrazione dello stato di guerra", (art. 87 C.P.M.)- sentences MARSILI Bruno, guilty of the above modified crime, to:

- 2 years prison
- trial expenses
- his maintenance in prison
- forfeiture of a tenth of his estates

We add that the charge of "denigrazione" was due to Marsili, because he offended a captured partisans group.

" In Sezione Speciale della Corte di Assise di Arezzo, visti gli art. 5 e 9 del D.L. 27-7-1944 N. 159 e Decreto 21-5-1945 N. 354 art. 87 C.P.M. di guerra 484 e 488 C.P.M. di guerra, previa dichiarazione che i fatti contestati come delitto di collaborazionismo nelle ipotesi previste dall'art. 51 C.P.M. di guerra costituiscono invece il delitto di denigrazione della guerra previsto dall'art. 87 C.P.M. di guerra suscitato, dichiara Marsili Bruno colpevole del delitto come sopra modificato e lo condanna alla pena di anni due di reclusione, al pagamento delle spese processuali ed a quelle del suo mantenimento in carcere, nonché alla confisca di un decimo dei beni di sua proprietà."

Si soggiunge che l'accusa di denigrazione è dovuta al fatto che il Marsili aveva rivolto ingiurie ad un gruppo di partigiani catturati.

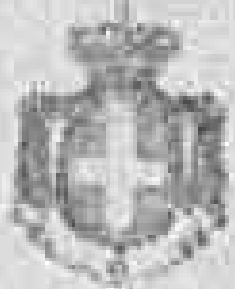

their present status. To request their return to TERNI
prior to trial would not appear to be practical.

2. The attached schedule shows that in only five instances have cases been satisfactorily concluded and disposal instructions been issued.

3. In view of the proven slowness of the Italian administration allied to staff difficulties within this HQ., the following recommendations are submitted for consideration:

- (a) Many of those released are still awaiting trial after more than a year in Italian custody. It is suggested therefore that all those who have been released for trial for a period exceeding six months be returned to 'H' Civilian Internee Camp forthwith unless the Italian authorities can establish that the trial will, in fact, be held within one month from date of our instruction.
- (b) That, by liaison with the Comdt. the quarters of Terrid, or such other official as may be decided, be permitted access to any internee for the purpose of interrogation. The interrogating officer would be required to give the Camp authorities twenty-four hours notice of intention. This would obviate such correspondence in requesting individual authorities and would avoid internees being held in Italian custody for long periods whilst the cases against them are being prepared.
- (c) That future requests from the Italian authorities quote the date on which it is intended to hold the trial and

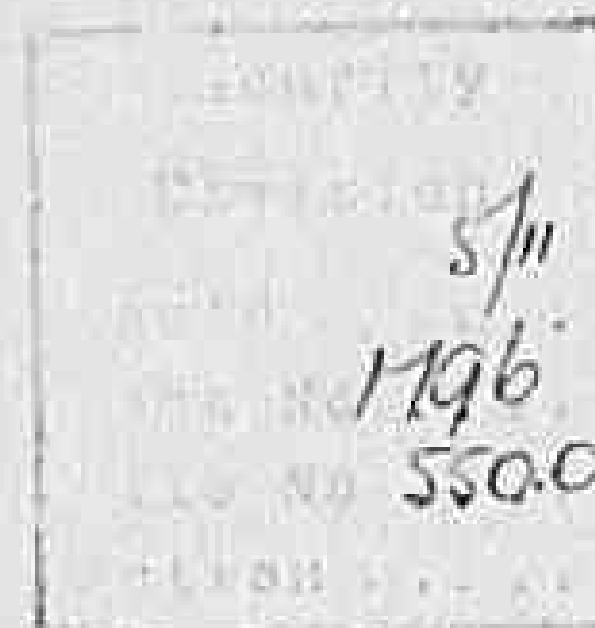

1. From time to time requests are received from Italian Authorities through your office, for handing over of certain internees for trial.
2. At present there are 49 cases outstanding upon whom no final action has been taken by the Italian courts. Over two months have elapsed since an enquiry was made as to the status of this group. The dilatory tactics of the Italian Authorities results in much unnecessary correspondence and book-keeping.
3. It is to be noted further that lately many requests for the hand over to some particular court are being forwarded direct to this Headquarters. This office has replied, in each case forwarding the reply through your office.
4. It is strongly recommended that your office make necessary arrangements to insure : (1) that requests for hand-over are not made until the case is ready for trial and (2) that a status report be submitted by the Italian Authorities within 30 days from the date of hand-over. It is further recommended that the Italian Authorities be advised that in the future no requests for handover will be granted unless processed through your office.
5. Upon completion of the trial it is incumbent upon the Italian Authorities to notify this office of the results of the trial. After trial a request by the Italian Authorities for the release of the internee for the purpose imposing the sentence will be considered by this office.

CRISCI, on 15 Jan last, by Giudice Istruttore orders, was sent to the Hospital Umberto I in Rome, ^{for} rays treatments to the digestive organs. The Questura disposed a sentry service of PS Agents, but, although the close vigilance, CRISCI, taking advantage of a compelled removal of the guard on duty, escaped from the Hospital and has not yet been found.

All the Authorities have been informed for his capture.

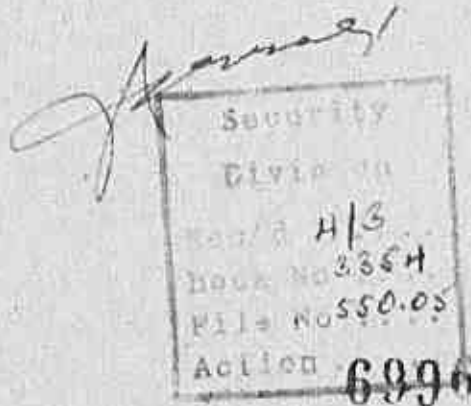
