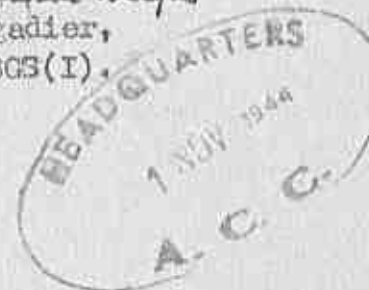

1. Since Capt. WATT is now serving with a unit controlled by AFHQ, the file in question was forwarded to G-2 (CI) Section of that headquarters for their attention.
2. In the opinion of G-2 (CI) AFHQ the evidence contained in the documents concerned is not in itself sufficiently complete to justify action against Capt. WATT without further enquiry, and in view of the extremely long delay in reporting the accusation now made such enquiry at this stage would prove to be almost certainly protracted and most probably abortive.
3. This branch is in agreement with these findings and no further action is contemplated.
