Originally arrested in Aug. 64, on suspicion of being involved with enemy subversive group; was held, interrogated and eventually released, during November and December 64, was undetected and found to be acting suspiciously. No. 3 unit have interrogated her but can prove nothing against her; but that unit recommends she be interned as a potential danger to security.
