SUBJECT: Independent Labourist Party.

In this city the Independent Labourist Party has been formed, with office in Traversa S. Felice a Piazza Dante N. 15, to collect persons who support the obedience of the laws, love of the family, liberty, increase of the social class, the respect of faith and the equality for the well being of Italy.

It is a centre party, it has no paper, and up to now it has only a few adherents.

SERSALE Giuseppe fu Antimo and fu Siniscalchi Carmela, born in Rome on 16.5.1889, resident here in Via Cimarosa N. 2 A, is the manager. He is a widower and has children, he is a lawyer. It does not appear that he belonged to the fascist party; no penal records in this R. Questura files.

SUBJECT : Partito Laburista Italiano

TO : Director, Labour Sub Commission  
(Att'n. Mr. HIRD)

1. With reference to your verbal enquiry regarding the above organisation and its Secretary General Carlo Leopoldo BASILE, the following is submitted for your information.

2. "Partito Laburista Italiano" was derived from "Partito Libero Sociale", and absorbed the "Unione Laburista Italiana". The Party has offices at Galleria Margherita No. 7 on the fourth floor. This Party has an estimated membership of 4,000 in all Italy. On its constitution a committee of 20 people was formed, amongst whom was a certain Avv. COCCIA. The Committee recently resigned as they could not agree with the acting Secretary General, BASILE.

3. BASILE is the Director and financier of the weekly newspaper "Roma del Popolo" which he uses to spread party propaganda which in general advocates the creation of numerous organisations of labour and co-operatives, but so far very few are functioning. An attempt is being made to change this paper from a weekly to a daily. BASILE is also the owner of the weekly political and economic paper "Il Riformatore" and the labour paper "Corriere Abruzzese". In addition he co-operates with the Director of the pamphlet "Lavoro e Tecnica", a certain Ing. MARZI Guglielmo, former Squadrista and Marola.

4. The central direction of the Party is carried out by the following, acting as committee.

5. BASILE was an anti-fascist today he is a wealthy man, this is indicated by the case with which he is able to purchase newspapers. I have seen a copy of an extortion letter dated 14 June 1945 sent by BASILE to Beniamino GIGLI's secretary.

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6. Between 4 June 1927 and 3 October 1941, BASILE was convicted by the Italian Courts on 25 occasions on charges of embezzlement forgery theft and bankruptcy, his sentences ranged from 3 to 20 Months. On 29 July 1935 he was sent to political confinement by the Provincial Commission of Rome for a period of three years because he was a danger to public safety owing to this criminal activities.
