1. Our records show that Senator Alberto CAIZA-BINI was an important active Fascist of long standing and his arrest was also requested by SEM
2. As you know, all cases of internees are reviewed periodically and age and state of health are given due consideration by the Reviewing Board in each case.
3. Since ample grounds existed for the arrest of CAIZA-BINI in the first instance it is felt that no action should be taken in his case until it has been reviewed in the normal way at PADULA, which will be fairly soon. Copies of the letters written by CAIZA-BINI and Gen IMBASSE have been forwarded to 371 PW Camp for consideration in conjunction with the rest of the information on the case.

Excellency,

Though I do not know if the direction of your office is still intrusted to H. E. Gamarra, I apply to you hoping to be heard.

His Highness the Lieutenant General of the Realm knows me and has already helped me several times. He knows therefore my attachment to the Royal Family also because in a letter he wrote to H. E. Gamarra in August 1943, he speaks about my faithfulness to the King and to Badoglio. Perhaps His Highness remembers that before the 8th September 1943 I expressed the wish to remain near him in any case. In this case I should have been with him and with the Allies. Instead of that I am at Padula and I don't understand the reason of my internment as I have nothing to my detriment. I am morally and politically sound and I have always limited my activity to the technical and cultural field.

I hope that His Highness will be able to help me in order to allow my return to my work and to my family which is still ignorant of my true situation. If this will not be possible, I hope that, at least, I will be released on probation like other deputies and senators.

If I ask for abster treatment, it is not only because I am a Senator of the Realm, but also because I am old and because my health is bad.

I beg you, Excellency, to excuse me and to express to His Highness my deep and unchangeable devotion.
