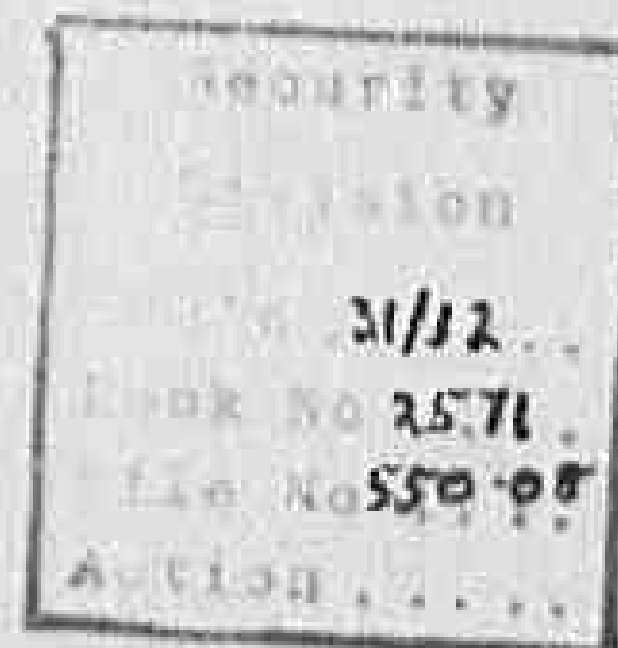

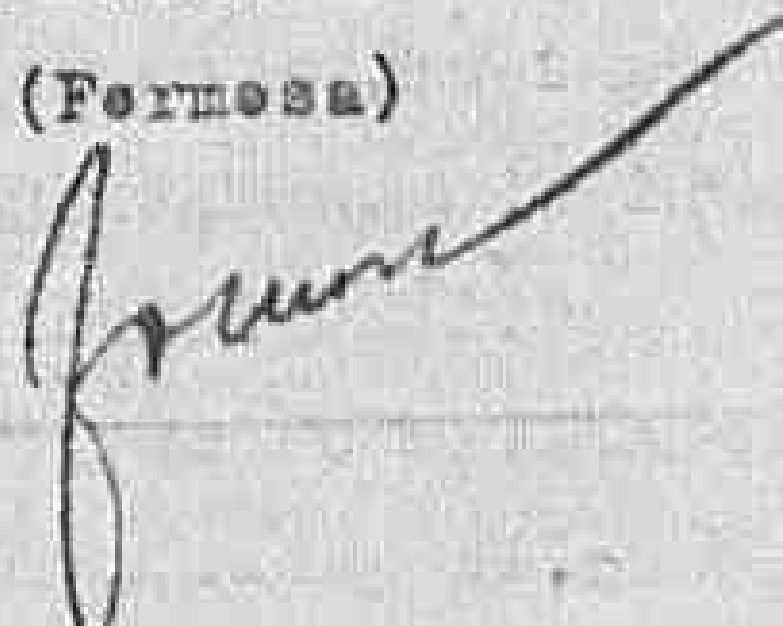

SUBJECT : Expiration proceedings against interned officers

Amongst the officers deferred to the judgment of this Commission of Expiration, there are some of inferior and superior ranks who are interned in Allied concentration camps for political reasons. For some of these interned officers, statements of accusation have already been issued by our Commission together with the date of the preliminaries concerned which, according to law, should expire at the end of three months. The competent CC.RR. Commands have not yet delivered the a/m statements to the persons concerned as entry into the concentration camps, where the same are interned, is strictly forbidden.

Such proceedings must be concluded as soon as possible for, as has already been pointed out their expiration should shortly take place. Thus we beg your Commission to kindly intervene with the competent Allied Command in order that it authorize both the President and the Secretary of our Commission (Dr. Pietro VERBONA and Mr. Emilio LAURICHELLA) to enter the u/m concentration camps for the interrogation of the officers concerned, and to directly receive their justifications.

It is pointed out that some of the officers in question must also be summoned as witnesses in several expiration proceedings initiated by this Commission against other CC.RR. Officers.

The Allied Concentration Camps in which the a/m officials should be allowed to enter, are the following:

Concentration Camp at APRAGOLA (Officers interned: Capt. VITULZI)

Concentration Camp at VERDI (Officers interned: Maj. FANTONI, Capt. DE PELL)

Amongst the officers deferred to the judgment of this Commission of Epuration, there are some of inferior and superior ranks who are interned in Allied concentration camps for political reasons. For some of these interned officers, statements of accusation have already been issued by our Commission together with the date of the preliminaries concerned which, according to law, should expire at the end of three months. The competent CC.RR. Commands have not yet delivered the a/m statements to the persons concerned as entry into the concentration camps, where the same are interned, is strictly forbidden.

