- (1) 1923-24 Sectional Delegate of the Fascio di Spello.
- (2) 1924-26 Vice-Secretary to the student Fascist group of CITTÀ DI GASTELLIO.
- (3) 1928-31 member of the Directorate of GUF of Perugia.
- (4) 1934-35 Vice-Secretary of the Regional Fascist Group of TIRRENIA.

(3) From 1935 he was Provincial Piumario of the Fascist association of Public Employment, president of the Provincial Section of the Fascist Institute A.O., and adviser of the regional group of Porta S. Angelo. He travelled about Italy for the purpose of attending Fascist meetings and conferences. As a propagandist he rose to be vice-director of the local Fascist paper "L'Assalto" and a correspondent of the "Popolo di Roma" and "Ungiuno Fascista", paper of the notorious Roberto FALCETTI. He was a director of the Fascist review "Dattaglio Fascista per la Compagna Coll'Impero" edited at Rome. Morally speaking, Rodani's name and the name of his family is a by-word in Perugia for corruption and dishonesty.

During the period of war, subject took the Republican oath in Florence. He was a Fascist Republican propagandist and wrote articles in Republican journals. Subject admits that he advised youth who came to him for counsel to present themselves for service in the Republican Army, and admits that he has never had any love for the British or Americans. He denounced the presence of a Jewish family in a house in Florence to the German authorities, and although they managed to escape, when the Germans came to the house he informed of the pro-Allied sentiments of the family living there (highlighted) after the arrival of the Allies he stated publicly that he was in favour of the Allies against the Germans. Subject is a member of security offences against the Allies and is therefore interned.
