1. Officers and ORs/EA of the Servizio Informazioni Difesa (S.I.D.) - as distinct from the agents employed by them - are members of a military intelligence service, whether they be drawn from SIA, CG.RR or elsewhere.

2. Therefore, unless they are at the time of their capture personally engaged in obtaining information by clandestine means (in which case they will be treated as agents) they are entitled to be treated as military personnel, viz. as P.W.

3. However, as members of an enemy intelligence service they will probably have information of considerable value to us. They will not therefore be evacuated at once as P.W. but will be detained in custody pending investigation and disposal instructions. They will be interrogated by the nearest FSS/CIC in conjunction with Italian GS, and any necessary local enquiries into their past activities will be made. The nearest SCI officer will be informed of the arrest, in order that he may check the name against his records.

4. A report on the case will then be forwarded to this HQ, together with a recommendation as to disposal, which will normally be one of the following:

(a) Continued detention pending further investigation or interrogation.

Officers and ORA/EA of the Servizio Informazioni Difesa (S.I.D.) - as distinct from the agents employed by them - are members of a military intelligence service, whether they be drawn from SIA, CC.RR or elsewhere.

Therefore, unless they are at the time of their capture personally engaged in obtaining information by clandestine means (in which case they will be treated as agents) they are entitled to be treated as military personnel, viz. as P.W.

However, as members of an enemy intelligence service they will probably have information of considerable value to us. They will therefore be evacuated at once as P.W. but will be detained in custody pending investigation and disposal instructions. They will be interrogated by the nearest FOS/CIC in conjunction with Italian CS, and any necessary local enquiries into their past activities will be made. The nearest SOI officer will be informed of the arrest, in order that he may check the name against his records.

A report on the case will then be forwarded to this HQ, together with a recommendation as to disposal, which will normally be one of the following:

- (a) Continued detention pending further investigation or interrogation.
- (b) Internment as a military P.W. at a normal P.W. Camp.
- (c) Release for employment by SIDA or
- (d) Respatch to CC.RR Reception Centre (through MAG Public Safety).

This HQ, after consulting Italian CS, HQ HQAE (if deemed advisable), will then decide on the disposal, and notify the detaining authority of this decision.

In the case of SID personnel who are also members of the CC.RR, this instruction overrides the provisions of our 1402/5/ GSI(b) dated 11 October 1944 on the G.M.H.

1. Attached is a photographed copy of a list of S.I.D. agent belonging to Section 'S' which has been received from the CS Section of SIM, having been found by them in the offices of the Fascist Republican General Staff.
2. The list gives the symbol, name, rank, employer organisation, date and place of birth, father's name, domicile and details of activity of each agent.
3. All members of S.I.D. will, if found, be interned and treated as P/W in the same way as other Fascist Republican air personnel.