Consequently the aforementioned officers have not yet been informed of when their files will be examined nor have they been able to forward their justifications to this Commission which, according to law must take note of their appeals before the final decision. Such proceedings must be concluded as soon as possible for, as has already been pointed out their expiration should shortly take place. Thus we beg your Commission to kindly intervene with the competent Allied Command in order that it authorize both the President and the Secretary of our Commission (Dr. Pietro FORMOSA and Lt. 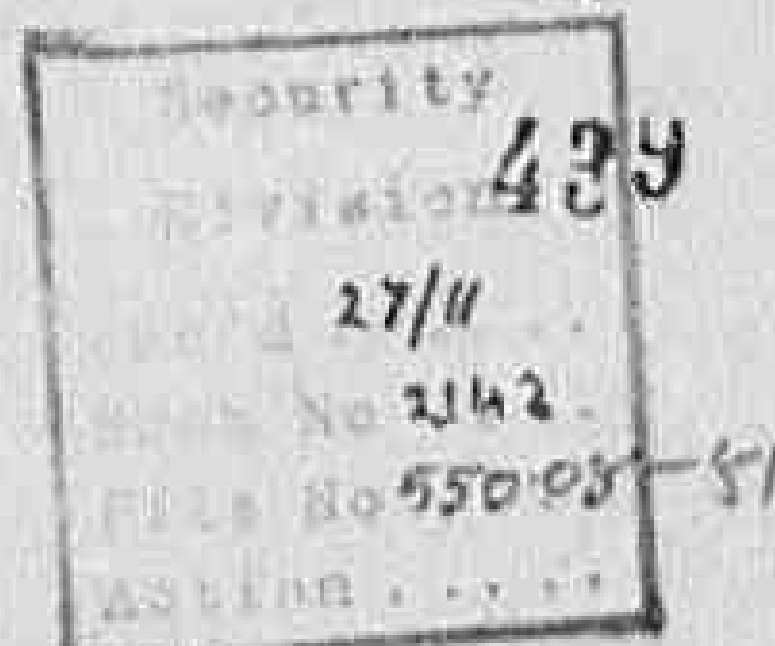

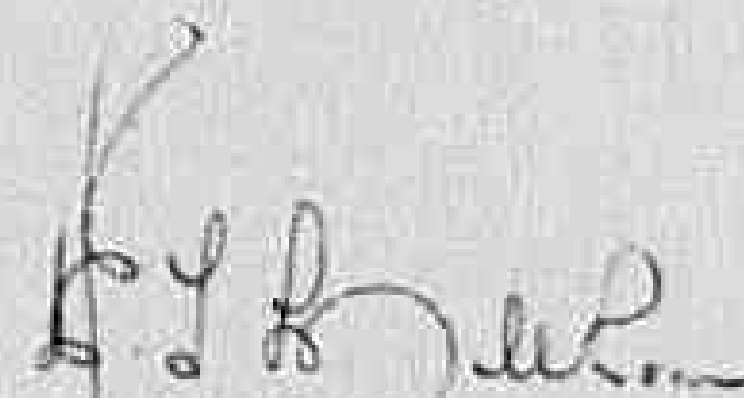

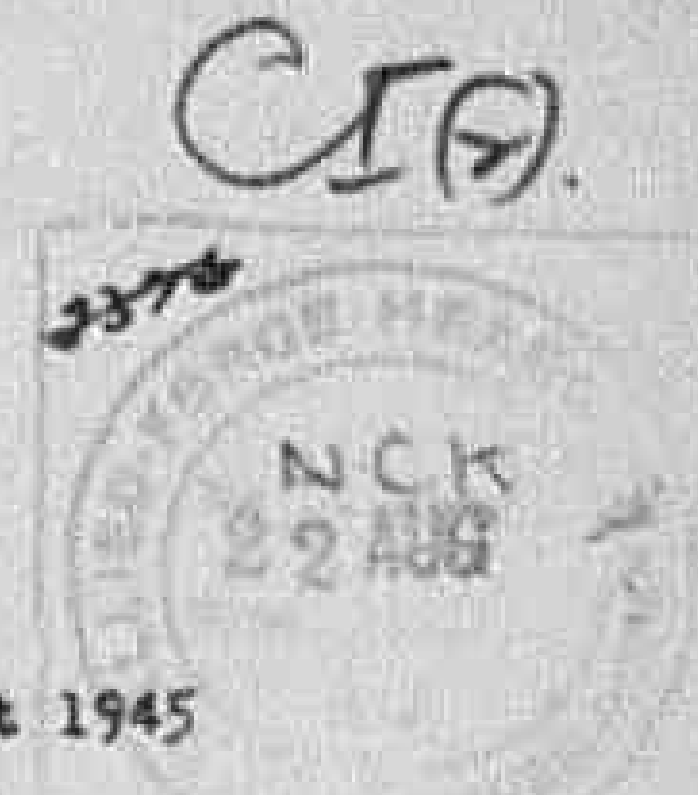
